1<sup>st</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>?


1<sup>st</sup> because shortest?

some from Luke?

Mark could have been 3<sup>rd</sup>,  
using both  
Matthew and Luke


Was Mark

who made them.

# “10 Indications a Church is Making Disciples”

1) Those who have been in the church the longest complain the least.

-- *Philippians 2:14*

# “10 Indications a Church is Making Disciples”

2) Members care that others needs are met more than their own.

-- *Philippians 2:4*

# “10 Indications a Church is Making Disciples”

3) The church is willing to make sacrifices to attract those not there yet.

-- *Acts 15:19*

# “10 Indications a Church is Making Disciples”

4) The financial needs of the church are funded, with people willingly sacrificing. No one begs for money. -- *2Cor 9:7*

# “10 Indications a Church is Making Disciples”

6) The leaders of the church are most likely to give up “their” seats, park farther from the building, or do whatever is necessary to help the Body. -- *Matthew 23:11*
