## Acts 13:1-7, 12 NLT

<sup>1</sup> Among the prophets and teachers of the church at Antioch of Syria were Barnabas [*of Cyprus*], Simeon (called “the black man” [*from Niger*]), Lucius (from Cyrene [*Libya*]), Manaen (the childhood companion of King Herod Antipas [*raised in Rome, Italy*]), and Saul [*from Turkey*].

<sup>2</sup> One day as these men were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, “Dedicate Barnabas and Saul for the special work to which I have called them.”

<sup>3</sup> So after more fasting and prayer, the men laid their hands on them and sent them on their way.



## Acts 13:1-7, 12 NLT

<sup>4</sup> So Barnabas and Saul were sent out by the Holy Spirit. They went down to the seaport of Seleucia and then sailed for the island of Cyprus.

<sup>5</sup> There, in the town of Salamis, they went to the Jewish synagogues and preached the word of God. John Mark [*of Jerusalem*] went with them as their assistant.

to Tarsus to look for Saul.



## Acts 11 New Living Translation

<sup>26</sup> When he found him,  
he brought him back to Antioch.  
Both of them stayed there with  
the church for a full year,  
teaching large crowds of people.

(It was at Antioch that the believers  
were first called Christians.)
