

We have four of our FBC members in this facility and they asked if there was anyway we could continue teaching Sunday School to them. At the time, we were only allowed to be outside the building but we started the class. We were outside the window and they were inside. As the time progressed, other residents began to ask our FBC ladies if they could come to the class. Our ladies said of course. Since then our members have continued to increase and we are now able to meet together in person. Most weeks we have between 13 to 18 people in attendance. Some are from different denominations but what a blessing to study God's word together. The church has allowed us to have extra copies of the Sunday School material to pass out. Many tell us how thankful they are for the class and the study materials. They have shared that they are passing them on to other residents and to their family members.

We are thankful for the witness of our FBC ladies and other faithful Christians there who are willing to let God use them for His purpose, as they pray, encourage and share Christ. Pray for them and this ministry.

We have also been asked to come back to another of our senior care centers to do a weekly 30—45 minutes singing and devotional time with their residents. This usually was on a weekday afternoon. We will need volunteers to come and join with the residents in worship. So many residents long for this time of worship and visiting with others from the outside. Participation will bring blessings.



Walking Down the "Romans Road" to Salvation....
