Progress is being made on the finalization of the plans to finish the downstairs and add the bathroom to the narthex. Subcontractors and the architect have visited the church in the last week to measure and assess their pieces. Once the plans are ready and we approve them, they will be submitted to the city of Northglenn for their approval, after which the work will begin. Dick Kelly and Paul Coleman are also working on options for improving the condition the parking lot. We don't have an exact timeline but will let you know as we have more information. Please know that we are working on this. Thank you all for your continued patience.
