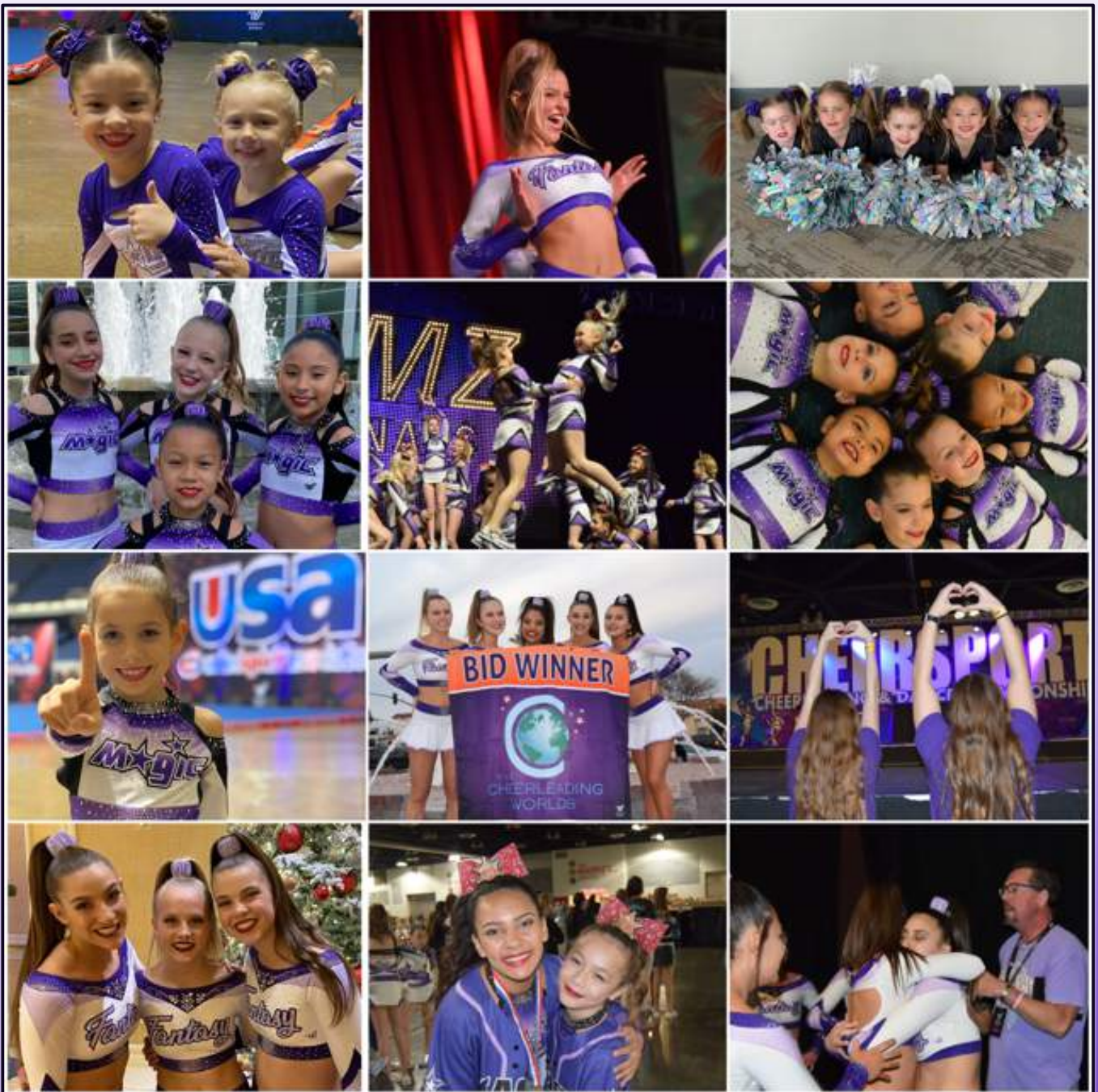

COVID 19 RESPONSES

We are diligently working to provide a program that is taking into consideration the current state of affairs. We understand that athletes have not been able to work out traditionally in almost 2 months, gyms have been closed and families have been affected in multiple ways due to this pandemic. We're here to tell you that we understand. We have revised our season to make it more affordable (Same uniform, 1 practice set, smart decisions in regards to our events which include limited travel and extra expenses) We have also reduced our Assessment fees to 8 monthly payments rather than 9 to give an extra month of relief in the beginning of the season. We are excited to offer some unique ways to help alleviate the financial burdens that a traditional cheer season can bring. We will continue to stay up to date on the health and safety procedures to keep our athletes our priority and are happy to discuss any concerns you may have.

