Q: How Much Does it Cost?

A: Tuition is \$60 per month starting in October. There is also a one time fee for choreography/music. Uniforms are additional cost but for cheer are the same as last season so there is the opportunity to get a used one. You will attend (3) competitions, which range from \$65-\$100 per competition. A yearly Usasf fee of \$30 is also required by each athlete. **ALL ATHLETES GET FREE TUMBLING STARTING IN OCTOBER!!**

Q. Who are the Coaches?

A. Our coaching staff is certified through the USASF. All teams will have 2 coaches each.

Q. How do you select Teams?

A: We select teams to be the most competitive in each level.

Q. How often do we practice?

A. Once a week.....Extra practices may be added as we approach competition season.

Q: Does everyone make a team?

A: We do try our best to place every athlete. If we do not have a spot for a cheerleader, we will make a phone call to that family.

Breakdown of Additional Cost

*Registration Fee \$35- Due on or before October 13th

* Choreography \$150- Due October 27th

* Cheer Uniform \$275.00- Billed in November

*Music fee \$50-65- Billed in December

*USASF Fee \$30.00 – Billed in December

*Shoes \$65-75- Billed in December (everyone is required to have the same shoe this season)

*Cheer Bow \$30- Billed in January

*Makeup \$10-25- Billed in January

*Competition fees (3) – Ranging from \$65-\$100 per competition. These will be billed the month prior to each competition.

* Uniforms are additional cost. These are the same as last season so there is the opportunity to get a used one if available.

Statements will be given out by the 1st of each month. Fees are due on or before the 15th. On the 16th, any outstanding balance will be charged to your credit card that you've provided in your tryout packet. You can pay in person and Midwest Cheer Elite accepts checks, cash, money orders, cashiers' checks and all major credit cards. If you have any questions about your account, please do not hesitate to call the front office. Accounts not paid in full will be charged a \$50 late fee and any returned checks would be charged a \$35 returned check fee.

There will be a 3% service fee for all credit card transactions.

There will be no refunds made to anyone who is asked to leave the program or that quits a team. If there is a financial problem, please contact the office immediately. Your coach will not be able to advise you on these matters.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY, RELEASE, INDEMNITY, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT

Name of Participant/Child: _____

In consideration of the services of MCE Toledo Athletics, LLC, and its owners, members, agents, officers, subcontractors, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on its or their behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "MCE"), I hereby agree, on behalf of myself, my child, my spouse, my child's other parent(s) or guardian(s), my parents, my family members, my agents, heirs, assigns, personal representative, and estate (collectively, the "releasing parties"), as follows:

1. I understand and acknowledge that the activities that I, my child, or any of the releasing parties engage in or observe while on MCE's premises, or while under the auspices, supervision, or control of MCE, or while traveling to or from such activities, pose known and unknown risks which could result in injury, pain, suffering, paralysis, death, emotional distress, loss of companionship, and/or damage to me, to my child, to property, to the releasing parties, and/or to third parties. The following describes some, but not all of those risks, and I understand and acknowledge that there are other risks, both foreseeable and not foreseeable, that are not included among the following which any of the releasing parties may suffer:

Cheerleading, dance, and gymnastics, including performances of stunts and use of trampolines and other equipment, is dangerous and entails certain risks inherent in the activities that simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. Without a certain degree of risk, participants would not improve their skills, and their enjoyment of the activity would be diminished. Cheerleading, dance, and gymnastics expose participants to the usual risk of cuts and bruises, and other more serious risks as well. Participants often fall or come in contact with other participants or with equipment or objects, can sprain or break wrists and ankles, can incur injuries caused by others, and can suffer more serious injuries, including paralysis and death. Traveling to and from practice, rehearsals, shows, meets, competitions, and exhibitions raises the possibilities of any manner of transportation accidents.

