


VACATION CREDIT POLICY

Each family is entitled to 1 vacation credit per calendar year. A vacation credit enables you to pay 1/2 of your session tuition for 1 session (your child will only be eligible to do 1/2 their classes during that session). You must notify the front office if you will be using a vacation credit prior to the start of the session.

MAKE-UP POLICY

Students are entitled to a maximum of 1 make-up class per session. If you miss 2 or more classes, only 1 make-up may be scheduled. Your child must have missed a class before scheduling a make-up. Your child must be currently enrolled in a class in order to attend a make-up class. Make-up classes must be done within 1 session of the missed class. 24 hour notification is required to schedule & reschedule make-up classes.

PARKING POLICY

The driveway at Island Tumblers is reserved for pick up and drop off only, **please do not park or wait in the driveway**. Parking in the ITG lot is limited and is reserved for short term (1-hr. max) only. Parking in other businesses lots or driveways is strictly prohibited. ITG is not responsible for any damage to vehicles when parked or if any vehicles are towed. We are in an industrial zone so park at your own risk.
