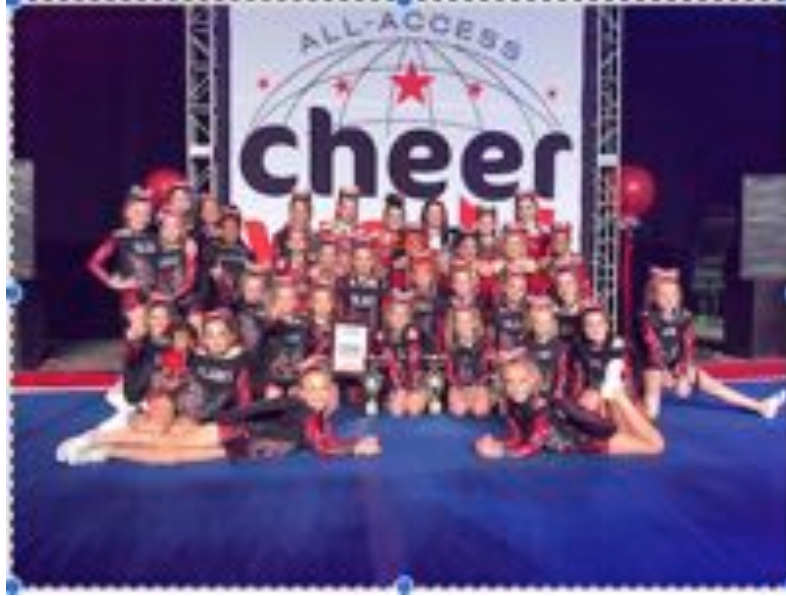

The Staff is highly qualified to coach All-Star Cheerleading, so please understand that we know what we are doing when it comes to All-Star Cheer. PRACTICES: The commitment you are making will be from Tryouts in **APRIL 2018 to the last competition in April 2019.** Please understand that even one team member missing from practice/competition adversely affects the entire team and excessive absences

WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

GYM LOYALTY: As a Cheer Town All Star Team member, you will NOT be allowed to participate in Tumbling Classes or Private Lessons with a Coach that is not employed by Cheer Town!

ABSENCES: All Athletes are expected to attend EVERY practice. We are aware of school activities and have tried to schedule classes around them. However, we cannot adjust our schedules to fit you own personal extracurricular activities. Athletes missing from class set back the entire squad from progressing. You are required to wear your practice attire to each and every practice. Not wearing the proper attire will result in extra conditioning no matter what the excuse is. Extra practices WILL be held the weekend before or week of every competition. Please keep this in mind when scheduling activities, trips, etc.... as these practices are MANDATORY!

EXCUSED ABSENCES: Contagious illness, Death in Family, Graded School Activity,

UNEXCUSED ABSENCES: Injury (come in and watch practice), other school activities, homework/test (plan ahead), parties, vacations, birthdays etc...

SUMMER PRACTICES

Attendance is required during summer. Please list any summer activities that will require you to miss practice(s) and turn them in to Robin. If you think you are going to take off the Summer and be on a Team, you would be WRONG! If you don't come to Summer Practices, you will be removed from the Team.

Every Team member is expected to attend every competition. Any athlete that misses a competition may be removed from the Team.

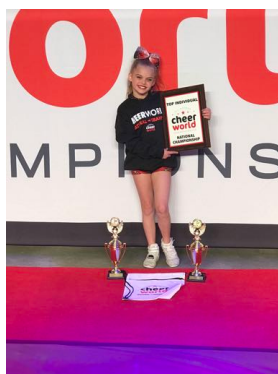

This is "Competitive Cheerleading"

You are expected to attend all practices exhibitions and competitions as a team. Our routines are coordinated around every team member. Therefore, one member's absence has a negative impact on all other team members. Be prepared to rearrange your schedules as needed, however, we will try to maintain a routine schedule in order for you to be able to make advance personal plans.

TUMBLING CLASSES: All Cheer Town All-Stars are required to take 1 tumbling class during the week, which is included in the monthly tuition.

CONDITIONING: Due to the strenuous physical activity required of an All-Star, it is very important that each athlete is involved in some type of physical conditioning program and stretching exercises either at home or at school outside the gym. It is not possible for an athlete to be in peak physical condition if their All-Star practice is the only physical activity in which they are apart of.

VALUABLES inside the gym: Many items come up missing in the gym every year. Please do not bring any valuables to the gym. If you bring valuables into the gym you are doing so understanding the risk you are taking. Cell Phone will be put in Cell Phone Box until the end of practice if they are brought into the gym.

- * Siblings not in class will have to stay in the parent box.
- * Once practice has started, athletes are expected to stay with team until dismissed by a Coach.
- * Fingernails are to be kept short.
- * Excessive talking, playing, back talk, tardiness or refusal to follow gym rules will result in Conditioning, Probation or removal from Team.
- * All Fees must be kept current.
- * Any parent that needs to talk with a coach must schedule a private meeting with that Coach and/or Robin.
- * Only Cheer Town Staff is allowed in the Office.
- * Students are NOT allowed to wait outside for a ride. They must wait inside the gym.
- * Negative discussions about Cheer Town, Coaches, Teams and/or students WILL NOT be tolerated.
- * All athletes must assume a role that is best suited for their Team. This is a Team Sport, there is no position more important than the other.
- * No Drugs or Alcohol usage by a minor in conjunction with Cheer Town.
- * All parents and athletes within this program are expected to be strong representatives of Cheer Town. Abusive behavior, lying, stealing, or any other negative behavior by any team member or their parent may result in dismissal from the program. Bad attitudes, back talking, rolling of the eyes and any other form of Disrespect to the coaching staff or other Team members will be grounds for dismissal. Negative comments about team members, other programs or other parents will not be tolerated. As an Athlete and a Parent you are expected to respect others.
