Romans 8:3-4 ESV

**³ For God has done what the law,
weakened by the flesh, could not do.
By sending his own Son ... ⁴ in order that
the righteous requirement of the law
might be fulfilled in us,
who walk not according to the flesh
but according to the Spirit.**

Romans 13:8-10 ESV

**8 Owe no one anything,
except to love each other,
for the one who loves another
has fulfilled the law.**

**9 For the commandments ...
are summed up in this word:
“You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”**

**10 Love does no wrong to a neighbor;
therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.**

Galatians 5:14 *ESV*

**For the whole law is fulfilled in one word:
“You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”**

**21 submitting to one another
out of reverence for Christ.**

**22 Wives, submit to your own husbands,
as to the Lord...**

**25 Husbands, love your wives,
as Christ loved the church
and gave himself up for her**

FULFILLING COMMITMENTS AS PARENTS

Matthew 5: 22 *ESV*

**“²² But I say to you that everyone
who is angry...
will be liable to judgment;
whoever insults ... will be liable
to the council;
and whoever says, ‘You fool!’
will be liable to the hell of fire.”**

FULFILLING COMMITMENTS AS PARENTS (continued) Colossians 3:20-22 *ESV*

**20 Children, obey your parents
in everything,
for this pleases the Lord.**

**21 Fathers, do not provoke your children,
lest they become discouraged.**

FULFILLING COMMITMENTS AS PARENTS (again) Titus 2:2-6 *ESV*

**² Older men are to be sober-minded,
dignified, self-controlled...**

**⁶ Likewise, urge the younger men
to be self-controlled.**

**³ Older women likewise are to be reverent
in behavior ...**

**⁴ and so train the young women
to love their husbands and children**

FULFILLING COMMITMENTS AT WORK

Matthew 5: 33 *ESV*

**33 “Again you have heard that
it was said to those of old,
‘You shall not swear falsely’”**

FULFILLING COMMITMENTS AT WORK (continued) Colossians 3:23-24 *ESV*

**23 Whatever you do, work heartily,
as for the Lord and not for men,**

**24 knowing that from the Lord
you will receive the inheritance
as your reward.**

You are serving the Lord Christ.

FULFILLING COMMITMENTS TO OTHERS

Matthew 5: 43-44 *ESV*

**43 “You have heard that it was said,
‘You shall love your neighbor and
hate your enemy.’**

**44 But I say to you, Love your enemies
and pray for those who persecute you”**

FULFILLING COMMITMENTS TO OTHERS (continued) Hebrews 13:2-3 ESV

² Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

³ Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated

(again) James 1:27 *ESV*

**27 Religion that is pure and
undefiled before God, the Father, is this:
to visit orphans and widows
in their affliction ...**
