FAQ

Thank you for your interest in the San Diego Show Cheer and Dance 2019 half Season. We are honored to invite you and your cheerleader to become a part of the Show family. Please be advised that Assessments will be held on Saturday, January 5 at the Show gym from 3:30pm-5:00pm. Please arrive between 10 and 15 minutes before your child's designated time to get your cheerleader registered. A nonrefundable \$75 deposit is required at the time of registration as well as a copy of your child's birth certificate. This assessment is Closed to all, except Show coaches and prospective cheerleaders.

What will be assessed?

Jumps, Tumbling, Flexibility, stunting; ability to follow directions, and formations. Once we do the assessment we will photograph your child and upload your child's birth certificate, as well as fit them for a uniform.

When does practice start? What days will we practice?

Practice will begin on Saturday *Jan 26*. 3pm-5pm (all practices for half season will be held on Saturdays) and tumbling classes on Monday or Wednesday 5pm-6pm.

Competition 2: *March 17 @ Bolsa Grande High School*

How much will the season cost and what do the fees cover?

The cost for half season from Jan 26- Mar 18, is \$500, and covers the following

- Registration for 2 competitions
- Insurance
- Uniform: Shell / Bottoms / Competition Bows
- Gym (practice) / Tumbling Fees (one day a week)

When is the \$500 fee due?

- \$425 due by 02/09/19
