Team Formation

Dreamz Elite does not promise the formation of any team or any position for any athlete. All team placements, routine positions, and stunt spots are at the discretion of the coaches and can be changed at any time without discussion. We start each season brand new based on the athletes that are present during our evaluations. Rosters will be generated and comprised of members whose talents provide the best chances for success at competitions.

- All skills that are performed at evaluations are expected to be maintained and advanced throughout the season.
- Team placement is based on age and overall skill set. Coaching staff will make the final decisions on team placement.
- If an athlete regresses during the season, the athlete may be moved to a more appropriate team. Coaching staff will make the final decision.
- Athletes are not allowed to participate with other allstar programs while being members of Dreamz Elite. Athletes may participate on school teams as long as USASF rules are followed and practices do not interfere.
- Athletes have 14 days from placement to drop from the program. Any payments submitted are NON-REFUNDABLE. After 14 days, an athlete who elects to drop from the program for reasons other than a season or career ending injuring with a doctor's not, will be charged a \$500 drop fee. Athletes who are asked to leave the program due to parent or athlete breach of contract will be considered an elective drop and be charged the \$500 fee.
- Drop fees will automatically be charged to the credit card on file and may not be disputed or called fraudulent charges.

Our coaching staff considers each athlete's strengths and weaknesses when forming teams each season. Our coaches are experts at grouping athlete talent and setting your child up for success. Remember: routines are made up of more than just tumbling skills.

Program Costs

Dreamz Elite strives to be upfront with all of our program costs. Allstar cheerleading is a significant financial commitment. We offer several fund-raising opportunities throughout our season to help offset costs. If we are required to temporarily close, events are unexpectedly cancelled, or other situations arise that are beyond our control, we will adjust costs as fairly and quickly as possible.
