JOHN 10:1-11 ESV

¹ “Truly, truly, I say to you,
he who does not enter the sheepfold
by the door but climbs in by another way,
that man is a thief and a robber.

² But he who enters by the door is the shepherd
of the sheep.

JOHN 10:1-11 ESV

³ To him the gatekeeper opens.

The sheep hear his voice,
and he calls his own sheep by name
and leads them out.

⁴ When he has brought out all his own,
he goes before them,
and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.

JOHN 10:1-11 ESV

⁵ A stranger they will not follow,
but they will flee from him,
for they do not know the voice of strangers.”

⁶ This figure of speech Jesus used with them,
but they did not understand what he was saying
to them.

JOHN 10:1-11 ESV

⁷ So Jesus again said to them,

“Truly, truly, I say to you,

I am the door of the sheep.

⁸ All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them.

⁹ I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.

John 10:10 ESV

¹⁰ The thief comes only
to steal and kill and destroy...

SAVED FOR

John 10:10 ESV

¹⁰ I came that they may have life
and have it abundantly.

ACTION STEP #1

TURN THE LIGHT ON

John 8:12 ESV

¹² ... “I am the light of the world.

Whoever follows me

will not walk in darkness,

but will have the light of life.”

ACTION STEP #2

READ THE BOOK

John 20:30-31 ESV

³⁰ Now Jesus did many other signs
in the presence of the disciples,
which are not written in this book;

³¹ but these are written so that you may believe
that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God,
and that by believing
you may have life in his name.

ACTION STEP #3

GRASP GOD'S WILL

John 6:40 ESV

⁴⁰ For this is the will of my Father,
that everyone who looks on the Son
and believes in him should have eternal life,
and I will raise him up on the last day.”

ACTION STEP #4

EAT IT ALL UP

John 4:14 ESV

¹⁴ but whoever drinks of
the water that I will give him
will never be thirsty again.

The water that I will give him
will become in him a spring of water
welling up to eternal life.”

ACTION STEP #4 (CONTINUED)

EAT IT ALL UP

John 6:35 ESV

³⁵ ... “I am the bread of life;
whoever comes to me
shall not hunger,
and whoever believes in me
shall never thirst.

RISE UP

John 11:25 ESV

²⁵ ... “I am the resurrection and the life.

Whoever believes in me,
though he die, yet shall he live
