#### **OUR PHILOSOPHY**

All-Star Competitive Cheer is one of the most exciting and challenging activities available to kids today. This unique team sport combines gymnastics, dance and stunting in a fast-paced routine. All-Stars are athletes in every sense of the word. They are dedicated teammates who work very hard to achieve their goals. In the end they are rewarded by a sense of accomplishment and fulfillment that makes all of the work worthwhile. At Empire Elite we believe in providing a family atmosphere that teaches our students "life lessons" that will remain with them forever. Character, Commitment and Attitude are all values that we hope our athletes will strongly develop and carry into all areas of their lives. Our athletes will also gain valuable experience competing in front of nationally known judges and thousands of spectators increasing their confidence, courage and ability to handle pressure.

It is our goal to see each and every one of our members develop lasting relationships, a strong sense of self-worth, pride in being a part of something bigger than themselves, and life skills that will assist them in becoming positive and productive adults. We believe in the notion that while we have separate teams, we are all **ONE GYM**, and function as such. The Empire Elite family believes our successes lie not in the trophies we bring home, but in the relationships we build while traveling the path to victory.

While having fun is our main objective, there are some guidelines you must abide by and agree to when becoming a member of the Empire Elite All-Stars competition team. Please thoroughly read the following Competition Team packet, sign and date, and submit at the commitment meeting in May. Both <u>PARENTS</u> and <u>CHEERLEADERS</u> must sign this packet before joining – you will not be allowed to start practicing without the signed forms on file.

#### TEAM PLACEMENTS

Immediately following tryouts each member will be placed on a "Primary" team – this is the team they must agree to join. Some members may also be offered a "crossover" option, which allows a member to be on two different teams. Being a crossover is not mandatory, but if you commit to it, you must see it through for the entire season. If a member decides to be a crossover, they will not be charged monthly team fees for their second team, however, they will have to pay whatever other costs are involved with each team (competition crossover & camp fees). They will also be required to attend all team practices each week. On our tryout form, you can choose whether or not you want to be considered for a crossover position. We will offer some or all of the following teams for 2021-2022:

Not everyone can be on the team of their choice, you've got to start somewhere and work your way up. While age is one indicator for our team placements, we also take into account skill levels, maturity, and work ethic. There may be instances when we offer a younger aged cheerleader a spot on an older team, but whenever that happens, we warn parents that we will not treat the cheerleader as though they were younger. They will be required to perform material that is age-appropriate for an older team, and they will be expected to act as maturely as those around them. In some cases, we may find that a cheerleader is highly skilled enough to be placed on an older team, but we do not find their social skills an appropriate fit for that team, in which case, we would keep them on the younger team. Whatever the situation, we expect cheerleaders and their parents to respect our decisions on team placements. We believe an individual will excel and be most happy when placed on a team that compliments their skill level, as well as their maturity level. Furthermore, we strongly feel that all of our teams, regardless of age or skill level, will have an extremely successful season. Our ultimate goal is to create teams that are balanced in all technical areas of cheerleading and provide members the best possible chance of placing in the top three at competition.



Cheerleaders tryout to be a member of Empire Elite All-Stars, not for any particular team or position. Coaches will place each cheerleader on the best possible team for them, based on age, maturity, individual skills and team needs. We reserve the right to place anyone on any team we see fit, regardless of their experience or age. We also reserve the right to move individuals to another team that might be a better fit for them after the season goes on and we have assessed that they would work out better somewhere else. All decisions are made based on what's best for the team, as well as the individual. We do not play favorites and we approach everyone equally, regardless of what team they may have been on previously. As such, coaches decisions are final and are not up for discussion. Please do not request your child to be a flyer, base etc.

ANY PARTICIPANT ON AN EMPIRE ELITE ALL-STAR TEAM IS NOT PERMITTED TO TAKE ANY TYPE OF CLASSES, PRIVATES, OR JOIN TEAMS AT ANY OTHER CHEER OR GYMNASTICS FACILITY, UNLESS REQUIRED TO DO SO BY A SCHOOL SQUAD.

#### ATTITUDE

#1 RULE IN OUR GYM: ALL MEMBERS MUST DISPLAY A POSITIVE ATTITUDE AT ALL TIMES. Everyone has a bad day at times, but we want our gym to be the place you come to get away from negativity – leave your frowns at the door and always remember to keep things positive. Negative attitudes and disrespect are not acceptable from anyone (cheerleader, coach or parent), and will be considered grounds for suspension or dismissal if the negativity persists.

