### **World Day of Prayer**

This year, the women of the WDP Committee of The Bahamas calls us to consider Jesus' words to the disciples after washing their feet: "Do you understand what I have done for you?" The women of The Bahamas describe what Jesus does when he washes the disciples' feet as "radical love." To them, radical love comes from humility, compassion and commitment. God's radical love is not static or self-centered; it reaches out and draws others in.

The first organized "day of prayer for the world" held nationally was in Canada on January 9, 1920. The United States soon followed on February 20, 1920.

Now, hundreds of thousands of women (and men, youth and children) from around the world and in every region gather to collectively worship on the first Friday in March. Each year, a different country serves as the writer of the World Day of Prayer worship service and other materials. Women of that country's national committee interpret scripture within their cultural context, preparing a worship service, and women around the world lead the services.
