- **Renovation, Clay** cultivated relationships within their community recently by having a church picnic at Onondaga Park. A Missionary Heart

(Romania) In his pre-missionary days, DANIEL BYRD was a regional vice president for a subsidiary of a Fortune 500 company, drawing a handsome, six-figure salary and working roughly four hours a week. He gave it all up to answer God's call to missions. Living in Cluj-Napoca, Romania, he works to plant churches among the Roma people in partnership with Romanian Baptists. He also disciples a group of seven young Roma men. Much of Daniel's ministry is focused on Roma youth, who desperately need both positive male role models and the Gospel. Gifts through the Cooperative Program support missionaries such as Daniel who sacrificed their former salaries to work on the mission field.
