

## Lesson 6 Answers - Salvation

### I. God's Sovereignty in Salvation

#### A. God's sovereign plan of salvation

1. Verse 29: whom He foreknew  
He also predestined

Verse 30: whom He predestined  
He also called

Verse 30: whom He called  
He also justified

Verse 30: whom He justified  
He also glorified

2. a. That we should be holy and blameless before Him.  
b. to the praise and glory of His grace

#### B. God implements His plan of salvation

1. dead in trespasses and sin
2. He will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgement.
3. repentance
4. God
5. God
6. *God* was causing the growth
7. *God* has not only raised the Lord Jesus, but will also raise us up through His power.

#### C. God culminates His plan

1. The image of His Son, Jesus Christ
2. We will be transformed into conformity with the body of Christ's glory.
3. I desire that they also, whom you have given Me, be with Me where I am, so that they may see My glory which You have given Me.

### II. Conversion

#### A. Conviction of sin

1. Knowledge of sin through Moses' teachings, the Law
2. Deeply upset and asked Peter what they should do.

## B. Repentance from sin

1. He knew he was a sinner.
2. a. repentance  
b. salvation

## C. Turning to Christ

1. Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved.
2. a. Jesus as Lord  
b. Believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead.

## D. Becoming slaves to righteousness

- 1.a. There is no commendation for those who believe in Jesus Christ.  
b. the law of sin and death
2. slaves to righteous living
3. You are sanctified. "Now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life."

## III. Evidence of Salvation

### A. What reveals genuine faith?

- 1.a. one's works  
b. trials; tested by fire
2. good works
3. Do good work to be an example to others.

### B. Love and labors

1. "God is not unjust; He will not forget your work and the love you have shown Him as you have helped His people and continue to help them."
2. "The love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit."
3. "Beloved, let us *love one another*, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God."
4. "Let us not love with word or with tongue, but *in deed and truth*."

### C. Hope that endures

1. "It is the one who has endured to the end who will be saved."
2. "We have fixed our hope on the living God, who is the Savior."
- 3.a. the hope of righteousness  
b. the hope of salvation  
c. the hope of eternal life

D. The three that abide

1. their faith in Christ
2. their love for all the saints (God's people)
3. their trust in the hope laid up for them in heaven

IV. Application

A. Be holy and perfect before God

B. "Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. Do not offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God, as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer the parts of your body to Him as instruments of righteousness.
