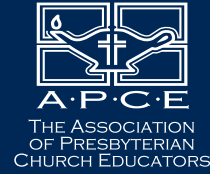

# Welcome to APCE Annual Event 2020 Little Rock

## Parking Information

Parking for APCE Annual Event participants who choose not to valet park at the hotel is available in two main parking decks managed and operated by the Little Rock Convention and Visitors Bureau.

**Convention Center Parking:** 201 Main St., Little Rock, AR, 72201 (a block from the Marriott)

**Robinson Center Parking:** 424 West Markham St., Little Rock, AR, 72201 (under the Doubletree, a block from the Marriott)

APCE Annual Event participants are able to receive a discounted parking rate of \$6.00 per car/per day or per exit with a parking ticket validated with APCE’s parking stamp, available in the Statehouse Convention Center Rotunda near Registration. **A separate APCE-stamped validated parking ticket is needed each time you enter and exit the parking deck.** It is \$6.00 for each entrance and exit.

Be sure to download the APCE App! The webmaster will be available in the Statehouse Rotunda near the Registration Desk to offer any needed assistance, Tuesday afternoon–Thursday, during registration hours.

Please note that while you can update your personal schedule on the App, this does not change your registration. All workshop changes must be made at the Registration Desk.

## Children Are Welcome!

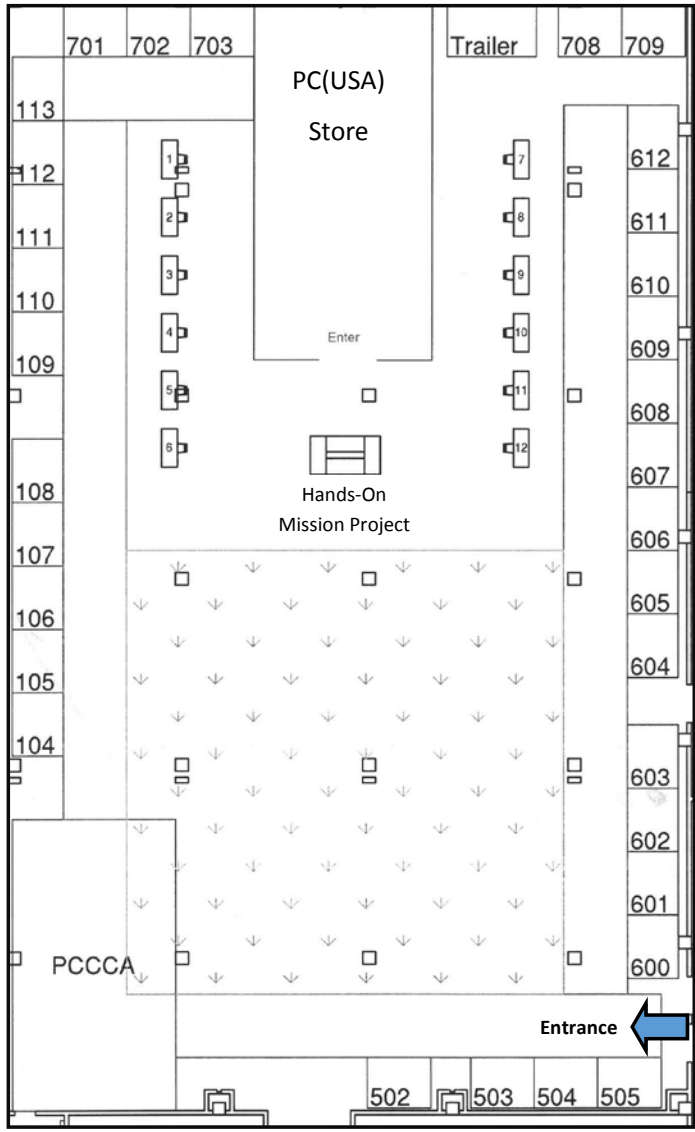

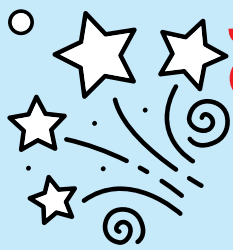

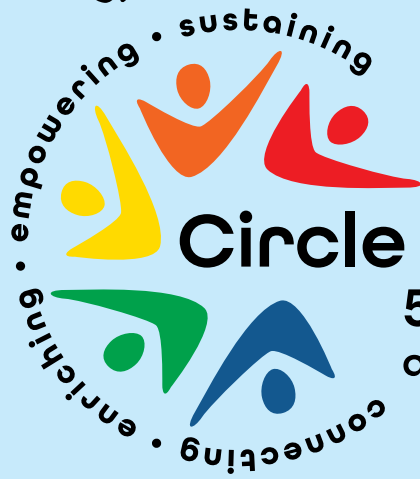