TRYOUT PROCESS

Our tryout process will look a little different this year. We will be doing individual or pairs for tryouts now through May 31st. We feel this will give us the opportunity to properly evaluate each athlete, give them the extra time if needed to perform a skill multiple times as well as conduct what is normally a large group event into a smaller, safer event for everyone. We will take into consideration that athletes have been out of the gym for 6-8 weeks. Hand washing will be required prior to entering the gym.

VIEWING ROOMS

Our gym is sanitized and cleaned multiple times a day and our staff is following strict sanitary practices both inside and outside of the gym. In an effort to eliminate group gatherings in small areas, our viewing rooms will be closed to spectators until further notice. There are several places outside that you are able to watch from your car and still view the inside of the gym and we are exploring other unique options to give better sight into the gym for spectators. We will continue to make decisions that keep our athletes and staff in a safe and healthy environment.

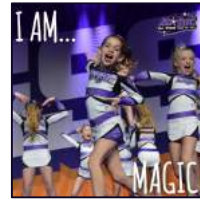

COMMON QUESTIONS

Who is the USASF?

The USASF is the governing body for All-Star Cheerleading. All gyms, coaches and athletes must have a current membership with the USASF in order to participate in USASF sanctioned events. A \$30 membership fee is due to the USASF for each athlete's registration.

What are the 2020/2021 division options?

There will be 4 categories offered in the 20/21 Season. FUNdamentals, Novice, Prep and Elite. Prep is becoming a very competitive and popular option in our industry. It offers a lower commitment level both financially and in time.

How do you form a team?

When cheerleaders are placed on teams after tryouts, it is done in the best interest of the child, the team and the program. We create our teams based on the athletes who attend tryouts and group them with like skilled and aged athletes. Each athlete contributes to the team in different ways so we use a method of multiple skill categories to evaluate and form the best teams possible. Our tryouts are basically like a low stress work out. Athletes will be able to perform their skills and demonstrate the potential to learn new skills. We will give our athletes multiple opportunities to showcase their abilities.

If any athlete is not maintaining the skill level they had during tryouts, it is at the discretion of the staff to call a meeting with the parent and move an athlete to a more level appropriate team.

COMMON QUESTIONS CONT'D

When do practices start?

Our planned start date is June 1-2. June and July will be modified to allow safe numbers in the gym as well as proper conditioning and training to get everyone back on track. All online registrations and down payments must be completed in order for your athlete to participate in practice.

What is the commitment for the team?

Our teams are a year round commitment. Competition season begins in November and runs through the beginning of May for our Elite Teams and through the middle of April for our other teams. It is not advisable to have your athlete involved in other sports or time consuming activities. We expect **Magic All-Stars** to be the priority once you sign your team contract for the season.



What does my cheerleader need to wear to practice?

Practice clothing is included with your **Magic All-Stars** assessment fees. Clothing will be handed out in August and all athletes are **REQUIRED** to wear their assigned gear to practice. Hair must be worn in a high ponytail with the correct practice bow or scrunchie, cheer shoes & **NO JEWELRY** at any time.

What if my child misses practice?

All absences should be called in or emailed to our office prior to the missed practice. Extreme illness, family emergencies or graded events are the **ONLY** excused absences. If your cheerleader misses a practice the week prior to any competition or two weeks prior to a major National Competition, the staff has the option to replace them for that competition. Your athlete is granted 3 unexcused absences before they are put on probation. These fines will be enforced if absences occur outside of the excused absence policy. The credit card on file will be automatically charged without notice.

FINES and FEES

\$25 LATE FEE will be applied on the 8th of each month for late tuition/assessment payments.

\$25 RETURNED CHECK FEE

\$50 MISSED PRACTICE FEE will be assessed for missing practice the week of any competition or two weeks prior to any national competition.

