Frequently Asked Questions

What is included in my tryout fee?

Athlete evaluation, Leveled practices, Extra Tumble/Conditioning Classes, An Infinity T-Shirt, Infinity Swag Bag with themed goodies for each athlete and admission into the Team Reveal party on June 3rd!

How are teams selected?

We select teams to be the most competitive in each level. There are many different factors taken into consideration when choosing the best fit for each athlete. We will be looking at tumbling level, jumps, stunting ability, performance potential, attitude, maturity and age when selecting our 2017-2018 competitive teams. And yes, EVERYONE makes a team! To find out more info on Team Selection, attend our first ever Infinity Parent Seminar on Wednesday, May 24th at 6:30pm!

How often do the teams practice?

Allstar teams will have normal team practice twice per week, Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday. Each practice will be 2.5 hours long. Tumbling/Conditioning practice will be on Fridays throughout the summer months (June/July/August). There will be additional weekend practices for select teams as needed in September, October and November to prepare for competition season. Our Tiny team will practice twice a week, 1.5 hours each night. Prep teams will practice once per week with each practice being 1.5 hours long. The practice calendar for the year will be released at our Team Reveal.

How much does competitive cheer cost?

Approximately \$3,600 for Allstar athletes and \$2,100 for our Tiny/Prep athletes (travel expenses not included). Finances are broken down in detail inside of this packet. We offer numerous fundraising opportunities throughout the season to help off set costs and we have had families in the past who were able to fundraise their entire cheer balance! Fundraisers are optional and all monies are applied directly to the athlete's account.

What is the Infinity attendance policy?

Cheerleading is a team sport that requires all athletes to be present in order to successfully hold practice. Therefore, athletes are required to attend every practice. **More than TWO absences during the season can result in removal from team.** During the week leading up to a competition all practices are mandatory. ANY ATHLETE WHO IS UNABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN PRACTICE DURING THE WEEK LEADING UP TO A COMPETITION WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE ROUTINE FOR THAT WEEKEND.

We have a summer vacation planned- what should I do?

We value the importance of family at Infinity and encourage you to take time with each other during the summer months. We will excuse an athlete for a summer vacation if we have a **completed vacation form** at least **1 week prior** to their absence. As of August 14th (first day of Duval County Schools), practices become mandatory. Please visit our website to locate the vacation form and turn in to the front desk.

Skills Camp

June 19-23

Skills Camp is MANDATORY for all athletes. Each team will participate in a 3-4 hour block on each day of that week. Specific times will be released at the Team Reveal.

Choreography Dates

August 18-20, August 25-27, August 28-29, September 8-10, September 26-30

Each team will be assigned 2-3 days of choreography from the above dates.

Exact times/days will be emailed out mid-summer. Choreography is mandatory so please set aside these dates.

Hair/Make-Up

This year we will be using a high TEASED ponytail with CURLS on the bottom and a braid in the front. Prep and Tiny Teams will do a high Straight Ponytail. Allstar athletes must purchase a hairpiece to wear so that all look the same. There are many different companies to purchase from at different price points and we will send an email mid-summer with details on how/when to order.

We will offer classes and videos to ensure all athletes look the same.

Make-up will be a natural, smoky eye using make-up you purchase on your own OR from us. Glossy Pink lipstick will be sold in our pro shop or you can use your own. Color must be PINK.

During the week of the Infinity Showcase (December 4th-7th) athletes will be required to get their hair/make-up approved for competitions.

Fundraising

We offer plenty of fundraisers throughout the season to help offset the cost of Allstar Cheer. We offer at least 1 new fundraiser per month from June through December. Details for each fundraiser will be emailed out. We offer a special incentive for our returning families- a \$50 referral fee will be credited to your account for each athlete you bring to Infinity who participates in the season.

Team Parents

We select 1 team parent for each Infinity team. Our team parents are the liaison between the coach and the parents. Team parents are in charge of meeting the team at competitions, handing out wristbands, and assisting with team functions and communication. Team Parents are not involved in gym decisions, coaching or accounting issues.

Infinity Uniforms

This year is our year to re-new uniforms for the majority of our program (every 2 years!). The majority of our program (Minis, Youth, Juniors) will wear the "Program Uniform" that covers the midriff. Our Senior teams will wear a 2-piece uniform. Our World's Team will have a uniform specific for their team. And our Tiny/Prep teams will use uniforms from the past season. We have a "Sponsor My Uniform" sheet as one of our first Fundraisers.
