

Chimbote Packing

- Soap & shampoo
- 1 or 2 small LED flashlights
- Snack food (see Required Reading)
- Any medications you may require.
- A small notebook and pen to record the events & names of the places visited.
- Kleenex, 1 roll of toilet paper & Handy Wipes.
- Candy for the children; individually wrapped; about 5 pounds if you have room.
- A good inexpensive watch and alarm clock.
- Motion sickness medication if needed.
- Money for souvenirs and offerings.
- Antiseptic gel to disinfect hands.
- Neosporin and Band-aids for small cuts.
- Name tags filled out on each piece of luggage. .
- Leave valuables such as credit cards, money, drivers license, etc., at home.
- Small pouch for carrying passport. Should go around neck and hang under clothes. You may also put your money in this. The pouches are available at Walmart in the travel section.
- 1 or 2 small zip-loc bags to keep passport, etc. dry.
- 2 or 3 kitchen sized garbage bags for dirty clothes, etc..
- Any money that you plan to spend in Peru should be in small denominations... 10's and 20's... **unmarked, clean bills. New bills if possible.**
- Please keep the clothing modest.

VERY IMPORTANT ITEMS

- Hair dryers, curling irons and etc., should be capable of switching from 110 to 220-240 volts. 110 will not work.

IMPORTANT IMPORTANT

- LIQUIDS including deodorant, tooth paste, perfume, hair spray, etc., can only be carried in your carry on under these very strict conditions. The containers must only be capable of holding 3 ounces. Note; A 4 oz container with 3 oz of liquid will not be permitted. You can only carry as many 3 oz containers as will fit in a 1 quart zip-loc bag. It must be in a zip-loc bag.
- LARGER AMOUNTS OF LIQUIDS MAY BE CARRIED IN YOUR CHECKED LUGGAGE! It is easier just to put ALL liquids in your checked luggage.
- You may not carry any knife or sharp instrument onto the aircraft. No matches or cigarette lighters. You may be arrested if you do so. You may put these items in your "checked luggage."
- No Laptop computers in checked luggage.
- Jokes about bombs and terrorism are expressly prohibited in airports and could cost you imprisonment and cause costly delays for the entire group.
