ABOUT FUSION ELITE ALL STARS

<u>Who's Eligible:</u> Everyone is welcome at Fusion Elite! This info packet is for All Star Elite/Prep Teams that are full-year travel teams for ages 5-19. We have teams for every age and ability level, so <u>no one gets cut!</u> Whether you've been a competitive athlete for 10 years, or are just starting out, we have a team for you!

<u>Other programs:</u> Fusion Elite offers a variety of classes and teams for all ages, abilities and budgets in addition to the Full Year Elite teams. Please see our website for a full listing of other programs.

<u>What we do:</u> Fusion Elite is a competition-based program. Our athletes practice 2-3 times per week and compete at mostly California/Nevada events and one travel competition per year. While our program is based on competition, we feel that our organization exists to build self-esteem, confidence, work ethic, leadership, healthy lifestyle habits, and friendships that will last a lifetime.

<u>Teams:</u> We had 11 cheer teams last season. The number of teams we create depends on the number of athletes that register. Teams are selected based on age and athlete experience level.

<u>Cost:</u> Travel sports are expensive ventures. We understand that it takes financial sacrifice to be involved in a program that travels and competes on a national level. We do everything we can to ensure a quality program for the lowest cost possible. Compare our prices with similar organizations, and you will find that Fusion Elite is far less expensive. Evaluations are done on a walk-in basis. Come at your convenience any time during the time window listed above. Your individual evaluation will only take 30 minutes to an hour. If you cannot attend one of the dates above, please contact us for a private evaluation. Wear comfortable clothing, hair up and athletic shoes.



Receive team placements by text and email on or before May 10th. Begin regular team practices on May 15th.

*Evaluations are casual and fun! You will meet our staff, other athletes, and get acquainted with our facility. Since everyone makes a team, there is very little stress involved!

*We create teams with competition in mind. Athletes will be placed on teams according to their ability and their age. We consider all aspects of cheerleading and place everyone on specific teams for a reason. Regardless of the team, we are confident that your athlete will shine!

*Rosters will not be considered FINAL until choreography at the end of June. This will give our staff time to work with each athlete and ensure that he/she is on the team that best fits with his/her abilities, age and goals.

*We reserve the right to move participants, combine teams, or split teams during the season if it will benefit the program, the team or the athlete.

FUNDRAISING • DISCOUNTS

- The Power Company Booster Club A non-profit organization that puts on fundraisers several times per year. Depending on how involved parents and participants are, they can raise a large portion of their expenses.
- 2) Athletic Edge Parents earn money by working concession booths at concerts/sporting events. Interested parents should visit www.athleticedgeinc.com for info, and must sign up individually we have a meeting at the beginning of the season to help you get started!
- 3) We offer \$30/mo. discount for the second child, and \$45/mo. for the third+ child in a household.

MORE ABOUT FEES

- *Athletes starting later in the season will have a higher monthly payment, as season fees are the same, but will be divided over fewer months.
- *Uniforms are used on a 3-year cycle. This is year 3/3.
- *Uniform Package for new athletes includes uniform top/bottom, competition bow and tee shirt. Uniform package for returning athletes includes bow and tee shirt. Additional apparel and accessories are available, but not required.
- *Parents are responsible for purchasing their own shoes, link will be given once the season starts to order.
- *Fusion Season Class Pass gives unlimited classes for the entire season at a discounted rate. Promo rate is only available upon registration and with a commitment for the entire year. The Season Pass is a 70% discount off of normal class rates.
- *All payments, charges and fees are handled through the Fusion Parent Portal. Every member MUST have a credit card on file, and by registering, you give the right to Fusion Kids Center to charge the card on file for all fees incurred throughout the season.

CROSSOVERS

Crossovers are athletes that participate on more than one all star team.

- *If you are interested in becoming a crossover, please indicate so on your registration forms, and you will be considered when we place our teams.
- *Crossovers are charged \$25/month gym fee per crossover team **plus** additional competition fees incurred by their additional teams (Crossover comp fees are billed on the 1st of the month in which the competition takes place.)



