

Welcome to World Class Allstars. We are so excited you are interested in joining the WCA Family! We are gearing up for our 6th competitive season and we are pumped for what this next season holds. In this packet you will find all the information needed to become a competitive all-star cheerleader for World Class Allstars. Please review the information in this packet, in its entirety.

Tryout Fee:

• Allstar Tryout: \$75

• Allstar Private Tryout: \$85

• Sibling Discount: \$25

If the parent chooses to not allow their athlete to be on the squad assigned there will be a \$250 fee payable immediately

Monthly Tuition: Due on the 1st of each month June 2022-May 2023

• Allstar Novice: \$125/Monthly

• Allstar Prep: \$155/ Monthly

• Allstar Elite: \$165/ Monthly

• Family Discount: each additional student will recieve 20% off monthly tuition of the lesser value.

Competition Fees: Due on the 15th of each month according to your payment option

Allstar Novice: (Estimated at \$650-\$750)

• Allstar Prep: (Estimated at \$1,000-\$1,500)

• Allstar Elite: (Estimated at \$1,500-\$1,700)

Allstar Elite Level 5 & 6:(Estimated at \$1,500-\$1,800)

Allstar Worlds, Summit, Cheer Worlds, and any other end of the year finals will not be included in the quotes prices above

Athlete Scholorship:

Any athlete can apply for a tuition scholarship at the beginning of the season. Scholarships are awarded according to financial need. Applications are available online and in the office.



Office Staff:

Our office hours are from 4pm to 8pm, Monday through Thursday. Our front office staff is here to help you in any way that we can, from billing and accounting to general inquiries.

Updates:

WCA sends out monthly news letters to keep our families informed of all the things occurring each month, including upcoming events.

Communication:

There are several other ways WCA communicates with their families. Facebook, GroupMe, E-mails, ect. Please stay informed with all mediums.

No Refunds:

Under no circumstances or for any reason will a refund be issued for any WCA collected fees. (Injury, illness, team changes, quitting absences. etc.) If your athlete quits or leaves the team and your fees were pre-paid for the season, that amount (less the quitting fees) will be held on your athletes account for future use on future WCA fees. (classes, teams, etc.). A refund will not be given in the form of a check, cash, credit card or any other form. World Class Allstars will not charge for services not provided.

Current Balance:

All students must be cleared at a zero balance with WCA in order to sign up for private lessons, classes or other special events. Members must be cleared at a zero blance at least one working day prior to an event in order to perform. WCA reserves the right to pull an athlete from any performances if the account is outstanding. Athletes may also be removed from practices if their account is outstanding.

Practice Attire:

Every all star will be fitted for 2 sets of practice wear and will be required to wear the assigned outfit to every practice. Athletes will also need to wear cheer shoes and have their hair pulled back at all times for safety. This will be strictly enforced. In the event you lose an article of practice wear, you will be required to purchase a new one.

Booster Club/ 5013C:

All families will have access to fundraise through the booster club. The WCA Parent Booster Club is a 5013c group that allows us to participate in other opportunities of raising funds such as; working events like the UCA football games, or Verizon Arena. Funds raised through the booster club allow you to pay for competition fees as well as other fees such as travel expenses, hotel, airfare, uniforms, and practice wear. More information will be provided once apart of the program.

Sponsorship Fundraising:

Sponsorship fundraising is a great way to put money on your competition account. Sponsorships are offered to companies as advertisement and 90% of the money sponsored goes to your athletes competition account. Sponsorship packets with more information are available at the front desk.

Fundraising:

Fundraising options are available to offset the cost of competition fees. We will immediately begin fundraising in June and continue throughout the season. You choose the fundraisers you would like to participate in. 10% of the money goes into the WCA scholarship fund. All money that you accumulate there after will be put into your competition account.



Competition Late Fees:

In the event of a delinquent account, the WCA office will notify you, and will require check or cash for the amount delinquent, in addition to a \$25 late fee. Should your account have a balance at the end of your original payment plan, you will be assessed a 10% late fee of the full remaining balance each month until paid in full.

Quitting Fees:

Quitting a team at any time is detrimental to the team. Fees are paid prior to the start of the competition season. Quality time is spent on each and every athlete. There fore, if an athlete quits a team, the following fees will be owed and drafted within 2 days of the separation from the gym.

Crossover Fees:

Some athletes may be asked to compete on more than one cheer team and are known as "crossovers". An athlete can not cross over between Novice, and Elite. Crossovers are responsible for the crossover fees charged by the event producers. If you are asked in the middle of the season to replace an athlete, you will be made aware of the crossover fees from that point forward.

Tryout Video:

The tryout video will be posted on April 25th on our YouTube channel. Make sure that your athlete practices the level routine that best suits their skill level they will be able to successfully present.

Tryout Clinic:

We offer a free Tryout clinic for all athletes intending on trying out. This season tryout clinic will be held on April 27th and 28th. Level 1-2 will be held from 4:30pm-5:30pm and level 3-6 will be held from 5:45-6:45pm. Athletes must register for tryouts online prior to attending the tryout clinics.

