Team Placement and Registration:

We will be having a registration and team placement evaluation on Sunday October 22 from 7:15 until 8:00 pm. The placement fee is \$25. The Registration fee is \$50. If you cannot attend this date, please let us know so we can schedule a private registration/evaluation prior to October 27.

We will decide on appropriate teams the following week and will email/text you team placement as well as your practice schedule by October 27. Practices will begin the week of October 29-November 4.

Monthly Tuition is \$125 per month. Second child will be discounted at \$100 per month. This is due by the 1st of every month. This includes one 1 to 1 1/2 hour practice a week (depending on team age), competition fees, uniform, bow, and music/choreography. Here is a table for your records. Please be prompt in payments!

Monthly fees can be paid by cash, check, or credit card. If paying by check, please place the cheerleader's name on the memo line. All cash and check payments should be placed in an envelope. If paying by credit card, you can process this online through our Jack Rabbit system. If you fundraise and/or have money in your accounts, it will automatically be deducted.

Jack Rabbit Online System:

- After you are registered with the program, you can set up an online portal through our Jack Rabbit system. On this portal, you can keep current personal contact information and payment processing information.
- On the portal, I will be posting all fees and adding any of your payments. Again, you can look at your balance at any time. I will also periodically be emailing statements.
- You are able to add credit cards directly to your account that you can use to pay off balances.

Fundraisers:

- You are free to coordinate your own fundraisers/tag days. You just must complete and return a fundraising approval form. After you have turned in the form, you will be contacted only if we have questions and/or we are not approving the fundraiser. If you don't hear from us, then you are all set! All fundraising money must be turned in to the gym the practice after the fundraiser occurs. Fundraising forms can be found on our website.
- If you are interested in seeking out business sponsors, we will collect sponsors until January 1. The form for business sponsors is also on our website.
- You are free to participate in any gym fundraisers that you would like as well. Again, all fundraising money must be turned into the gym.
- Only large bills or checks from gym members will be accepted for fundraisers. Please do not turn in loose change!
- We do not have the proper licensing for raffles, bingos, etc... since we are a for profit organization. We cannot host these events or collect money from these events. If you are having events like these, you may NOT list Pennsylvania Elite Cheerleading in any of the information.

Cheer Accounts:

Each athlete will have his/her own cheer account. This account is where your fundraising money and/or personal deposits will be recorded. I will deduct monthly fees directly from cheer accounts. If your cheer accounts are not kept up to date, your athlete will not be able to participate!

Classes and Private lessons:

Classes are optional. There are no sibling discounts. Class information and sign-ups can be found on the link on the welcome page of our website (www.paelite.com). Private lessons are offered monthly. Katie and Liam do one on one privates or semi-privates (2 athletes). If interested in setting up a private lesson(s), the links are found on our website and will be posted monthly via group me. These fees must be paid separately!

Hair and Make-up: hair for competitions must be all up in a high ponytail. The pony tail should be curled. You can choose to do a braid or a bump in the front if you would like, but this is completely optional. Make-up should be blue eye shadow, some light blush, and mascara (if tiny girls don't like to wear this that is okay). Cheerleaders should also wear red lipstick.

Uniforms: Half year members will wear tanks and shorts. These are paid for with your monthly tuition fees. You are responsible for purchasing plain white cheer shoes of your choice.

Clothing/Merchandise Orders: We do have select merchandise for sale in the gym office. We also have an online clothing sale. No one is permitted to create their own gym merchandise using our gym name and/or gym logo(s), without permission from Brett or Tracy.

Parents/Spectators: please avoid entering the gym before, during, and after practice hours. All the information needed will be given to your athletes to take home. Anything needed to hand in to us should be turned in at the gym office or placed in the payment box in the lobby. If you need to use the restroom, please be sure to enter the back of the gym! Please be sure to closely supervise any children while waiting in viewing lounges. We are going to do our best to keep the athletes in the main gym for the duration of the practice. All water bottles should be sent into the gym with the athletes. Water will be on sale at the gym for \$1 as well. At times, the windows will be closed for viewing to keep the athletes attention as well as keep the routines a surprise for all of you. Windows will be open during classes, private lessons, and open gyms.

Questions/Concerns: If you have questions/concerns, we ask that you email or text first. If you wish to set up a meeting or receive a phone call, please be sure to text or email with the reason for the call/meeting. We will not be able to have impromptu meetings before and after practice.

Current Information, updates, reminders, etc... will be posted on our website, Facebook page, and in the gym lobby. We will also send information home with the athletes and text or email parents as needed! Additionally, I will be setting up a Group Me for all registered Half Year athletes. This is an app you can download on your phone. I will post updates and information on here as well.
