



2018-19 TOP GUN All-star Information

1. Welcome to the Top Gun All-Star Program!

- This season our all-stars packages offer two options. All-star regular & All-stars Elite.
- All-stars Level 1 is priced at \$65.00+ Membership and Competition Cost. This package includes (1) 1 1/2 hour practice and 1 hour tumbling class.
- Tuition is for 12 months and is an averaged cost. This fee WILL NOT be PRORATED.
- Competition and membership fees are added to this fee and are listed on page 6 on the payment schedule.
- Our all-stars packages for Levels 2-5 are \$100.00 per month. This package includes (2) weekly team practices. This Package also include 1 hour of tumbling.
- All Competition Fees, Uniforms, Membership Fees & Choreography Fees are added together and divided by 12 giving us our 2nd payment due on the 15th of each month.
- *This year all athletes must be leveled and acquire a USASF membership number.*
- *Birth Certificates for USASF age verification must be submitted prior to first practice.*
- *All clients will be required to submit a credit/debit card or bank draft information on our snap system. You must enter and verify information before first practice in May. This year the all-star contract will be completed electronically online and must be completed prior to the first practice in May. You may still pay by check prior to the 1st. However, on the 1st of the month accounts will be automatically drafted. Any account denied funds or not paid on the 1st will be charged an NSF fee of \$20.00.*

2. Competitions

- All competitions are mandatory for all team members!
- Schedule for competition will be distributed at dress rehearsal
- We will Practice 3 days the week of competition, unless otherwise stated.
- Competition Week Practices are: Monday, Wednesday and Dress Rehearsal on Thursday
- Dress rehearsal is MANDATORY!

3. Practices

Summer Practice times and days will be held during the week. We are working to establish times and dates based off of the current availability of our team members schedule.

- All practices (inside of the gym) are closed to parents and spectators unless otherwise posted (no observers in the gym).
- Practices are mandatory to compete. *Any all-star who misses 4 practice hours prior to competition will not be allowed to compete in that competition, no exceptions. No refund for that competition will be issued. Any all-star who misses 6 total practices will not be allowed to finish the season. However, they will still be held responsible to fulfill their financial*



- *obligation as stated in the all-star contract and no refunds will be issued. Top Gun All-stars is a team sport and all members are required to attend every practice. The practice schedule has not been established at this time. After tryouts we will create the teams' schedule. All scheduling conflicts must be submitted in writing at least two weeks in advance. Dress rehearsal is held every Thursday prior to competition and is mandatory to compete in that competition*

4. Tumbling

Tumbling is a large portion of the score at each competition. **As a safety precaution all-stars are not allowed to take classes at any other facility. The only exceptions are if your school squad attends another facility with the squad.**

5. Camps and Choreography & Communication

- We will conduct our choreography camp in mid & late September
- **This camp is mandatory and the price for choreography and music is \$150.00 per all-star. Crossovers will pay an additional \$75.00 per routine Choreography**
- Communication is the most important tool in running a successful program. *Our primary way of communicating is email, text messaging, website and now Facebook. Please be sure that we have correct email, phone numbers and mailing address on file. If you change your phone number please notify the front desk so that we may remain current on all contact information.*

6. Contracts and Payments

- **In order for Top Gun to provide the number of benefits and quality instruction you expect we require all of our all-stars to complete an all-star contract along with credit card or debit card information. (and MUST be provided)**
- **Credit card and debit cards are used as a secondary method of collection. All fees are due on or before the first of the month. Any fees not paid by the 1st of the month will be charged to your card on file. Many of our customers actually prefer this method of payment and it can be set up to automatically draft your account monthly. Anyone not wishing to have their fees charged to their credit card needs to pay their fees prior to the 1st of the month.**
- **Please remember this is a business and we have to be able to meet our expenses in a timely matter. All athletes wishing to compete in the 2018-19 season must complete a contract with correct information on your snap accounts by May 31ST, 2018**

7. Practice Gear & Team T-shirts

Top Gun will be bringing back practice gear for this season. Practice gear is mandatory and must be worn to each and every practice. Dress for the job you want! All Athletes are required to wear BLACK Nike Pro style shorts with either BLACK Sports Bra or Black Tanks. Pieces may be



purchased with the Top Gun Logo. *Shirts will be ordered during Season & are not included in Pricing.*

8. New Uniforms for 2018

We changed our uniform in the the 2017-18 season. The cost is \$450.00 and we will have a Team Competition bow. Crossovers will be responsible for purchasing a bow for each team they compete on. Price per bow is \$26.00.

9. ALOHA Hawaii, US Finals & D2 Summit 2018

By request, Top Gun is looking at taking team or teams back to Honolulu, Hawaii to compete in the Aloha International Cheer Competition. We will have a parent meeting after placements to discuss creating these teams specifically for Hawaii.

All qualifying teams will attend the Us Finals. Each year we try to attend a different location for Us Finals. We plan on taking any qualifying team to D2 Summit in Orlando, FL at Walt Disney World. Both US Finals and D2 Summit are qualifying events. We must receive a bid to attend.

10. Cross Overs

Cross overs are a vital part of any small gym. On your tryout form, please check whether or not your child is willing to participate a crossover athlete. Cross Over Athletes allow us to have additional teams that we might otherwise NOT have enough athletes create. Cross Over Athletes also allow us to place veteran athletes on teams where leadership is needed to help promote a winning attitude and boost the teams athleticism. Crossovers do not pay additional tuition, however they will have additional choreography, Competition Bow and competition fees costs.

11. Team Warm Ups & Arrival at Competitions

Team warm ups are optional, however they are available. Upon arriving at competitions this season all Top Gun Athletes Must be dressed in one of the following:

1. Team Warm Up
2. Team Uniform Top with Black Pants (warm up, leggings or yoga) No Uniform SKIRTS over pants!!

Level 3 Requirements

- Back handspring Series
- Jump to Back Handspring Series
- Round off Tuck
- Round off Back Handspring Tuck
- Front Tuck
- Must have: 5 of the 6

Level 4 Requirements

- Standing Tuck
- Jump to Back handspring Tuck
- Round off Back Handspring Layout
- Specialty Pass Level Appropriate (Bonus)

Level 5 requirements

- Jump to Standing Tuck
- Back Handspring series to Full Twist
- Round off Back Handspring Full Twist
- Specialty Pass Level Appropriate (Bonus)

All skills must be proficient and 80% performable under high intensity/fatigue situations.

*******Teams will be leveled by the majority of skills possessed by athletes during all-star placements(tumbling is not the only factor in placements)***