2. I expressly agree to accept and assume all of the risks, known and unknown, foreseeable and not foreseeable, related to, arising out of, or in any way connected with MCE-related activities, including but not limited to performance of stunts and use of trampolines and equipment, and the negligent acts or omissions of MCE or others. My participation and that of my child is purely voluntary. No one has force or coerced me or my child to participate. I elect for myself and my child to participate in such activities in spite of the risks.

3. On behalf of myself, my child, and the releasing parties, I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to defend, hold harmless, and indemnify MCE from any

and all liability, claims, demands, costs, damages, actions, or rights of actions asserted by any of the releasing parties, which are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected with my or my child's participation in MCE-related activities ("Costs").

4. Should MCE incur attorney's fees or costs related to or arising from my obligations under this agreement, I agree to indemnify and reimburse MCE for such attorney's fees and costs.

5. I represent and warrant to MCE that adequate health, accident, and liability insurance is in force and will be maintained to cover any Costs, and if such Costs are not paid in full, then MCE shall not have, and I hereby release MCE from, any obligation to pay or reimburse any such Costs, and I agree to pay the Costs.

6. I agree that the substantive and procedural laws of the State of Ohio shall apply to this agreement and in any action arising from this agreement without regard to the conflict of laws rules of the State of Ohio, that the state courts of Ohio shall have exclusive jurisdiction of any action, and that such action shall be brought only in the county in which MCE is located.

7. I acknowledge and agree that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my participation or the participation of any of my child, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against MCE on the basis of any claim from which I have released MCE by signing this Agreement, and such lawsuit shall be dismissed.

8. I acknowledge and agree that this agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Ohio, and that if any provision of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, such provision shall be modified, if possible, only to the extent necessary to render it enforceable, and the remainder of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

I UNDERSTAND THAT I GIVE UP SUBSTANTIAL LEGAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, I AM AWARE OF ITS LEGAL CONSEQUENCES, AND I SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO ME. I INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.

You will be responsible for the monthly installments and any balance on your account until such time that written notification is sent to Midwest Cheer Elite Toledo, LLC, 12265 Williams Road, Perrysburg, Ohio 43551. Services fees for choreography, coach's fees and other yearly fees are divided into the monthly installments and are due upon notice of termination. The remaining balance of fees for services provided will be calculated and a final bill must be paid in full within 30 days of the final bill date.

I understand (please initial by each “I understand”)...

____ I understand that my child is being evaluated to be a member of Midwest Cheer Elite Toledo, LLC and not any particular team, placement is based on age, ability, and team needs.

____ I understand that should my child need to discontinue practicing during the season due to injury and/or illness, they may not return to the team until they receive a clearance from a licensed doctor and are able to return to the same level they were prior to the injury and/or illness.

____ I understand that should the coach and/or gym owner feel an athlete is injured to the point they are unable to perform the duties of the team, they have the right to bench the athlete until suitable diagnosis and clearance is given by a licensed doctor (i.e.: “a school trainer” would not be an acceptable clearance for any injury).

____ In accordance to the Ohio Revised Code, all concussions must follow the diagnosis and treatment plan set up by the State of Ohio and the athlete may not return until they have passed all neurological testing set up by the new law.

____ I understand that should my athlete discontinue performing the skills that they performed at evaluations, at any time during the season, they can be moved to a more appropriate level team for their current skill level.

____ I understand that all communication should be done thru the business phone and email...Calls and communication should not be done thru coaches’ personal cell phones, Facebook or emails.

____ I understand that should my child “quit” during the season, I am responsible for the current and next billing cycle in full from the date written notification is given to the gym owner.

____ I understand that there are no refunds should my athlete quit or be removed from teams during the season.

____ I understand that the installments I am paying cover competition fees, music, choreography, tuition, tumbling, coaches’ fees, and practice clothing. Therefore I understand that monies paid for installments earlier in the season may not be credited or applied towards upcoming installments, should we leave the gym.

Any and all questions I have regarding the contract have been answered to my satisfaction and I understand the contract that I am reading.
