¹ Early on Sunday morning,
as the new day was dawning,
Mary Magdalene and
the other Mary went out to visit the tomb.

² Suddenly there was a great earthquake!
For an angel of the Lord came down
from heaven, rolled aside the stone,
and sat on it.

³ His face shone like lightning,
and his clothing was as white as snow.

⁴ The guards shook with fear when
they saw him, and they fell into
a dead faint.

⁵ Then the angel spoke to the women.

“Don’t be afraid!” he said.

“I know you are looking for Jesus,
who was crucified.

⁶ He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen.

Come, see where his body was lying.

⁷ And now, go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and he is going ahead of you to Galilee. You will see him there.

John 21 *NLT*

³ Simon Peter said, “I’m going fishing.”

“We’ll come, too,” they all said.

So they went out in the boat ...

⁴ At dawn Jesus was standing on the beach

They saw Him on the road

Mark 16 *NLT*

¹² Afterward he appeared ...
to two of his followers
who were walking from Jerusalem
into the country.

They saw Him on a mountain

Matthew 28 *NLT*

¹⁶ Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee,
going to the mountain
where Jesus had told them to go.

¹⁷ When they saw him, they worshiped him
—but some of them doubted!

They saw Him in a home

John 20 *NLT*

¹⁹ That Sunday evening the disciples were meeting behind locked doors because they were afraid of the Jewish leaders.

Suddenly, Jesus was standing there among them!

“Peace be with you,” he said.

They saw Him at the dinner table!

Luke 24 NLT

³⁰ As they sat down to eat,
he [Jesus] took the bread and blessed it.
Then he broke it and gave it to them.

³¹ Suddenly, their eyes were opened,
and they recognized him.

As the risen Lord, Jesus didn't show Himself:

- @ the Temple
- @ the synagogue
- @ church worship
- @ church meetings

Though he did promise to be there ...
