



**As of today: 12/9/2020 – we will be following OPTION A**

CheerStar would like to take the time to explain how we will get back to live competitions and remain as safe as possible. Before we get into details, keep in mind that the below procedures may change the day of the event due to many things out of our control. In addition, state and local guidelines may prevent certain aspects of competition from taking place. This is simply an initial plan to help gyms and spectators prepare for the opportunity to attend competitions in the future.

## OPTION A

ATHLETES, COACHES AND SPECTATORS over 3 years old must enter facility with a mask on.

COMPETITION will be judged by program and not by division. Example: All American Allstars will report at 8:00 am. Their first team will take practice mat at 8:30 am. Then they will go through rotations in order of how they would like each team to compete. Once all-of a program has competed, then they will exit the facility.

Per state and local guidelines, spectators must remain at least 6' apart when not immediate family members

Events are standing room only, with the exception of a few seats for the elderly and handicap.

Spectators will be asked to keep masks on while in the facility

Score sheets will be emailed only

We will have a legalities and deductions judge on hand to discuss if needed

We will schedule a sanitization break between each program

After all programs have competed, we will begin to tabulate all performances

There will NOT be an on-site/live awards session.

Awards will be virtual on the Tuesday following the event.

## OPTION B

ATHLETES, COACHES AND SPECTATORS over 3 years old must enter facility with a mask on.

COMPETITION will be judged by levels with an hour break in between levels. Example: All Level 1 teams will report at 8:00 am. The first performance will be at 8:30 am. All Level 1 teams and spectators will leave immediately after their performance through an exit only designated door

Per state and local guidelines, spectators must remain at least 6' apart when not immediate family members

Spectators will be asked to keep masks on while in the facility

Score sheets will be emailed only

We will have a legalities and deductions judge on hand to discuss if needed

Once level has concluded, the final team athletes, coaches, and spectators will exit the performance arena

The next 30 minutes will be spent sanitizing the practice and performance areas

There will NOT be an on-site/live awards session.

Awards will be virtual on the Tuesday following the event

## OPTION C

ATHLETES, COACHES AND SPECTATORS over 3 years old must enter facility with a mask on.

COMPETITION will be judged as normally judged with all levels throughout the day, however, we will ask that no one arrive more than 45 minutes before their warm-up check in time

Per state and local guidelines, spectators must remain at least 6' apart when not immediate family members

Spectators will be asked to keep masks on while in the facility

Score sheets will be emailed only

We will have a legalities and deductions judge on hand to discuss if needed

Once team has competed, the athletes, coaches, and spectators will be asked to exit the performance arena

There will NOT be an on-site/live awards session.

Awards will be virtual on the Tuesday following the event.

## **SOME THINGS TO EXPECT AT OUR VENUES**

Directional markings to direct foot traffic in the safest way possible.

Signage to maintain a 6 foot social distance from others.

Designated entry/exit points for teams, coaches & spectators.

Hand sanitizers at entrances, exits and high traffic areas.

Scheduled delays of competition to sanitize and clean practice and competition areas.

Specific entry/exit points for teams, coaches & spectators.

Temperature checks may be required on entry of the venue.

## **ADDITIONAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

Athletes & coaches are expected to perform daily temperature and symptom checks for everyone in contact with your team.

Athletes and coaches should wear a proper fitting face mask at all times while not warming up their routine or competing.

Athletes will be required to place bags and other belongings in a designated area upon entering the warm-up area.
