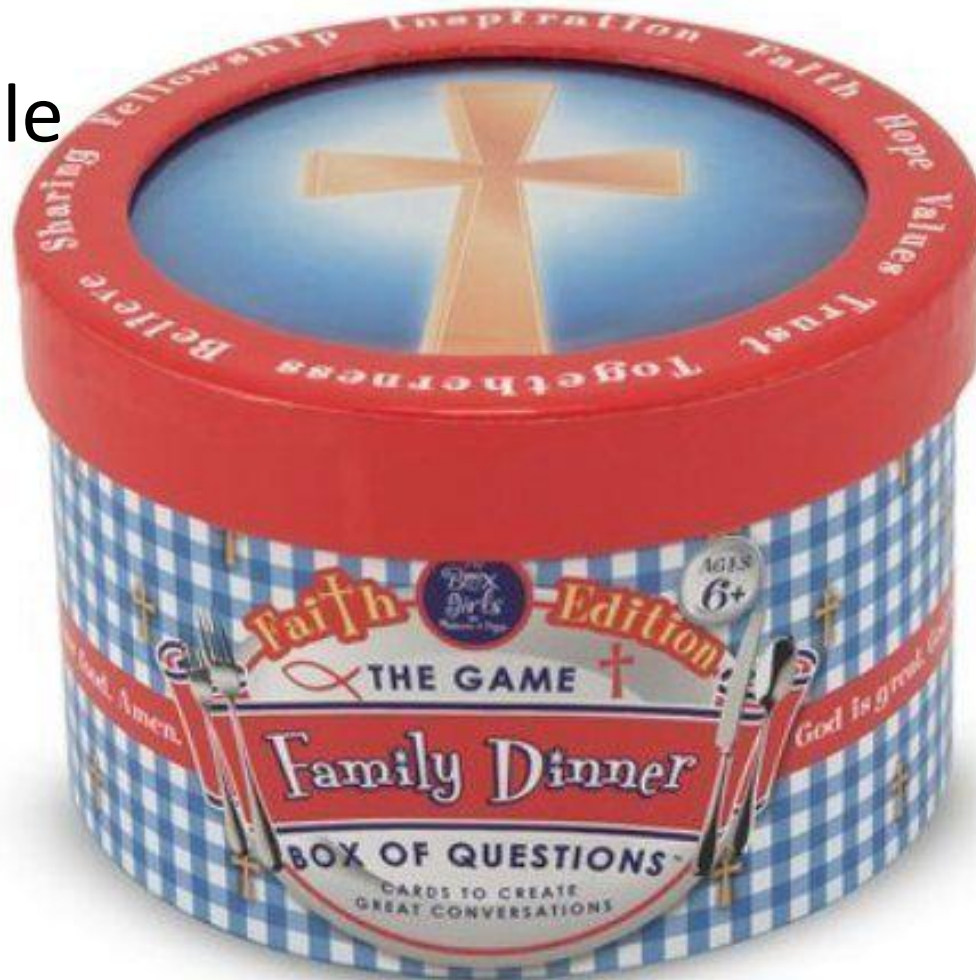

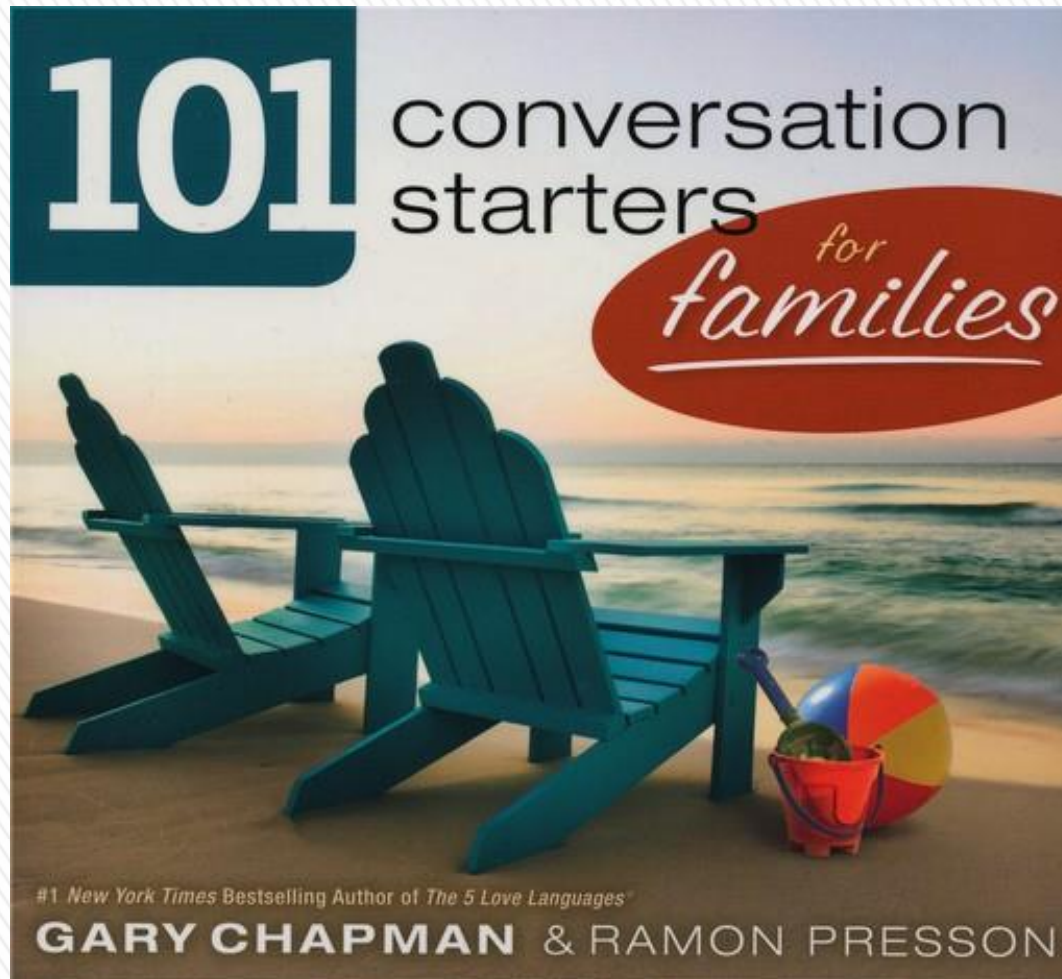