Work ethic is crucial for our teams, and it is expected that you will come to practice ready to cheer and willing to give whatever your team needs you to give. Sometimes you will be asked to perform in positions you don't normally do or enjoy. It is during these times that your true character is being tested, and we hope that you will take that opportunity to shine.

#### **COMMUNICATIONS**

Our primary mode of communication is via email. All members are required to provide an email address, which should be checked at least once a day. We will try to provide hard copies of information at the gym, but sometimes communications need to go out last minute and email is the best way to get that info out. Please make a point to check your email often. All members are also required to create an account on our website member's area. The member's area will have a team calendar that is updated often as well as team announcements and updates. It is the team members and parents responsibility to check the member's area often in order to keep up to date on events and information.

#### **PRACTICES**

Teams will practice three times a week (2 team + 1 tumbling). Level 4 & 5 teams will practice 4 times a week (2 team + 2 tumbling). All members are to attend all team and tumbling practices. The attached schedule is an **EXAMPLE** of what practices might look like. Final schedules will be announced following tryouts.

#### ATTENDANCE

You are allowed three excused absences from your team practices in a season. An excused absence is one in which you call/email ahead of time to let the office and the coaches know which day you will be missing. The earlier you can let us know the better. The only EXCUSED absences are those for school functions that result in a grade, a funeral, a wedding, a pre-planned vacation or if you have a fever or contagious illness. If for any reason you miss more than your allotted three absences, it will be up to the staff's discretion on what measures to take. There are NO EXCUSED ABSENCES 2 WEEKS BEFORE A COMPETITION, TEAM PRATICES & TUMBLE ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL MEMBERS. Any member missing 2 consecutive practices without making arrangements in advance will be subject to removal from the team. If a team member is injured or sick (not contagious) and unable to participate they must still attend and watch all practices.

Because our season is a total of 9 months we have several gym closures throughout the year and we ask that families try to arrange their vacations around these dates to avoid practice conflicts.

Please be on time to practice. When you are late, the entire team is held up for you. We know that life happens, and sometimes you just can't help it (coaches are late sometimes, too!), but if you are on time the majority of the time, we will be more understanding when you are not. If a team member is more than 15 minutes late it will be counted as an absence.

Full team attendance is key to the success of a program! School dances, homework, or social events are not an excuse for missing practice. These types of absences will not be excused.

PLEASE NOTE: Tumble class absences are not included in the above attendance policy. As long as a member is not missing an excessive amount of tumble classes we will be understanding to the occasional tumble absence and will not count it against the member. Tumble classes the week of competitions are mandatory.

#### **FEES**

#### ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE:

Each member will be charged a non-refundable \$45 registration fee upon joining the team.

#### **UNIFORMS (FEMALES): \$640**

Uniform includes: Custom body liner, custom bottom, bow, and cheer shoes.

#### **UNIFORMS (MALES): \$435**

Uniform includes: Custom top, black pants and cheer shoes.

#### **UNIFORMS (RETURNING MEMBERS): \$35**

Uniform includes: Competition bow. You are not required to purchase a new uniform, shoes or practice wear. If you decide you need to purchase any of these items, payment will be due at time of purchase.

\*Both Uniform and Spirit Pack are broken down into four installment payments called Empire Payments due in June, July, August, and September.

#### **USASF FEE:**

USASF Athlete Membership fee is \$30.00. Memberships will be completed and paid for by the athlete's parent. You will receive more details about this upon joining.

#### **SUMMER SCHEDULE:**

We will run 2 team practices and weekly tumble and jump, conditioning, and stretch classes (FCJ) throughout the summer from June 1st- July 23<sup>rd</sup>. The last week of July, classes will be available as drop in options only. Within this time frame we will have 2 team practices. The tentative dates for these team practices are as follows: July 26<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>

Cost for Summer Practices and Classes: \$405 per member

\*This cost includes 2 tumble classes per week, 2 jump, conditioning, and stretch class (FCJ) per week & 2 team practices total.

WE DO NOT PRO RATE THE COST FOR SUMMER NO EXCEPTIONS. However, we will allow make-ups if class sizes permit us to do so. Members are required to pay the full amount regardless if they miss one or more days. We allow make-ups during the month of August for those who travel during the summer.

#### **EXTRA SUMMER CLASSES:**

We will be offering extra tumble and FCJ classes to our teams at a discounted rate. More details and schedule will be released in our team commitment packets after tryouts.

