### ❖ **May 2019:**

- **Dates & times to mark in your Calendar:** (Must attend at least two May tryout dates. Reveal teams beginning of June)
  - Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup>, Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>, Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup>, & Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup>. Times below, age is determined by your child's age as of August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019:
    - 5:00-6:30pm ages 5-11 years old
    - 6:30-8:30pm ages 11-18 years old
  - Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> 6:30pm Parents Meeting
- All forms & fee below **due prior to first clinic:** (we can not place you on a team till we receive ALL paperwork)
  - ✓ 2019 May Tryout Fee \$100
  - ✓ 2019-2020 Release Form (all medical sections must be completed) (also on website)
  - ✓ Member's Information Page (also on website)
  - ✓ Code of Conduct and Financial Commitment (also on website)
  - ✓ Copy of Birth Certificate (If we don't already have one)
  - ✓ Please read all star information packet/rules (on website only)

### ❖ **June 2019:**

- **Dates & times to mark in your Calendar:**
  - Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> 5:30-7:30pm is Team Reveal. (athletes only)
  - Wednesday, June 5<sup>th</sup> First Team Practice. Time will be given to kids at reveal 6/3/19.
  - June 11<sup>th</sup> till August 23<sup>rd</sup> Team Practices will be Tuesday & Thursdays. Time will be set once teams are determined, kids will receive these times at reveal 6/3/19. (estimating: morning, afternoon, late afternoon.)
- Registration Fee **due June 1<sup>st</sup>:** (This covers music, practice wear, & gym registration)
  - ✓ All Star Teams - \$285 (2019 May tryouts of \$100 will be deducted from this = \$185)
- Monthly All Star Fee is **due June 7<sup>th</sup>.** (These fees are billed every month from June 1, 2019 – April 30, 2020)
  - ✓ Level 1-2: \$115. Level 3-4: \$135. Level 5 \$140 & double teamers **only** pay for highest level team.
- Booster Fee is **due June 27<sup>th</sup>.** (This covers kids holiday gifts, team private rooms at competitions, end of the season gift & end of the season banquet meal, etc.)
  - ✓ Booster Fee \$80 & checks must be wrote to: Champion Boosters

### ❖ **July 2019:**

- **Dates & times to mark in your Calendar:**
  - Team practices remain the same in July, Tuesday & Thursdays – times same as June.)
  - Gym closed the week of July 1<sup>st</sup> – July 5<sup>th</sup>.
  - **Choreography is MANDATORY: Friday, July 26<sup>th</sup>. Saturday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. & Sunday, July 28<sup>th</sup>.**
- Monthly All Star Fee is **due July 7<sup>th</sup>.** (same details as above – June)
- Choreography Fee is **due July 9<sup>th</sup>** (once teams are set this amount will be determined)
- Uniform Fee is **due mid July.** (further details closer too)

- August Team practices Tuesday & Thursdays till August 23<sup>rd</sup> – Times same as July.
- Last week of August we'll begin evening practices: Monday, August 26<sup>th</sup> & Wednesday, August 28<sup>th</sup> only. (times given closer too)
  - Sunday practices will not begin till September 8<sup>th</sup>
- First Competition Fee **due August 1<sup>st</sup>**. (determined once competition schedule is set.)
  - 2019-Aug, Sept, Oct, Nov. & 2020-Jan, Feb, March will be months that competition fees will be billed. This is all the competition fees are we attending broken down into monthly payments.
- Monthly All Star Fee (same as above, **due August 7<sup>th</sup>**.)
- USASF Registration & **USASF Fee \$30. Complete AFTER AUG. 1st** This must be completed & paid on your own, details below:
  - ✓ 2019-2020 registration can not be completed until August 1<sup>st</sup> or after. If you register early your fee will *not* transfer into the 2019-2020 season.

## COMMITMENT FORM. CODE OF CONDUCT & FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

1. A member and a member's family, must at all times be a strong representative of Champion All Stars and a positive reflection on their team.
2. Abusive behavior, bullying, lying or any other form of negative behavior by a parent or child is grounds for removal from the team.
3. No Athlete shall drink alcohol or use any form of drugs including cigarettes while in Champion attire or at a Champion All Star function. You will be subject to immediate removal.
4. Many people communicate with other parents, cheerleaders and members of other organizations through e-mail, Facebook, Twitter, and message boards. PLEASE remember, anything you say is a direct reflection on Champion.
5. If you are found communicating negatively, or sending rude or inappropriate messages you will be subject to immediate removal.
6. Upon entering and exiting Champion and while attending competitions, all athletes must be wearing appropriate attire; sports bra, uniform half tops and any other revealing attire must be covered by your warm up jacket or team shirt. This is a USASF rule that no bare midriffs are to show.
7. When you are informed of the competition schedule, dates and arrival times, it is expected that these dates and times are adhered to and all athletes are at all practices prior to all competitions.
8. All athletes are expected to be at every practice. Excessive unexcused absences will not be tolerated and are ground for removal. Please try to schedule vacations when Champion is closed.
9. I understand and agree that tuition is due the 7<sup>th</sup> of every month and that there will be a \$25.00 late charge if not paid by the 7<sup>th</sup> of every month.
10. Uniforms, accessories, camps, choreography, and competition fees are due on the exact due dates given to you.
11. I understand that as a parent, I have read the Champion All Star Packet and am solely responsible for tuition, registration fees, Booster fees, uniform and accessories, camps, choreography, competition fees and travel expenses, and that all fees are Non-Refundable.
12. If I choose to leave the program after July 1<sup>st</sup> 2019, I am subject to a \$450.00 buy-out fee plus the remainder of the tuition for the season.
