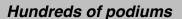

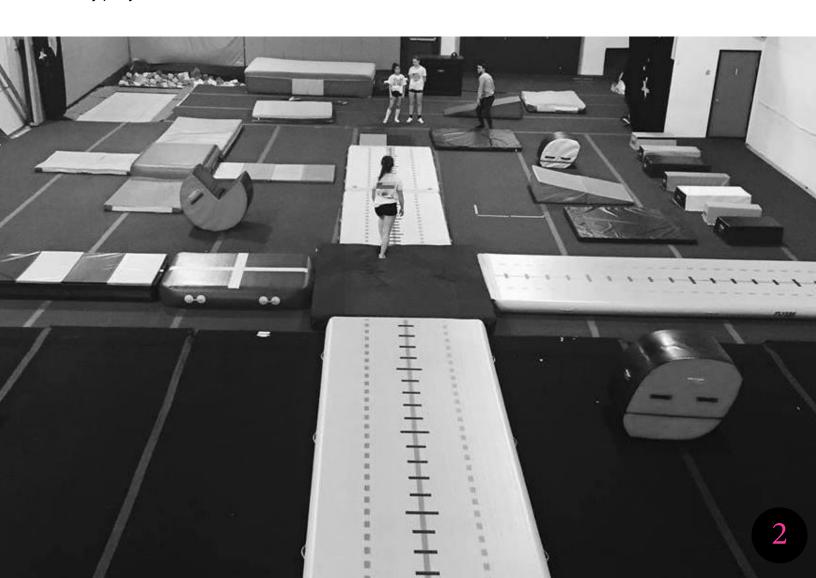

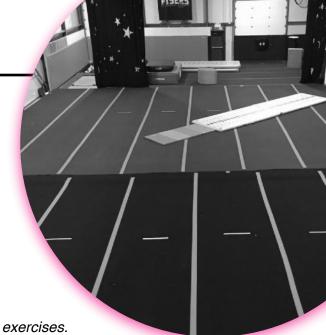


Flyers Cheer Gym

- A large foam cube pit served for trampoline, tumble track, and floor exercises.

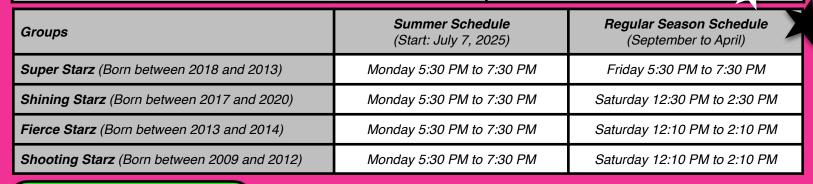

National Competitive Program

This program emphasizes safe competitive cheerleading practice in a stimulating environment. Athletes will have the opportunity to refine their skills through comprehensive training in cheerleading and floor gymnastics, preparing them for participation in multiple competitions throughout the season.

The primary goal is to develop the technical skills necessary for competition while promoting the athletes' personal growth. This program provides an enriching experience where athletes can push their limits, enhance their self-confidence, and develop qualities such as discipline and determination.

*Evaluation participation required.

Training: Cheerleading: 2 X 2 hours per week. (Summer 1 X 2 hours per week)

Tumbling: 1 tumbling class per week.

Competition: Minimum of 4 competitions in addition to the Nationals at Mississauga (Ontario). Participation in the Pink Premier show (November) and the Pink Finale show (April).

Level: 1 to 5 Age: Born in 2020 or earlier (varies based on demand) Season: July to April

Training and tumbling fees*: \$1910

Included: - Technical training in cheerleading and tumbling
