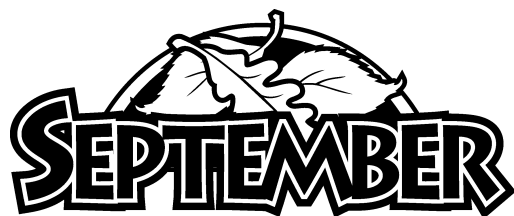

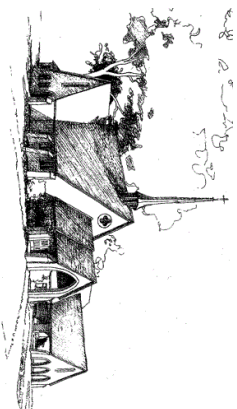
For the columbarium, we're using a special order brick for the enclosure. Since this is a rather small order of brick, the manufacturer is combining orders with other buyers before executing the order.