PRACTICES & ATTENDANCE

- *All teams will practice twice per week in May, June & July. Summer practices will be on WEEKDAYS.
- *From August-April, all teams will practice 3 times per week, 2 WEEKDAYS and 1 WEEKEND practice.
- *Practice schedules will be determined by the number of teams we create.
- *Additional practices may be added if necessary during competition season and/or in the event of injury or replacement.

POLICY

Fusion Elite does not excuse absences. Each absence affects the team negatively, regardless of the circumstances, and keeps other athletes from being able to practice effectively.

To hold every family and athlete accountable in the same manner, the following will apply:

Each athlete may miss 8 practices. These may be used for illnesses, vacations, school events, family events, etc. It is up to the parent how the absences are used. No guarantee is made that athletes will keep their original roles when missing practices. Team before individual.

After the 8 absences are exhausted, any missed practices will cause the athlete to be removed from vital sections of the routine. Simply put, if a team cannot depend on an athlete, that athlete cannot hold important roles on the team.

Arriving late or leaving early more than <u>20 minutes</u> is considered a miss.

Athletes must sign in at the front desk kiosk in order to be marked present.

Absolutely NO missed practices are allowed the two weeks prior to any competition or during any choreography session.

Continual missed practices/team activities will result in athletes being moved to a lower level team, a program with less commitment required, or being removed from the program entirely.

Teams will attend 2-3 five-hour blocks during this time period – schedule will be released after team placements.

Dance/Pyramid Choreography – One/Two Sessions in September or October, TBD

Competition Schedule will be released in July

*Choreography sessions and competitions are MANDATORY.



COMPETITION & TRAVEL

COMPETITIONS

Full year teams compete at 6-8 competitions.

4-5 events in Northern/Central California, 1-2 events on the west coast (driving distance) and one travel event that our parents get to choose! Events may be one day or two day.

POST-SEASON EVENTS


Teams are eligible to qualify for post-season events, such as The Summit, US Finals or The Pinnacle when they do well at scheduled competitions.

Some of these events will be optional, and some will be required in the event of qualification. This information will be listed on the competition schedule when it is released.

Post-season events are not included and may incur additional fees and travel. Details will be given as teams qualify for these events.

MORE ABOUT

- *All competitions are required.
- *Competitions/events are the first priority of the athletes on Fusion Elite while traveling. Although we compete in fun locations, vacationing and leisure activities cannot conflict with the needs of the team.
- *Parents are required to make timely reservations in order to secure travel and hotel accommodations.
- *Travel competitions (events more than 4 hours away) may require a Friday arrival and a Monday return. Should we attend out of state events, we may require a longer stay.



PARENT EXPECTATIONS

We have read the registration packet and understand the commitment we are making to the Fusion Elite program, staff and other team members:

Payment is due on the 1st of each month by automatic withdrawal from a VISA/MC. There is a \$25 service fee during each month that there is no valid card on file OR if card comes back declined or expired.

Fusion does not send statements. Parents have 24/7 access to account information and balance on Fusion's parent portal.

It is the responsibility of the parent or other adult <u>signing the contract</u> to meet all financial requirements. In the event that you wish to split your fees between co-parents, BOTH parents must sign a contract and a meeting will be required to set up a fee schedule.

If payment has not posted by the 10th of the month, a \$25 late fee will be assessed, and the athlete will be removed from practice until payment is made. Accounts that reach 30

days past due will cause athlete to be removed from the team, and all balances will be assessed 18% interest monthly until paid in full. Delinquent accounts past 90 days will be sent to small claims court for enforcement.

This is a contract for the 2024-2025 season (May-April.) Families have 30 days from the date the contract is signed before it becomes binding. Contracts canceled within the 30-day window will be refunded minus the registration fee (and any fees that may have been paid on your athlete's behalf.) If, for any reason, a contract is broken after the 30-day window, the member must continue to pay off the contract OR pay a 1-time termination fee of \$500. There are no refunds if you leave our program. We do this to cover the expense of finding someone to fulfill your responsibility to your team.

