

## **Eligibility Requirements for Grant**

1. Requests for funding must be for a program involving more than one congregation within the geographic boundaries of Newton Presbytery. Interfaith and Ecumenical projects involving one or more Presbyterian congregation will be considered.
2. Projects must begin within one year of application.
3. An evaluation of the project and how resources were used will be expected upon completion of the project and/or within one year of receiving EMMCO support.
4. Funding will be year to year. Maximum grant application request is \$2,000

### **Please answer the following questions on a separate paper.**

1. What is the nature of the project and what do you envision it will do, how it will function?
2. What is your expected time frame for the project? *Project should begin within the year of application*
3. What other congregations or Presbytery entities are involved in the project?
4. Are you aware of anyone else doing this kind of project in your area? If so have you made any effort to work with them? (explain)
5. How many people do you expect be involved in your project?
6. What resources are necessary in order to carry out the project?
7. What resources do you already have available for your program?
8. Where are your resources coming from? (members, congregations, etc.)
9. What resources are you requesting? *(i.e. use of Presbytery name, staff support and/or funding)*
10. How does the project fit with the vision and priorities of the Presbytery? (see attached)
11. Who will be accounting for the grant? Please include to whom the check, if grant is approved, should be made out to.
