PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Check In Monitoring Students to Clients to view-Station/ Event Students/ Cli-Sanitize equipment used				
*	What to Bring?	CDC recommends everyone over the age of 2 wear a mask. Students should bring a clearly labeled bag with their name. The contents should include a mask and a separate bag to place mask inside of (Masks will not be worn during class), a bottle of water (or more), and hand sanitizer. (Competitive athletes please see your additional list of items)		
*	Line Up	Outside of the facility, floor markers spaced 6 feet a part for a student & parent to enter the facility. Staff Members will notify you when it is time to enter the building.		
*	Temperature Monitoring	Every student, parent & staff member will have their temperature taken. It there is a temperature in the family of 99.5 or higher, they will be asked to leave and schedule a make up.		
*	Hand Sanitizing	Everyone will be required to sanitize their hands upon entering the facility. Also, everyone will be given a wipe for their shoes/feet upon entering.		
*	Class Call	Staff Members usher student & parent into facility. Families are limited to 1 parent per child & should they choose to stay & view the class, are asked to use only indicated seats. Parents will escort their child to the call in gate where they will receive a colored dot indicator of their starting color for the class. Once child is in gate, parents are asked to move to viewing areas or utilize our Spot TV from outside of the facility.		
*	Staff Work Habits & Standards	Staff will be required to wash hands before and after every class. Staff will be required to sanitize hands between every event. All staff members are to agree to adhere to a 24 hour wellness standard. Should they feel fatigued or obtain a fever within 24 hours of shift, they are required to call out from the shift. Mangers are to be notified immediately.		
*	Equipment Standards	Staff are required to sanitize all contact surfaces before and after every class. Staff will also, be required to sanitize stations after every rotation.		
*	Facility Ratios and Scheduling	We have set up classes to reduce our ratios for all classes and set up the facility for students and spectators to stay 6 feet a part for physical distancing. We have also, worked hard to allow for scheduling to reduce the amount of people in the facility at any given time.		
*	Spacing/ Physical Distancing	While attending class students, clients & staff are required to stay 6 feet a part from one another at all times. Tape or Velcro floor markers will be provided to establish distancing. If or when a coach deems it necessary to spot a child, the coach must wear a face mask.		
*	Entrance/ Walkways/ Restroom/ Viewing/ Water Fountain Standards	Staff is to sanitize all entry surfaces prior to and after every class. Proshop items and Cookies will not be sold at this time. Water Fountains will not be available during this time. Students must bring a water bottle. Staff is to sanitize viewing and restrooms between classes. Only 1 person allowed in the men's room at a time. Only 2 people allowed in the women's room at a time.		
*	Exiting	Staff Members are to escort students to the viewing areas for parent pick up. Student's whose parents did not stay for class will need to escorted to the exit for their parents to pick up at the door. All students, parents and staff members must keep physical distancing of 6 feet.

*	What to Bring?	CDC recommends everyone over the age of 2 wear a mask. Camp Paperwork must be completed. Students should bring a clearly labeled bag with their name. The contents should include a mask and a separate bag to place mask inside of (Masks will not be worn during any physical activity), a bottle of water (or more), and hand sanitizer. For Half Day Camps— please bring snacks for snack break. For 2 Half Day Camps— please bring lunch and snacks. (Competitive athletes please see your additional list of items)			
*	Line Up	Outside of the facility, floor markers spaced 6 feet a part for a student & parent to enter the facility. Staff Members will notify you when it is time to enter the building.			
*	Temperature Monitoring & Survey	Every child, parent & staff member will have their temperature & a survey taken. If there is a temperature in the family of 99.5 or higher and/or an answer is "yes", they will be asked to leave and call us at (209) 957-1919			
*	Hand Sanitizing	Everyone will be required to sanitize their hands upon entering the facility. Also, everyone will be given a wipe for their shoes/feet upon entering.			
*	Sign in/ Check in	Parents will sign in their child. Staff Members usher campers & parent (if parent wants to enter) into facility. Families are limited to 1 parent per child. Staff or Parents will escort their child to the call in gate where they will receive a colored dot indicator of their starting color for the camp. Once child is in gate, parents are asked to move to viewing areas or exit the building.			
*	Staff Work Habits & Standards	Staff will be required to wash hands before, after and during every camp. Staff will be required to sanitize hands between every event. All staff members are to agree to adhere to a 24 hour wellness standard. Should they feel fatigued or obtain a fever within 24 hours of shift, they are required to call out from the shift. Mangers are to be notified immediately.			
*	Equipment Standards	Staff are required to sanitize all contact surfaces before and after every camp. Staff will also, be required to sanitize stations after every rotation.			
*	Facility Ratios	We have set up camps to reduce our ratios for all camps and set up the facility for campers and spectators to stay 6 feet a part for physical distancing. Depending on Age Groupings—the ratio will be 8-10:1			
*	Spacing/ Physical Distancing	While attending camp students, clients & staff are required to stay 6 feet a part from one another at all times. Tape or Velcro floor markers will be provided to establish distancing.			
*	Entrance/ Walkways/ Restroom/ Viewing/ Water Fountain Standards	Staff is to sanitize all entry surfaces prior to and after every class. Proshop items and Cookies will not be sold at this time. Water Fountains will not be available during this time. Campers must bring a water bottle (or more). Staff is to sanitize viewing and restrooms between classes. Only 1 person allowed in the men's room at a time. Only 2 people allowed in the women's room at a time.			
*	Exiting	Parent's must sign out their camper at the front desk. Staff Members are to escort campers to the gate for parent pick up. All campers, parents and staff members must keep physical distancing of 6 feet or wear a mask.