#### STUNT CAMP:

All teams (with the exception of the tiny team) will be attending a stunt camp hosted at our gym in addition to their choreography camp. Cost is \$125 per member. Even if you join the team after stunt camp, you remain responsible for paying this fee, as you will still benefit from the stunts choreographed for the routine. Stunt camp is mandatory for all team members. All members must stay the full camp from start to finish, no exceptions will be made.

Tentative dates for our 2021-2022 stunt camp are tentative but we believe they will be the following: Aug 30th – Sept 3rd

#### **CHOREOGRAPHY CAMP (Included in spirit pack):**

The choreography camp fee is included in your spirit pack, which will allow us to pay for national-caliber routines and quality, custom-made music. This will be a private choreography camp hosted at our gym. Choreography camp is closed for viewing. Even if you join the team after the choreographer has taught the routine, you remain responsible for paying this fee, as you will still benefit from the routine. Choreography camp is mandatory for all team members. All members must stay the full camp from start to finish, no exceptions will be made. Dates for our 2021-2022 choreography camp are tentative but we believe they will be the following: TBD

#### **CHOREOGRAPHY CLEAN-UP:**

Choreography clean-up will be scheduled for late October / early November. Fee: \$60.00 (Not all teams will participate).

#### **MONTHLY TUITION:**

#### All Boys: NO TUITION

- -Tuition begins August 1<sup>st</sup>. Our season runs from August 2021 thru April 2022. If a team is awarded and attends a bid to a Nationals that requires practices in May, May tuition will be charged and pro-rated.
- -Tuition is due at the first of every month. A \$15 late fee is assessed after the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month.
- -Empire does not charge any additional fees for scheduled extra practices during the season months nor pro-rate.

**FAMILY DISCOUNT:** 20% off monthly tuition per sibling

#### **PAYMENT**

We accept cash, check, and major credit cards (no American Express). However a 3.50% fee will be assessed to all charges if you choose to pay by credit card.

#### CREDIT CARD REQUIREMENT

All team members will be required to have a valid credit card/debit card on file. Your card will not be charged unless your account becomes 30 days past due, or unless you authorize us to automatically withdraw from your account each month. Each member will be required to complete a credit card authorization form prior to joining the team. You will not be allowed to join the team without a valid credit card on file. Without a valid credit card on file, the only option to join the team would be to pay 50% of the year's fees in advance, and the remaining 50% is due mid-way through the season.

All competitions are <u>mandatory</u> for all team members – if you are unable to attend your team's assigned competitions, you will not be allowed to join or remain on the team.

If a member leaves early from an awards ceremony, they forfeit any rights to a jacket, metal, trophy etc. unless an emergency or sick which must be excused.

Members are expected to arrive on time in required clothing to all competitions. If a member is more than 10 minutes late, this will be counted as one of your 3 excused absences each member is allowed per season.

We consider Empire Elite athletes part of our family. As such, family is expected to support each other. At specific times throughout the season you will be asked to support other teams at competitions. This is not negotiable. All athletes (including your child) perform better when there is a large crowd of encouragement. Do your part to support the other teams of Empire Elite.

#### NATIONAL COMPETITIONS

All teams except for the Tiny and Mini team will attend two National competitions per season. Our Tiny teams do not travel to any out of state competitions. Mini teams will only be attending one of the two out of state Nationals. The last few years we have traveled to the Encore in San Diego, the American Legacy in Loveland, CO, the American Celebration in Salt Lake City, UT, The American Grand in Las Vegas, NV, Encore in Las Vegas and American Showcase in Anaheim, CA. National competitions are mandatory for all team members – if you are unable to attend your team's assigned nationals trips, you will not be allowed to join or remain on the team. If a member leaves early from an awards ceremony, they forfeit any rights to a jacket, metal, trophy etc. unless an emergency or sick which must be excused. A team may attend an additional nation competition if a bid is awarded. It is our goal to get a bid to the D2 Summit.

#### **COMPETITION FEES**

Competition fees are not included in monthly tuition. We will collect competition fees a couple of months prior to every competition. Fees range from \$75-\$90 per competition. National fees range from \$135-\$180. You will receive a competition pay schedule with a breakdown of competitions, fees, and due dates as soon as they are released from all of the brands.

#### **COACHES TRAVEL & COMPETITION FEES (does not apply to Tiny team Members)**

Each team member will pay \$100 for coaches travel and competition fees. Members of our Mini team will pay \$50 for coaches travel fees. This fee will cover the expenses for our coaching staff to travel and attend all of our competitions. This fee will be included in your Empire payments. Bids may add additional coaches travel fees. In the case that a bid competition results in a team practicing into the month of May, additional tuition fees may apply.
