Registration

Pre-registration for the 2015 - 2016 season will be held the weeks of April 13th - 23rd, 2015. Please be prepared to pay your tryout fee and \$250.00 deposit when you sign up. **In order for your child to tryout you must sign up first.** DVD's will be available for \$20.00 and CD's for \$5.00 of the tryout material and need to be paid for when you register. CDs and DVDs will be passed out at clinic

Squad Placement

At Miss Tammy's we believe that it is more important what the athlete gets from the all-star gym, not what the gym can get from the athlete. For this reason we form squads that best allow athletes to compete the skills they achieve.

Squad levels will be determined after teams have been formed and begun practicing together. Squad tumbling or stunting does not guarantee any certain level, this is determined by a combination of both and will be set by the coaches of Miss Tammy's. Some athletes may be given the opportunity to double team.

Tryouts

Tryouts will be held Friday, May 1st, 2015. After tryouts, our staff will work together to come up with teams based on age, skill ability, and potential for a successful competitive season. Each child will need to tryout to be placed in a practice group (**special exceptions can be made for extreme circumstances for early or late tryouts with an additional \$25.00 tryout fee.**) Once practice groups are determined, we will post them on the internet Monday, May 4th by 3:00 p.m. The new groups will begin practicing Monday, May 4th, 2015. Age is determined by the child's age as of August 31st, 2015. Teams will be finalized by July 15th, 2015 and notifications will be made.

- Ages 6 - 11 Monday, April 27th 5:30 - 7:00 (Big Gym)
- Ages 12 - 18 Monday, April 27th 7:00 - 8:30 (Big Gym)
- 5 years and under Tuesday, April 28th 5:30 - 6:30 (Small Gym)

Tryout times will be announced at the clinics

Program Costs

Monthly tuition covers tuition, annual USASF membership fee, choreography/music fees and practice clothing – *which includes T-Shirt, 2 pair of performance shorts and sports bra or tank.*

Please carefully consider the financial commitment involved and read this form in its entirety.

Payment Dates

April 30th or before - \$250.00 Cheer Deposit towards competition fees

June 15th 2nd Competition Fee Installment – \$100.00

July 15th Final Competition Fee Installment – \$100.00

This will cover the competition fees for **4** competitions

Uniform Payments are \$350.00 ½ due by August 1st and 2nd ½ due by September 1st

In cases of multiple athletes in a family or extreme circumstances, please see Sandra to set up payment plans – these must be set up for auto-draft.

NEW INCLUSIVE MONTHLY TUITION RATES:

Mini Tot Cheer – \$90.00 w/auto draft or \$100.00 if paid by check or cash

Mini Cheer - \$115.00 w/auto draft or \$125.00 if paid by check or cash

Youth – Coed Cheer – \$140.00 w/auto draft or \$150.00 if paid by check or cash

All tuition is due by the 10th of the month. Any tuition received after this will incur a \$10.00 late fee. Any accounts that get 30 days past due will be required to be on automatic credit card or bank draft for all monthly tuition and additional expenses for the remainder of the season.

It is the parent's responsibility to make sure that Miss Tammy's has the correct and most accurate information on file. Unfortunately there will also be a \$35 late fee for all insufficient card numbers, insufficient funds, card cancellations, & declines. All scheduled competition fees must be paid by July 31, 2015.

Tuition does not fluctuate based on the number or duration of practices in any month. Monthly tuition is due beginning May 2015 and will run through April 2015. If an athlete joins after the initial start of the season, additional fees will be collected to cover competition fees, practices clothes, & choreography/music fees.

Cheer - This rate includes your monthly tuition, choreography/music fees, & practice clothing and team hair bow. Tuition **does not include** your tryout fee, initial \$250.00 deposit paid at time of registration, additional competition fee installments, cheer uniform, shoes, competition make-up, and hotel or travel costs.

Stay to Play – Some competitions are now requiring all athletes competing at their events to make hotel reservations through their website. This will not be at every event and we will let you know which events will require this when competition schedule is released.

Miss Tammy's Team Rules

Athletes and Parents: In order to run a successful program it is the parent and athlete's responsibility to abide by certain rules to ensure everyone involved is treated fairly. These expectations are to be followed at all times during the year. If at anytime one of these rules is broken; it can result in dismissal from Miss Tammy's. 5. Athletes are required to attend **ALL practices & extra practices 4 weeks prior to each competition.** _____Athlete initials_____Parent initials
6. Only 4 absences (excused or unexcused) will be given from August 1st, 2015 – April 1st, 2016. _____Athlete initials_____Parent initials
7. School functions (excluding athletic teams – school sports are not excused unless you are cheering at them) are the only excused absences. It is the parent/child's responsibility to let Miss Tammy's know in advance. _____Athlete initials_____Parent initials
8. **Athletes and parents are expected to present themselves with a positive attitude to training and towards Miss Tammy's. This includes the staff, the athletes, & towards other parents throughout the year.** _____Athlete initials_____Parent initials

12. Athletes are required to wear the scheduled practice clothes to each practice.
