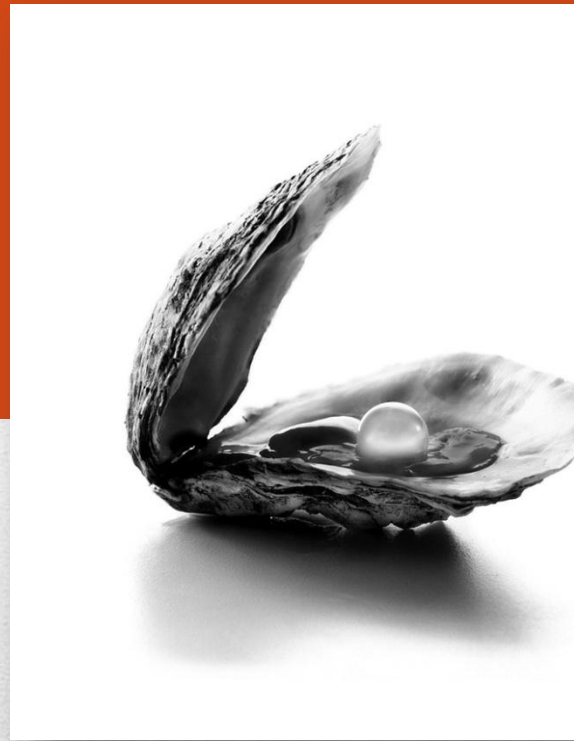


Imagine that you are at work:

¹⁹ “Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.”

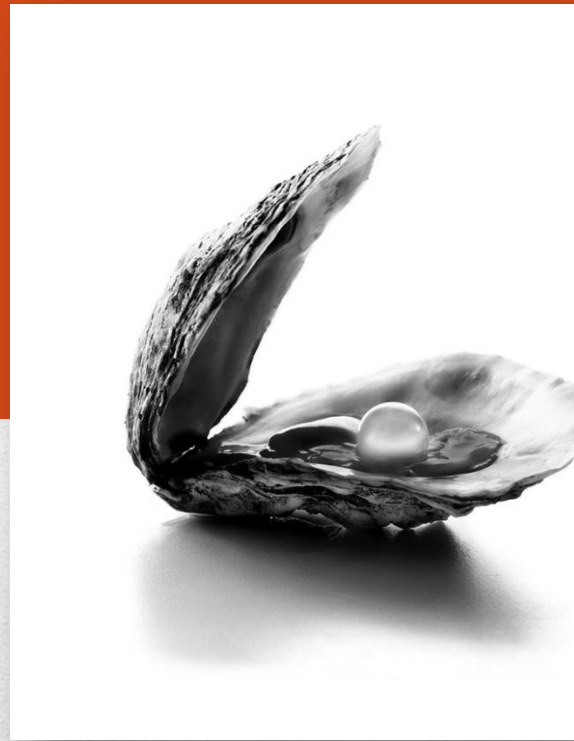