Tryout Attire:

- Solid color sports bra/ tank top
- Athletic spanks/shorts
- Cheer/ Athletic shoes
- Hair in ponytail and pulled back from face

Tryout Signup:

We will have signups posted online. These times slots will be first come first serve. This will allow us to bring in everyone and rotate through the tryout process which will include, paperwork drop off, stretching, tumble warm up, and evaluations. This process will be about an hour long. You may pick up your athlete on the left side of the building once their time slot is up.

Team Groups:

You will receive an email with practice days and times on Wednesday, May 4th. Your athlete will be paired with groups according to age and skill level. We will continue the tryout process for two weeks to see which team will best benefit your athlete and the team as a whole. We will announce team placements along with team names, coaches, and set practice schedule on May 20th, via email.



Announcements:

Once teams are announced, we will not accept any. calls, text, or emails regarding concerns with placements. You must trust our decision. Always remember, placements are never final. If we see that a child would better benefit a different team, we can/will move them anytime throughout the season.

Viewing Room:

A viewing room is provided to watch your child practice. Although viewing is allowed, the viewing room is not a place for gossip, doubting the coach's abilities, or coaching your athlete. These examples create a negative atmosphere and are not acceptable. If you have a concern about YOUR child, please notify one of the coaches.

Practices can be closed for viewing at any time throughout the season when needed in order to retain the athletes 100% attention.

Please remember that all-stars are not the only individuals in the gym during practice times. There are prospective all-stars and recreational class parents in the viewing room as well. We would like the atmosphere in the viewing room to be positive for everyone.

WCA Parents:

We ask that parents not interfere with the coaching of our cheerleaders in the gym or at competitions/ events. Remember you as a parent reflect World Class Allstars at all times. We want to make this experience fun and positive for athletes and parents. We expect all of our parents to not only respect the families within our program, but when at competitions we expect all parents to respect other athless and gyms as well as the companies that put on the competitions.

Commitment/Conduct:

The WCA program prides itself on team spirit and unity. Athletes on each team must support other teams during performances. We will often require our members to arrive early at events and stay for all teams performances to support the program equally.

WCA athletes must treat their teammates and coaches with respect at all times.WCA athletes must maintain good sportsmanship with other cheerleading programs in the area and around the country. We expect our members to be humble about their abilities and respect the talents of others in the industry.



Attendance:

We understand there are circumstances that may be unavoidable, however please keep in mind this is a TEAM sport that is unlike any other. There are no back-ups or "second strings." Attendance at practice is essential to the success of all squads. Every team member has a specified function, and one absence could disrupt the effectiveness of practice.

Absence Policy:

- All practices, events, exhibitions, competitions and any functions of World Class Allstars are mandatory.
- Please notify your coach or the front office as soon as you are aware you might have an absence or conflict.
- Only 3 practice absences are allowed. The only excused absences are for family emergency or a school funcaiton that results in a grade. All other absences such as part time jobs, dances, concerts, banquets, long- distance driving, family reunions, weddings, recitals, school/church socials, or any other non-related school activities are considered unexcused.
- Absences are not allowed the week leading up to a competition.
- An unexcused absence may result in the athlete being moved to an alternate
 position or being pulled from an upcoming competition at the discretion of
 the staff. It is the responsibility of the athlete to learn any changes prior to
 practices.
- In the case of an emergency absence please contact the office or your coach immediately.

Summer:

The summer months of June-August will be used as a time for the athletes to improve their skills and learn choreography. We know families use the summer as a time for relaxing and enjoying other activities such as vacations and camps however practice is still mandatory if you are in town. Summer Vacation Requests may be submitted to the front office for approval on the first day of your athlete's practice. Please note, no dates falling on mandatory events will be considered excused.



Travel:

Travel costs are not included in the competition fees. You will be required to make travel arrangements that best fit your families needs. We will inform families as soon as the competition schedule is set for the coming season. You are not required to stay in the same hotels as everyone else however we know the kids enjoy being together in one hotel when possible. We will send out a list of recomended hotels once we have them.

Travel Discount:

Those families that travel in to WCA from a 25 mile radius or greater are eligible for a \$25 discount off tuition.

Stay to Play:

There are special rules that apply to "Stay to Play" events. You will be given information and instruction on how to book your hotel should we decide to attend a compeition with this requirement.

Choreography:

A detailed schedule will be given to you once teams are formed. All Choreography dates are absolutely Mandatory. Choreography will be in June and will be closed for viewing.

Conditioning:

Cheerleading is a very strenuous sport that requires athetes to be in good physical condition. In our practices we will include excercise that will help with flexibility, strength, and endurance. If needed, your athlete may be asked to take an additional tumbling, stretching, or stunting class. These classes are discounted for team members class.

Social Media:

It is expected and required that all WCA Athletes, Parents, and Friends be respectful on ALL SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS. WCA will not tolerate the misuse of social media if it affects or reflects poorly on WCA in any way, shape or form. All WCA Facebook pages are owned by WCA and post/comments that are negative or against what WCA deems appropriate will be deleted. Repeated offences will result in dismissal from the program.