Practices may be viewed from the parent viewing area only. Parents and non-participating children are not allowed to watch practices from inside the cheer gym or be on any gym equipment or performing surfaces.

Transportation and accommodations while traveling to competitions are not included, and are the responsibility of the parents. Some families choose to send their athletes with other gym families. Fusion does not take responsibility for damages/issues resulting from arrangements made between parents.

Issues, concerns or complaints should be directed to the coach or program owner. Issues should be discussed with coaches in private, and parents should always show respect for staff in front of athletes. Negative behavior by parents is not tolerated and is grounds for dismissal of your family from this program. Our staff utilizes a 24-hour rule when responding to complaints that do not affect the immediate safety of our athletes.

Threatening to pull an athlete from the program for any reason will cause Fusion Elite to immediately remove your child from the routine or team. We need to make sure every family is dedicated to finishing out the season for their team's sake.

It is the parent's responsibility to read all GroupMe announcements, flyers, emails and informational materials to stay up to date on gym events and news.

Participating on a full travel team may require up to 4 missed school days per season.

If an athlete participates in multiple activities, parents must ensure that Fusion Elite takes priority.

Fusion Elite reserves the right to move athletes within a routine or between teams at our sole discretion. Teams may be split or combined at any time if it will benefit the overall program. Athletes do not own, nor are they entitled to any "spot" or position in the routine, and will likely be moved around the routine many times during a season. Our coaches and staff will make changes based on their expertise, scoring system, judges' feedback and overall team needs. Parents are not coaches and will not be allowed to question placement in a routine – these decisions are made by our staff only with the best interest of the program and team in mind.

Athletes may be removed from routines or from the program for failure to follow attendance policy, behavior policy or payment policies. Parents are expected to support the gym when they discipline athletes for these failures to follow rules.

Competitions are ALL DAY EVENTS. Fusion requires athletes to stay and support the other teams during their performances, and athletes must be present at their award ceremonies. Please do not plan anything else on a competition day and do not encourage your athletes to break the rules and leave early.

Parents are expected to ensure that their athletes are in the correct attire, hair and make-up during events. If an athlete breaks these rules, parents are expected to support the gym when they discipline athletes with consequences.



ATHLETE EXPECTATIONS

I have read the registration packet and understand the commitment I am making to the Fusion Elite program, staff and other team members.

I will participate for the entire season, and not quit mid-season and hurt my gym and my teammates.

I will maintain a positive attitude and work ethic and will follow all coaches' instructions.

I will be at practice, be on time, and give 100% when I'm there.

I agree that if I participate in activities other than Fusion Elite, my all star team comes first.

I will refrain from being negative about the program, coaches, and team members in person and in public forums and on social media. I will refrain from posting anything inappropriate while in uniform, at competitions, or at any time that I could be connected to the Fusion Elite program.



I will communicate injuries, incidents, and concerns to my coaches IMMEDIATELY in order for them to take action and/or offer assistance.


I understand that I am required to stay and cheer for all other Fusion Elite teams at competitions.

AGE DIVISIONS determine how old a team is

TEAM LEVEL determines the difficulty of skills a team is allowed to perform (see below)

<u>Team Level</u> is determined mostly by tumbling skills. To secure a spot within a specific level (in addition to being able to stunt that level), athletes must have <u>MASTERED</u> all of the skills below with an asterisk.

<u>MASTERY</u> is determined by correct body positioning, timing, speed, approach and landing. Skills must be able to be thrown multiple times without a spot or hesitation. Athletes may be required to perform skills to counts.

If a team cannot be fully comprised of 100% of the athletes having the skills, the remainder of the roster may be determined by specific stunting skills/positions needed for each team. This is determined solely by the coaching staff, and should be considered the exception, not the rule.

Team level from prior seasons does not determine placement in future seasons. Skills will be reevaluated each year, and athletes will be placed accordingly.