\$500 TERMINATION OF TEAM CONTRACT will be assessed for quitting, leaving or being removed from the team for any reason after the start of the season. (June 1, 2020)

NO REFUNDS will be given for any paid fees including tuition, assessments, uniforms, practice gear, shoes, team dues etc for any reason including injury or illness. Any items ordered become the property of Magic All-Stars if an athlete quits or is removed from the team.

What about the summer months?

Summer months are geared towards perfecting your current skills for the upcoming season. We use the summer months to build our routines and strengthen our skills. Summer vacations are granted when a vacation request form is turned in by June 15th and as long as it does not interfere with any mandatory summer events. It is at the discretion of the staff to move athletes based on excessive absences during the summer months. If you are planning your vacations, we ask that you coordinate them with our Summer vacation dates. **MAGIC'S SUMMER VACATION DATES** JUNE 28-July5 AUGUST 2-9

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COMMON QUESTIONS CONT'D

How do I pay my monthly fees?

AUTOMATIC BANK DRAFT (preferred) or CREDIT CARD WITHDRAWAL is required for all team members. Accounts will be automatically charged on the 1st of each month for the tuition payment and assessment payment. If you choose to pay your account with an alternate form of payment, the credit card on file is still required however your account will be placed on a manual payment status. A \$25 late fee will be applied on the 8th of each month to all delinquent accounts. If a credit card transaction is declined, payment is due within 7 days to avoid a late fee. In the event that your account becomes delinquent, you drop from **MAGIC ALL-STARS** or receive a fine or charge, the card or account on file will be charged. Visa and Mastercard are the only credit cards that will be accepted for the 2020-2021 season.

Extra fees such as uniform, shoes, etc must be paid by cash or check. If a credit card payment is necessary, a service fee of 3% will be added to the charge.

Do you offer any discounts?

MILITARY DISCOUNTS will be offered in the amount of \$20 Off the monthly tuition fees.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS will be offered to the 2nd and 3rd sibling in the amount of **25% off** their monthly tuition. Sibling discounts apply to siblings billed to the same account and the discount is taken off the lower tuition. No discount is given off the down payment, assessment fees or any other fees.

DISCOUNTS DO NOT APPLY to Tiny Teams, Mini Prep Teams, International Athletes or Male Athletes. Sibling discounts only apply to Youth, Junior, Senior Prep Teams, Elite Teams and Worlds Teams. If a family qualifies for more than 1 tuition discount, the higher discount will be given. Only one tuition discount per family. (ie...sibling discount or military discount)

TEAM TUMBLING DISCOUNTS will be offered to current team members. Tumbling classes will be offered at a 50% Discount. (The normal tumbling class fee is \$70, stretch class \$60, flight school \$80 no discount)

LOYALTY CREDITS are being offered to returning **Magic All-Stars** team athletes off their initial down payment. Loyalty credits range from \$25-\$75 depending on the team.

FUNDRAISING

We have multiple families who pay for their ENTIRE season through our fundraising options. We offer small monthly options which include Cookie Dough, Sees, Popcorn, Mixed Bags etc but our most profitable fundraisers are working the concession stands at MLB Baseball & NFL Football games and concerts. (Angels, Rams, Five Points Amphitheatre) Ranging from \$50-\$300 per event. MUST be 18 years old and trained. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PAY OUT OF POCKET FOR CHEER! If you're willing to work...these events can help cover your entire season. The program director of these fundraisers has stated that these venues are making plans to begin but it is with the understanding that everything is tentative until further notice.

Will Magic All-Stars accept Summit Bids?

We have decided moving forward that our policy will be to only accept PAID BIDS. If your team is awarded a PAID BID, we will then discuss and consider the opportunity of attending Summit. We have an amazing line up of competitions scheduled for the 2021 season and can't wait to share them with you!



IMPORTANT DATES

The safety of our athletes, staff and families is of the utmost importance to us. All dates and prices are reflective of our optimistic assumption that the season will begin as planned in the tryout packet. If the situation or governmental mandates require that we change these dates, we will adjust the information as needed.

