- Developing and maintaining relationships Cheer and Performance Cheer clubs as well as event producers, Active Schools, Community Sports Hubs and any other relevant partners.
- Acting as an initial point of contact for Cheer and Performance Cheer queries.
- Attending a minimum of two quarterly board meeting per annum and the Annual General Meeting.
- Aiding the strategic development of cheerleading in Scotland including planning and implementation of initiatives and programmes.
- Assisting in fundraising efforts of SportCheer Scotland.
- Promotion of SportCheer Scotland and its membership.
