Current Member Scholarship	Pays for flat rate registration for the AE (cost of APCE membership not included).	Consideration given: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First to part-time church educators, • Then to full-time church educators. 	October 15	Up to six scholarships awarded annually. No more than one scholarship awarded in any region. Recipients may receive this scholarship once only.
Small Church (A small church is defined by an average of 100 or fewer people in attendance in worship.)	Pays for flat rate registration for the AE (cost of APCE membership not included).	Preference is given to Educators, volunteer or professional. Preference is given to first-time AE attendees.	October 15	Up to ten scholarships awarded annually.
Regional Scholarship	Pays for flat rate registration for the AE (cost of APCE membership not included).	First-time attendee of Annual Event. Preference given to multi-cultural/ethnic applicants.	October 15	Up to fourteen scholarships awarded annually. Marketplace income helps to fund this award.
