Thank you for participating in the 2018 AAU Spring State Championships in Daytona Beach, Florida at the Ocean Center.

Parent Information:

- Session times are very close together. Please arrive early enough to park, get to the Ocean Center and find your athletes competition floor. This process usually takes 15 extra minutes.
- Parking is directly behind the Ocean Center.
- The door fee will be \$16.00/9 years and older, \$8.00/ages 3-8. Children under 3 are free of charge. Weekend pass available for \$28/\$12. The door fee is CASH ONLY and exact change is much appreciated.
- The results will be posted on Team Florida Website by 5pm on Tuesday, April 17, 2017.
- There are many restaurants and shopping opportunities nearby.
- Please remember there will be NO flash photography as it is not SAFE for our athletes.
- Lightning City Merchandising will be the vendor of the championships.
- If the session before your competition time ends early, the next session will start immediately, so please arrive in the Ocean Center 15 minutes prior to your scheduled stretch time with the exception of the first session of each day.
- If you have questions prior to the competition, please CONTACT your coach and they will contact the meet directors for you.
- THE SESSION with “Z” division athletes will be competing for the coveted “All American” award. It is given to the highest all-around score for each level and each age group in the level. So, if there are 48 athletes in the “Z” division within a level, there will be 4 All Americans awarded for that level. This makes the competition for the highest all around athletes more competitive as they have earned the opportunity to compete for the All American based on their all-around scores they earned at the qualifiers before state.
- Please remember to tell your coach that you are interested in Age Group Nationals which is June 28-July 1, 2018 at The Tampa Convention Center.