{FEES and PAYMENTS}

Monthly Fees are due on the 1st of each month and if not paid by the 7th, a \$25 late fee will be applied. Invoices will be emailed on the 25th of the prior month. Please review it for errors and notify the office immediately. Your fees (or balance due) will be deducted from your credit card or checking account on the 1st of each month. If a student changes or drops a class, the office needs to be notified with the official 4 week drop notice form available online and in the waiting room files. All customers are required to have their monthly fees charged to a credit card or withdrawn through a bank draft. Your credit card information will be held on file and secured.

If a customer would like to use an alternate form of payment (check or cash) they may do so but all due dates apply and late fees will be applied if payment isn't received by the 7th. A \$25 service charge will be added if your check is returned unpaid. If checks are returned multiple times, an alternate form of payment will be required for all future payments. A credit card/bank account on file is still required for all accounts.

{NO REFUNDS}

Under no circumstances will a refund be issued for any collected or paid fees. (injury, illness, team changes, quitting, absences etc)

{NO REFUNDS CONT'D}

If your athlete quits and you paid your season's fees in full, that amount (less the \$500 cancellation of contract fee if applicable) will be held in your **MAGIC** account for future use on future **MAGIC** fees. (classes, teams, etc) A refund in the form of cash, check or credit **WILL NOT** be given and is not transferrable.

{CURRENT BALANCES}

All students must be cleared at a zero balance with **MAGIC ALL-STARS** in order to sign up for private lessons, classes or other special events. Members must be cleared at a zero balance 7 days prior to an event in order to perform. We reserve the right to pull an athlete from any performance if the account is delinquent.

{TERMINATION OF CONTRACT}

There is a **\$500 TERMINATION OF CONTRACT** fine for any child that quits, is removed or violates our guidelines anytime between June 1, 2020 to the end of the competition season (April 30, 2021). All work out gear, shoes, uniform or other items ordered are forfeited upon termination.

{FINES}

\$50 Missed Practice Fines may be assessed for athletes missing practices the week of a competition or 2 weeks prior to a National Event. Replacement for that competition is possible.

{PAST DUE ACCOUNTS}

After an athlete quits or the season is over, all accounts with past due balances will be referred to our **Collection Department**. A 10-day demand for payment notice will be sent requesting final payment.

{PROMOTIONAL USE}

MAGIC ALL-STARS reserves the right to use picture and first names for promo, advertising or website purposes. Any person who does not want their name and/or picture to be used must do so in writing at the time of tryouts.

{PRIVATE LESSONS}

Private Lessons are scheduled directly with each individual instructor but must be signed in and paid on the day of service. In order to participate in a private lesson, your account must be at a zero balance. We require that all private lessons be in good standing with the gym, have a current waiver and a paid yearly registration fee. We encourage our athletes to take group lessons in conjunction with private lessons. This policy ensures our athletes will see great progress from team coaches and our team tumbling coaches.

{SAFETY}

Athletes are not allowed on the gym floor unless they are enrolled in a class, taking a private or attending their team work out. They must wait in the designated waiting area until their instructor calls them out.

{AFTER HOURS}

MAGIC ALL-STARS is not a babysitting service and athletes should not be dropped off early, left at the gym during non-practice hours or after the practice time is over.

{CONFRONTATIONS}

Confrontations of any kind are not to be discussed in the presence of **MAGIC ALL-STARS** students or other parents or spectators. Please schedule a meeting with our owner.

{NON DISCRIMINATORY}

We strongly believe in the benefit of our students getting to know athletes from other areas, different races and other cultures. We do not discriminate against students based on race, background or religious preference. **MAGIC ALL-STARS** is a family owned business and our core values will be shared with our athletes. This may include praying before and after practice and events, biblical principles and verses.

MAGIC ALL-STARS LOGO and TEAM NAMES...

We do not allow anyone to recreate or use our Logo, Name or Team Names on any non-official **MAGIC** item. We will NOT authorize the use to anyone other than our official spirit gear providers. Any improper use will result in termination of use. We reserve the right for **MAGIC ALL-STARS** use only.



MAGIC ATHLETE POLICIES

{MANDATORY EVENTS}

All practices, choreography, camps and competitions are mandatory.

{SUMMER VACATION}

Summer vacation requests may be turned in by June 15th to your coaches for approval however dates falling on mandatory events or after Labor Day will be considered unexcused.

