

Champion July Tumbling & July-August All Star Information

July 2020 Gym Information:

- Closed June 30th – July 5th. July session = July 7th – July 30th, 2020.
- Reopening procedures are the same for July. No food, outdoor area open if need to eat. No Bags. Lobby Closed.
- Limitation of two tumbling classes and one flight/jump a week.
- If payment is not made by Tuesday, July 14th at the start of child's classes; the student will be asked to view class and not participate till payment is complete.
- No refunds or discounts for missed/vacations. Price holds your class and/or evaluation spot.

July 2020 Tumbling Only Student Prices

- Four week session for one class a week \$65, \$50 for second class.
- Multi-Child or Multi-Class discount please allow us 48 hours to apply your discount.

July 2020 All Star Only and/or Plus Tumbling Class Prices

- \$85 for Mandatory twice a week evaluation.
- \$30 for one extra class a week, \$20 for second/third class.
- example 1: \$85 evaluation (twice a week) + 1 extra tumbling class = \$115
- example 2: \$85 evaluation (twice a week) + 2 extra classes = \$135
- example 3: \$85 evaluation (twice a week) + 3 extra classes = \$135
(*can NOT take 3 tumbling classes. 2 tumbling classes max. & 3rd class can be flight/jump.)
- Multi-Child or Multi-Class discount please allow us 48 hours to apply your discount.
- Can't attend evaluations? \$85 and forms still due at 1st eval to reserve your spot for a team placement.

July 2020 All Star Information:

- Mandatory four-week evaluation, held twice a week. Mainly stunting, very minimal tumbling.
- 2020-2021 All Star Commitment forms & payment due at first July evaluation. Commitment forms for the 2020-2021 season can be view from our website or attached below for your convenience.
(Evaluations are mandatory twice a week to best place your child on a team. Some absent forms are turned in for July. If this is you, please attend the dates not interfering with your travels.)
- Evaluation for Ages 6-18 years old. We will split up. Only attend if you want FULL travel, local travel teams will begin in Fall 2020.

August 2020 All Star Information:

- Registration fee, practice wear fee, August tuition, and booster fee will be collected in August, please prepare for this.
- You will be emailed your semi-permanent team practice time for August by the end of July; if you need two weeks' notice due to job. Please notify us.
(These are semi-permanent team placements because athletes are subject to change teams. Due to the unpredicted circumstances we're all facing, the coaches will spend August time making placements permanent. While also preparing stunts and tumbling for September Choreography. Keep note, if we need to see your child with a different set of athletes; practice time could be subject to change or may remain the same.)
- We'll be aiming for final team placements to be announced the end of August. If we can make the announcement sooner, we will. With safety as our top priority it's hard to put a placement on that final announcement. Thanks for your patience!

COMMITMENT FORM. CODE OF CONDUCT & FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

- 1.** A member and a member's family must at all times be a strong representative of Champion All Stars and a positive reflection on their team.
- 2.** Abusive behavior, bullying, lying or any other form of negative behavior by a parent or child is grounds for removal from the team.
- 3.** No Athlete shall drink alcohol or use any form of drugs including cigarettes while in Champion attire or at a Champion All Star function. You will be subject to immediate removal.
- 4.** Many people communicate with other parents, cheerleaders and members of other organizations through e-mail, Facebook, Twitter, and message boards. PLEASE remember, anything you say is a direct reflection on Champion.
- 5.** If you are found communicating negatively or sending rude or inappropriate messages, you will be subject to immediate removal.
- 6.** Upon entering and exiting Champion and while attending competitions, all athletes must be wearing appropriate attire; sports bra, uniform half tops and any other revealing attire must be covered by your warmup jacket or team shirt. This is a USASF rule that no bare midriffs are to show.
- 7.** When you are informed of the competition schedule, dates and arrival times, it is expected that these dates and times are adhered to and all athletes are at all practices prior to all competitions.
- 8.** All athletes are expected to be at every practice. Excessive unexcused absences will not be tolerated and are ground for removal. Please try to schedule vacations when Champion is closed.
- 9.** I understand and agree that tuition is due the 7th of every month and that there will be a \$25.00 late charge if not paid by the 7th of every month.
- 10.** Uniforms, accessories, camps, choreography, and competition fees are due on the exact due dates given to you.
- 11.** I understand that as a parent, I have read the Champion All Star Packet and am solely responsible for tuition, registration fees, Booster fees, uniform and accessories, camps, choreography, competition fees and travel expenses, and that all fees are Non-Refundable.
- 12.** If I choose to leave the program after July 14th, 2020. I am subject to a \$450.00 buy-out fee plus the remainder of the tuition for the season.