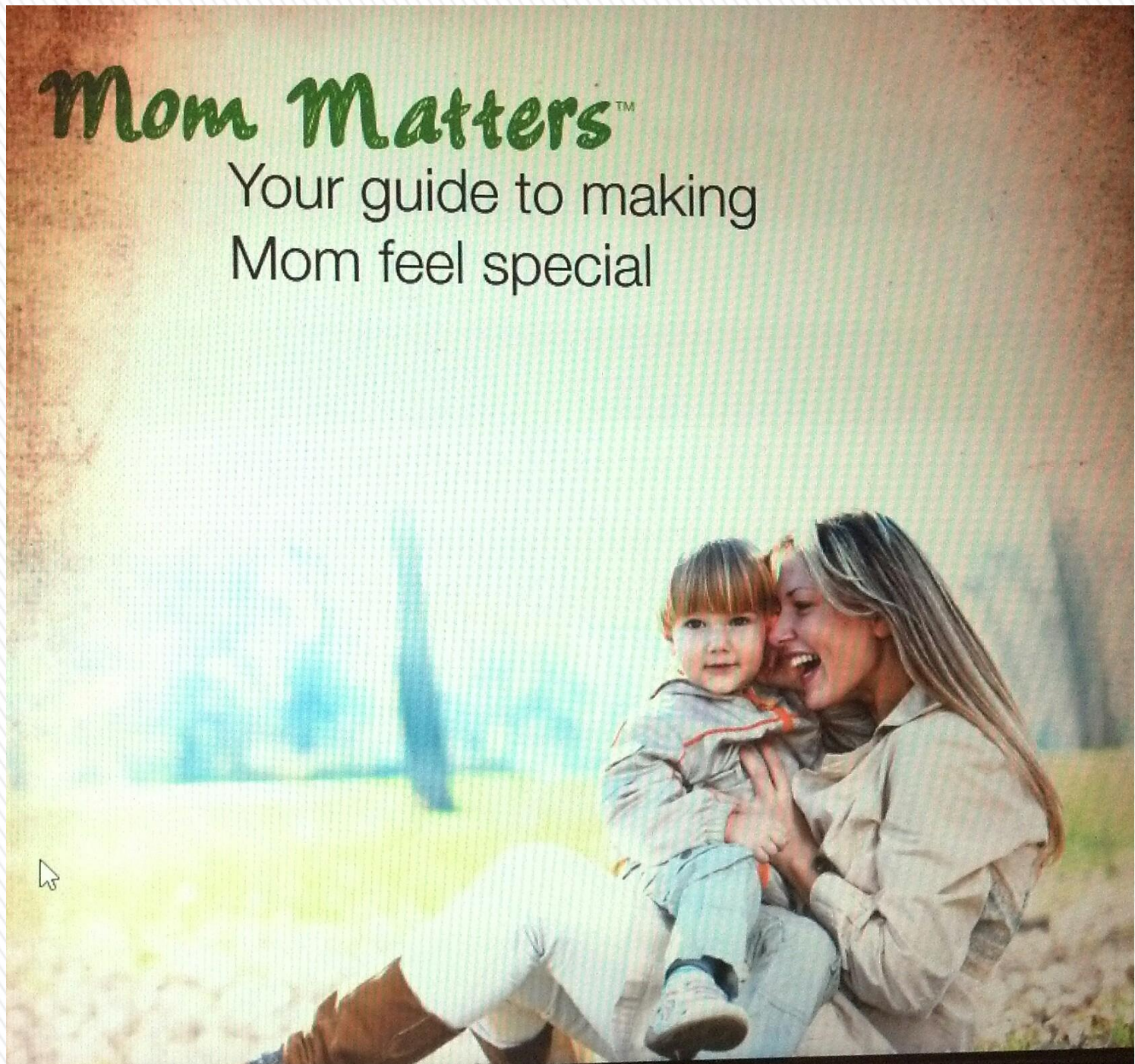

Salvation & Baptism (Age will vary.)
