Mary in Luke 1:26-38

26 ... God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, 27 to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary.

Joseph in Matthew 1:20-24

¹² Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured.

Church leaders in Antioch in Acts 13:1-3

- ¹ Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul.
- ² While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."
- ³ So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off.

+ praying

Jesus in the Olive Garden x3 in

Matthew 26:36-44

39 ... he fell with his face to the ground and prayed,"My Father, if it is possible,

"My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will."

+ testing Gideon in Judges 6:36-40 ³⁶ Gideon said to God, "If you will save Israel by my hand as you have promised— ³⁷ look, I will place a wool fleece on the threshing floor. If there is dew only on the fleece and all the ground is dry, then I will know that you will save Israel by my hand, as you said." ³⁸ And that is what happened. Gideon rose early the next day; he squeezed the fleece and wrung out the dew—a bowlful of water.

+ testing

Gideon in Judges 6:36-40 (continued)

39 Then Gideon said to God, "Do not be angry with me. Let me make just one more request. Allow me one more test with the fleece, but this time make the fleece dry and let the ground be covered with dew."

40 That night God did so. Only the fleece was dry; all the ground was covered with dew.

+testing

Galatians 5:16-25

¹⁶ So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.

+ testing

Galatians 5:16-25 (continued)

¹⁹ The acts of the flesh are obvious:

sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; ²⁰ idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions ²¹ and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like.

I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

+testing

Galatians 5:16-25 (continued)

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is

love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control.

²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.
