

What Is Half Year?

Half Year Teams are a lighter version of all star cheerleading. Teams practice only twice a week, and attend 3 one day Northern California competitions and one Reno competition. The cost, travel, and time commitment are perfect for those just starting out in All Star, those who play other sports, or those that cannot commit to a full year program.

Who Can Participate?

Half Year teams are perfect for first-time cheerleaders who want to try out all stars, returning athletes who like a limited season, or football cheerleaders who want to keep competing through their off season!

No experience necessary for half year. Ages 5-18, boys and girls.

How Do I Get Storted?

Fill out the registration forms and submit them to Fusion Elite in person or by email.

You'll receive a welcome email and practices will begin October 14.

Want to start sooner? Ask us about classes that can get you ready for the season.

Families can also begin fundraising as soon as their registration is in – even before the season starts!

When Are Proctices?

Practices begin October 14 and run through April 12, 2025.

Practices will be held Mondays & Wednesdays 5:30 - 7:15pm.

Times are tentative and may be changed if we create more than one half year team. Team may be split by age if we receive more than 25 registrations. If the schedule changes, you will be notified by email or phone.

Financial Policies

*All-inclusive fees cover instructional hours, choreography camp, equipment fees, administrative fees, insurance, end-of-season award ceremony, competition fees, coaches competition/travel fees, uniform top and bottom (for new athletes), competition bow, and Season 12 tee shirt. Additional apparel and accessories will be available, but not required.

*Payment is due on the 1st of each month by automatic withdrawal from a major credit/debit/ATM card unless otherwise arranged on your contract.

*You will have access to the Fusion parent portal, so you have your account at your fingertips. Log on to see account history, update card info, make payments or view your upcoming fees. If you have questions about your account, please let us know before the 1st of the month.

*It is the responsibility of the parent signing the contract to meet all financial requirements. Fusion does <u>not</u> coordinate payments between ex-spouses unless they are both present and sign separate contracts. Athletes under 18 are not allowed to sign financial contracts, and cannot be held responsible for fees.

*If payment has not posted by the 10th of the month, a \$25 late fee will be assessed, and the athlete will be removed from practice until payment is made. Accounts that reach 30 days past due will cause us to remove your child from our program, and send your account to an outside collection agency.

*All fees are non-refundable. When you sign up for a team, Fusion commits to pay for travel expenses, uniforms, etc. on your behalf, and when an athlete leaves the program, we are often obligated to pay for these commitments. Therefore, we will be unable to refund any portion of the fees paid if a participant chooses to leave Fusion Elite before the season is over.

*Fusion Kids Center requires a 30 day written drop notice. Tuition is due during those 30 days. Oral notices are not acceptable. No drops are allowed between January and April – drops during this time are particularly damaging to the team and routine. Athletes who drop during this time will still be required to pay tuition and all other team expenses until the end of the season.

*We do our best to give you an accurate estimate of what expenses will be incurred during the season, and every effort is made to reduce costs wherever possible. We will notify you as soon as possible when an actual cost differs from the estimates listed here, and reserve the right to add an additional charge to your account if there is an increase in the anticipated costs.

Attendance

Athletes must be at practice. Period. Since routines and stunts absolutely require the presence of each team member, missing practices, being tardy, and/or leaving early from practices, events or competitions is not tolerated. Absences and tardiness will affect the athlete's placement on his/her team and in his/her routine.

*Under no circumstances may an athlete miss practice the week leading up to a competition.

*Using practices or competitions as leverage for discipline is not allowed, as this will cause stress on the whole team.

*Extra practices are sometimes required before events, depending on the needs of the team. We will give as much advance notice as possible.

*Athletes may be moved in the routine, removed from stunts, pyramids and sections of the routine if an athlete's attendance creates a hardship or safety issue for the rest of the team.



*Tumbling and cheer classes are optional, but a great way to further your skills in cheerleading. Team practices are reserved for routine work, so individual skill development must be done in classes.

*We offer an unlimited season class pass upon registration, which gives you unlimited classes for your whole season for only \$45/month. This is a 40% discount from our regular fees. Unlimited class pass may only be purchased when registering, and is a contract for the full season (through April.)

*Those who choose not to purchase the unlimited class pass can still attend classes at the regular rate.
