8 Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. ⁹ For the commandments ... are summed up in this word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁰ Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

Galatians 5:14 ESV

 But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you"


FULFILLING COMMITMENTS TO OTHERS (continued) Hebrews 13:2-3 ESV
