

2023 Road 2 State Deduction Sheet

As in all live sport, the safety/deduction officials will aim to recognize and properly define all elements in the routines which may garner a warning or deduction. Coaches will have the opportunity to review their routine at Coach Corner to verify any deductions applied.

CHEER AND DANCE: ALL 10 POINT CHSAA NFHS VIOLATIONS = 1.0

ALL OTHER CHSAA SPIRIT BULLETIN DEDUCTIONS UNLESS CLARIFIED BELOW IN THIS DOCUMENT WILL BE WARNINGS.

Rally Towels will be allowed as they ARE legal by NFHS Definition

MINOR TUMBLING ERROR = 0.10

Hands/knees down on tumbling *from an airborne skill*, the landing position of the athlete's feet will be used to determine completion.

- All other hands/knees down tumbling errors from non-airborne skills will be taken in execution)

MAJOR TUMBLING ERROR = 0.25

- Landing on knees, head, shoulders, back or other compromising positions *from an airborne skill*,
 - All other tumbling errors of this type from non-airborne skills will be taken in execution)

OBVIOUS BUILDING MISTAKE = 0.5

- Controlled cradling, dismounting, or bringing down a stunt or pyramid early (not timing issues)
- Dropping to a load in, cradle, prone, flat back, or performance surface
 - Determined or measured by the other stunts being performed simultaneously if applicable.
- Top person becomes weight bearing on the spotter of a stunt.
 - R2S Clarification: this is a federation rule not a drop, thus will be seen as an Obvious Mistake.
- The top person incorrectly places weight on the middle layer of a pyramid (if the bracer was not there the stunt would fall)
 - R2S Clarification: this is a federation rule not a drop, thus will be seen as an Obvious Mistake

BUILDING FALL = 1.0

CLARIFICATIONS TO CHSAA BULLETIN DEFINITIONS

- Base(s), flyer, or spotter(s) falling/landing on the performance surface.
- Uncontrolled cradling, dismounting, or bringing down a stunt or pyramid early (not timing issues) from the intended.

CHEER BOUNDARY .25

Moving or stepping out of the competition mat boundaries will constitute a penalty. Breaking the plane outside the boundaries will not draw a penalty/deduction.

- R2S Clarification – *both feet must step off the mat onto the hardwood otherwise it will be a WARNING from the safety judge*

TIME VIOLATION .25

CHEER MUSIC TIME:

Total time of Music exceeds 1:45

TOTAL CHEER ROUTINE TIME:

Total time of Routine exceeds 2:30

DANCE ROUTINE TIME:

Total time of Routine exceeds 2:30 with a minimum of 1:45

GAMEDAY – CHEER/DANCE TIME:

Total time of Routine exceeds 3:00

WARNINGS:

WARNINGS WILL BE GIVEN AS DEFINED ABOVE, IN ORDER TO EDUCATE COACHES ON THE POTENTIAL PENALTIES THAT COULD BE ASSESSED AT OTHER SCHOOL EVENTS.
