



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

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Luke 24:13-35 edited TNIV

13 ... two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem.

¹⁵ As they talked ... with each other, Jesus himself came up and walked along with them; ¹⁶ but they were kept from recognizing him.

¹⁷ He asked them, "What are you discussing?" They stood still, their faces downcast. ¹⁸ One of them, named Cleopas ... replied 19 ... "About Jesus of Nazareth.

20 The chief priests and our rulers handed him over to be ... crucified ... 21 but we had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel ...

22 In addition, some of our women amazed us. They went to the tomb early this morning 23 but didn't find his body... "

27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

28 As they approached the village to which they were going, Jesus continued on as if he were going farther. 29 But they urged him strongly, "Stay with us,

29 "...for it is nearly evening; the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them. 30 When he was at the table with them, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it and began to give it to them.

31 Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight.

32 They asked each other,

32 "... Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?" 33 They got up and returned at once to Jerusalem ...



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


(5) compelling circumstantial evidence


