Preference is given to first-time AE attendees. | October 15 | Include two letters of recommendation with application. Number of scholarships awarded annually may vary. |
| Retired Educators | Pays for early bird registration for the AE (cost of APCE membership not included). | Awarded to Christian Educators who have been a member of APCE ten years or more. Preference is given to applicants from the region where the AE will occur. | October 15 | One scholarship awarded annually. Recipients may receive this scholarship once only. |
| Current Member Scholarship | Pays for early bird registration for the AE (cost of APCE membership not included). | Consideration given: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First to part-time church educators, • Then to full-time church educators. | October 15 | Up to six scholarships awarded annually. No more than one scholarship awarded in any region. Recipients may receive this scholarship once only. |
| Small Church (A small church is defined by an average of 100 or fewer people in attendance in worship.) | Pays for early bird registration for the AE (cost of APCE membership not included). | Preference is given to Educators, volunteer or professional. Preference is given to first-time AE attendees. | October 15 | Up to ten scholarships awarded annually. |
| Regional Scholarship | Pays for early bird registration for the AE (cost of APCE membership not included). | First-time attendee of Annual Event. Preference given to multi-cultural/ethnic applicants. | October 15 | Up to fourteen scholarships awarded annually. Marketplace income helps to fund this award. |

Applicants must be currently enrolled in their denomination's certification process. Preference is given to first-time AE or PC(USA) GA attendees.</p> | <p>October 15</p> | <p>Up to six scholarships awarded annually.</p> |
| <p>Global Partnership</p> | <p>Reimbursable for approved expenses up to \$1750 to help with the Global Partner's total expenses**:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For registration (cost of APCE membership not included), • Transportation, • And lodging and food for the Annual Event (AE). | <p>Awarded to international participants, preferably participants affiliated with one of APCE's partner denominations, from countries outside the U.S.A. and Canada. Preference is given to first-time attendees.</p> | <p>June 1</p> | <p>Include with application a letter of recommendation from a church governing body (for example: from a pastor who serves a church or agency from a partner denomination) and an attending sponsor. Up to two scholarships may be awarded annually.</p> |