Summer Vacation #1 June 28-July 5
Summer Vacation #2 August 8-16

{WORK-OUT WEAR}

All team members are expected to wear the proper work out gear and Varsity shoes. We will place three shoe orders in which you can order a pair. June, August and October. All Elite Teams will be wearing Custom **Magic All-Stars** shoes. You will have the option to choose low or high top. All team members must wear Varsity.

Each athlete will receive their official workout gear in the month of July or August and until that time can wear any work out wear. We ask that other gym logoed work out wear not be worn to **Magic All-Stars**. Extra items may be purchased for those athletes wanting an extra set or item.

{UNIFORM}

All team members are required to purchase a properly fitted uniform. **DUE on July 15, 2020.**

{FITTINGS}

Our Varsity uniform representative will fit each cheerleader for their uniform items (motion flex top, skirt, and warm up jacket) during the months of June or July. We will be keeping our uniforms this season. If yours fits, GREAT!! You are welcome to bring it in if you'd like us to look at it on your athlete. We have some great tips on making it work for an extra season!

{ORDERS} Uniforms are considered a "special order" and are non-refundable, non-exchangeable and non-returnable.. There are **NO** changes once your uniform is ordered or once it arrives.

{ORDERS CONT'D}

MAGIC ALL-STARS is not responsible for unfit uniforms or athletes growing before the arrival of their uniform. **Magic All-Stars** places one large order a year for uniforms.

{UNIFORM DELIVERY}

Uniforms will be delivered prior to the start of the 2020/2021 competition season in late November. Those athletes that join later in the season will receive their uniform with the next order that is placed. It is a possibility that uniforms will not arrive in time for a late starting athlete. They may need to borrow another athlete's uniform in this case until their pieces arrive.

{ALTERATIONS}

Alterations must be made before the first performance and approved by the owners. If the owners are not pleased with the alterations, you may be asked to order a new uniform/warm-up item.

Uniforms are of fragile material and **MAGIC ALL-STARS** is not responsible for rips/tears, missing stones etc.

{UNIFORM WASH AND CARE}

Wash the uniform by itself in a delicate laundry bag. Machine wash in cold water on the gentle cycle –**A gentle detergent is suggested. (Woolite)**
Hang to dry. Do not put it in the dryer and do not iron or dry clean.

{CROSS OVERS}

Athletes have the option to be a crossover. This is when an athlete competes on two teams. Athletes cross down to a lower level team and their primary team takes precedent in regards to extra practices. Coaches will discuss any crossover conflicts with one another and have a plan set in place. The higher team's tuition and assessments will be considered the primary team.

\$600-\$800 Crossover Fee due by 11/ 1/ 2020. This fee covers the competition fees. An additional \$25/month will be charged for tuition.

{SKILL LEVEL}

It is understood that if an athlete stops performing the skills they did at tryouts, it is at the discretion of the staff to move them to a more appropriate level team at any time.

{JEWELRY and PIERCING}

Jewelry of any kind is not allowed at practices, performances, or **MAGIC ALL-STARS** events. Cheerleaders may not get anything pierced between October 2020 and April 2021.

{MODESTY, BEHAVIOR, IMAGE}

All members will dress respectfully at competitions and events. **MAGIC ALL-STARS** cheerleaders represent our community and must conduct themselves with "class" and "good sportsmanship". Foul language and inappropriate behavior WILL NOT be tolerated and if it becomes an issue, that cheerleader will be dismissed from our all-star program. This includes social media posts.

{COMMITMENT/CONDUCT}

The **MAGIC ALL-STARS** program prides itself on being a family that supports one another. Cheerleaders are expected to support other **MAGIC ALL-STARS** teams during performances. We often require our members to arrive early at events and stay after awards to support the program. **MAGIC ALL-STARS** cheerleaders are not allowed to miss practices or events due to slight illnesses, homework, personal jobs, and other non-emergency situations. Each absence will be evaluated on an individual basis.

MAGIC ALL-STARS cheerleaders must maintain good sportsmanship with other cheerleading programs in the area and around the country. We expect our members to be humble about their abilities and respect other's talent in the industry. **This includes all social media sites.** If we see or hear of inappropriate social media posts whether in regards to **MAGIC ALL-STARS** or not, we will ask the athlete and parent to address it and take the post down. Repeated offenses will result in probation.

