

TINY TALENT SHOWCASE FAQ

1. Who participates in the Tiny Talent Showcase?

We typically have over 50 participants in our annual Tiny Talent Showcase. All students from our Parent/Tot and Toddler 2.5-3.5 classes are invited to participate in the Showcase. Participation is not mandatory but highly encouraged as the event is super cute and laid back and performed in a familiar atmosphere. Each class will showcase specific “routines” during the performance. PLEASE NOTE: the class is ***NOT*** structured around the showcase so children still enrolled in class but not participating in the performance will still continue to receive a productive class setting.

2. Where will the Showcase be held?

Our adorable Showcase is held at Bright Stars: a familiar, comfortable atmosphere. Students will sit with their families until their specific group is called up to perform. Parents love to have the opportunity to see their little ones perform with their instructor. There are sure to be many “Kodak” moments.

3. What time will the show take place?

We will have 2 sessions for the showcase. Performances will be held in the afternoon on Saturday, June 9th. Each class child participates in ONE session. The length of each session is approx. 1 hour. Times will be confirmed at the end of May.

4. Are tickets required?

Yes. Tickets are sold on a 1st come 1st served basis. All tickets are ***discounted*** to \$7 each during outfit distribution/ticket sales (May 21st – 25th). Any tickets purchased AFTER that date will be \$9 each. Children under the age of 5 sitting on a lap do not need a ticket. Children participating in the show do not need a ticket. We need to charge this fee due the expenses incurred leading up to and during the performance. ***(Please note that tickets are non-refundable)***

5. Is there assigned seating?

We conveniently allow seating on a first come first served basis. There is folding chair seating. We also offer reserved handicap seating.

6. When is payment due?

Payment is due March 1st. We are not able to order uniforms for anyone who has an outstanding fee. Please keep in mind, many times our supplier is not able to fill reorders. Therefore NO late orders will be accepted. For your convenience we will charge the credit card on file if the gym show fee is not paid by the due date and you have not notified us if your child is not participating. If you are in need of a payment arrangement please let us know. We will be happy to work with you.

7. Will classes continue after the Showcase?

Yes. The last day of Pay Period 5 of our School Year Session is June 22nd. Our Summer Session begins July 2nd.

8. Does a parent have to participate?

The performance groups are kept small and we have an instructor available for each child. You just get to sit back and enjoy the show. However, there may be an occasion where the performers are a little shy and may feel more comfortable with a family member standing nearby to help with their comfort level.
