We are excited you are interested in being a part of Miss Tammy's All-Star Co. for our 27th competition season, established in August of 1995. Miss Tammy's is respected nationally on both the All-Star and Collegiate level, having produced cheerleaders and dancers who represent top colleges and universities across the country.

Registration

Pre-registration for the 2021 - 2022 season will be held the week of May 10th – May 13th 2021. Please be prepared to pay your tryout fee and \$125.00 deposit when you sign up. **Prior to getting on floor for clinic, tryout/clinic fee must be paid. In order for your child to tryout you must sign up first.** Emails links of tryout material will be available for \$20.00 and need to be paid for when you register. Emails will be sent out after clinic.

Squad Placement

At Miss Tammy's we believe that it is more important what the athlete gets from the all-star gym, not what the gym can get from the athlete. For this reason, we form squads that best allow athletes to compete the skills they achieve.

Squad levels will be determined after teams have been formed and begun practicing together. Squad **tumbling** or stunting **does not guarantee any certain level**. This is determined by a combination of both and will be set by the coaches of Miss Tammy's. Some athletes may be given the opportunity to double team. **Due to the quick turn around this year between competitions and tryouts, we encourage everyone to continue posting on social media about tryouts.**

Tryouts

Tryouts will be held Friday, May 21st, 2021. Tryout fee is \$45.00 if pre-registered and \$55.00 if paid the day of clinic. After tryouts, our staff will work together to come up with teams based on age, skill ability, and potential for a successful competitive season. Each child will need to tryout to be placed in a practice group **(special exceptions can be made for extreme circumstances for early or late tryouts.)** Once teams are determined, we will post them on the internet Monday, May 24th by 3:00 p.m. The new teams will begin practicing Monday, May 24th, 2021. Age is determined by the child's age as of August 31st, 2021. Athletes can be moved to different teams throughout the summer if we determine that will benefit the athlete or the team better.

Program Costs

Monthly tuition covers tuition, all additional practices and choreography/music fees.

August 15th - All athletes will be required to create account or login to usasf.net and pay annual USASF Membership Fee – \$30.00. This is required by every organization for athletes to compete.

Some teams may be selected for new uniforms this season. New uniforms average \$400.00 and will be paid on installment dates that will be set after tryouts. Used uniforms may be available for a greatly reduced price.

In cases of multiple athletes in a family or extreme circumstance, please see Sandra to set up payment plan.

Miss Tammy's Booster Club:

There will be numerous fundraisers and all athletes and parents are expected to be actively involved.

Mini Tot Cheer – \$100.00 w/auto draft or \$120.00 if paid by check or cash

Mini Cheer - \$125.00 w/auto draft or \$145.00 if paid by check or cash

Youth – Sr. Cheer – \$150.00 w/auto draft or \$170.00 if paid by check or cash

WE STRONGLY SUGGEST PAYING BY AUTO DRAFT

All tuition is due by the 10th of the month. Any tuition received after this will incur a \$10.00 late fee. Any accounts that get 30 days past due will be required to be on automatic credit card or bank draft for all monthly tuition and additional expenses for the remainder of the season.

It is the parent's responsibility to make sure that Miss Tammy's has the correct and most accurate information on file. Unfortunately, there will also be a \$35 late fee for all insufficient card numbers, insufficient funds, card cancellations, & declines.

Tuition does not fluctuate based on the number or duration of practices in any month. Monthly tuition is due beginning June 2021 and will run through April 2022. If an athlete joins after the initial start of the season, additional fees will be collected to cover competition fees, hair bow, & choreography/music fees.

Cheer - This rate includes your monthly tuition, choreography/music fees and team hair bow. Tuition **does not include** your tryout fee, initial \$125.00 deposit paid at time of registration, USASF Membership Fees, additional competition fee installments, practice wear, cheer uniform, shoes, competition make-up, and hotel or travel costs. If you or your child removes themselves from the team, you will still be required to finish out the year's financial commitment for the remainder of the season. (No Exceptions)

***ABSENCES**

THIS WILL BE ENFORCED AND NOT HAVE THE LENIENCY OF PREVIOUS YEARS.

Excessive absences will not be tolerated. Only school sanctioned events and illness with a Dr. note will be excused. If your child must miss a practice, the gym must be notified prior to the practice.