MAGIC PARENT POLICIES

{SIDE LINE COACHING}

All coaching decisions are made by the **MAGIC ALL-STARS** staff. Parents are not allowed to "coach from the stands". Decisions are made to benefit the entire team as well as each individual cheerleader.

{NO PARENTS ALLOWED}

Parents are not allowed in the coaching area, in the **MAGIC ALL-STARS** practice arena, or in the warm-up area of any competition. This includes pre-warm-up, warm-up, and team discussions during competitions as well as practices.

To limit group gatherings in small areas, we will be asking parents to drop off and pick up their athletes rather than congregate in the small viewing rooms during practices. As guidelines change, we will make the necessary adjustments and will open back up the viewing rooms to spectators when we feel it is safe to do so.

We will not tolerate negative talk or behavior in our facility. Parents who have a concern should direct their questions to Troy Hedgren the owner by sending an email or phoning him but this should never be done at the gym during a practice.

We ask that parents respect our facility as an athletic training center. Younger brothers and sisters must be constantly supervised. Only registered students and coaches are allowed on the practice floor during practice hours.

{DISPUTES}

Disputes or conflicts between parents and staff will never affect a student in our program. We encourage parents to voice their concerns so that we may provide a better experience for their children, but conflicts should be solved away from the practice floor and ONLY with the **MAGIC ALL-STARS** Owner- NOT THE COACHES.

{CONDUCT AT EVENTS}

Parents or fans are not allowed to approach competition judges or officials at any event. This could result in disqualification of all **MAGIC ALL-STARS** teams. Our owners will be the only ones to talk to competition officials.

We ask respectfully that parents not interfere with the coaching of our cheerleaders at competitions. Most national championships will require that our teams perform in preliminaries and finals. Only coaches should discuss and critique preliminary performances with the teams. Be assured that the staff watches other teams, reviews score sheets, listens to critiques, and analyzes deductions. All of this information is used to provide the teams with the best possible mental preparation. Parents should refrain from discussing their personal opinions in regards to judging with their children. This will only put a hardship on the relationship of the cheerleader to parent, cheerleader to team, and cheerleader to coach.

We ask that our parents respect our program at outside events. Please display the same good sportsmanship and positive behavior that you expect from your children. This includes positive encouragement to all of our members and other parents.

Parents should not place the blame of weak performances on any specific child. Our teams succeed together and fail together. Be careful when blaming other cheerleaders for missed tumbling or dropped stunts - it could be your child at the next event! You will not like how it feels.

{SOCIAL MEDIA}

With the increased use of **SOCIAL MEDIA**, it is expected that all **MAGIC ALL-STARS** athletes, parents and friends be respectful and appropriate on all social media sites. We will not tolerate the misuse of social media if it affects or reflects poorly on **MAGIC ALL-STARS** in any way. ALL **MAGIC ALL-STARS** FB Pages or BAND APPS are owned by **MAGIC ALL-STARS** and posts that are negative or against what **MAGIC ALL-STARS** deems appropriate will be deleted.

{FUNDRAISING}

MAGIC ALL-STARS provides many fundraising opportunities for our team members which include selling items such as Sees Candy, Mixed Bags, Football Mania, Popcorn etc. We also offer the opportunity to work at one of the concession stands at Angels Stadium, Rams Games and Five Points Amphitheater. You must be at least 18 years of age and must complete the training for these events. Information regarding these events is periodically emailed out to everyone as the information becomes available. All other individual team fundraisers will be handled through your TEAM MOM and MUST be approved by **MAGIC ALL-STARS**. Specific fundraising guidelines must be adhered to and approved. FUNDRAISING CREDITS **MAY NOT** BE CASHED OUT or TRANSFERRED to other accounts.

MAGIC ALL-STARS has the right to add or change these guidelines and policies based on the overall safety and needs of our athletes, program and customers.

Upon registration through our online portal, all of these policies in our 2020-2021 tryout packet will be considered agreed upon through line 9 in our portal legal agreements. These policies include all information listed on pages 7-9 and 11-13 of this tryout packet.
