## **EVALUATION INFORMATION**



Athletes trying out are encouraged to attend team workout sessions (April 3-27, 2023) before trying out. Contact the front desk dates for schedule and pricing information. Athletes will sign up for a private evaluation time to demonstrate jumps, tumbling and flying ability (if applicable) April 28-29, 2023. Our team evaluations are as relaxed as possible, and each evaluation will conclude with a short interview to go over athlete goals for the upcoming season.

**Try-out Attire**: T-shirt or sports bra, spanks or shorts and lightweight tennis shoes or cheer shoes with hair pulled into a ponytail with a bow. Athletes are assigned tryout numbers during evaluation. Evaluations will be held April 28-29, 2023. If you cannot make it on this day, you can tryout during the preceding week by appointment.

#### **Evaluation Procedures:**

- 1) Schedule an evaluation time beginning 4/17/2023 with the front desk by calling 281-741-0531 OR request an evaluation time in your parent portal under the CAMPS/EVENTS TAB. Parent Portal Link: https://app.iclasspro.com/parentportal/odysseycheerco
- 2) Read through the 2023-2024 Cheer Contract Packet and program offerings/payment information sheets. All-star cheerleading is a SELECT sport and requires a large time and financial commitment. Please make sure you understand what you are committing to.
- 3) Turn in the 2023-2024 All-Star Registration Form, Parent & Athlete Rules Form and the Credit Card Authorization Form found in this evaluation packet. If this paperwork is not turned in your athlete will not be able to try out.
- 4) New athletes turn in a photo and birth certificate. Returning athletes turn in a current photo.
- 5) If you are not a current member, a \$55 non-refundable registration fee per athlete will apply and will be charged to the card on file prior to tryouts.
- 6) Submit practice wear and practice bow payment on or before your evaluation time. \$200 plus tax for competitive and prep teams & \$100 plus tax for show team and novice. *Price is subject to increase pending final design.*

Odyssey Cheer Company will always do what is best for a team to grow and have success throughout the season. Athletes will be considered for teams based on age, level availability and level requirements. Please note that athlete maturity, tumbling ability and jumping skills are also taken into consideration during team evaluations. Skills **MUST** be consistent and demonstrate **STRONG** technique in order drive the future success of a team. We are looking for well-rounded athletes with strong work ethic - simply having the necessary tumbling skills does not guarantee that a candidate will automatically make that level team.

Registration Fee: Non-refundable per athlete registration fee. This fee covers annual liability insurance fees.


**Practice Wear and Bow:** Competitive and prep teams will receive 2 practice wear sets & 2 bows. One set has a matching tank top that is optional. Novice and Show team will receive 1 practice wear set and bow. This set comes with a matching tank top that is optional for an additional \$10.

Monthly Tuition: Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of the month. ALL ATHLETES MUST HAVE A CREDIT CARD ON FILE TO RECEIVE AUTOPAY TUITION RATE – NO EXCEPTIONS. Tuition is drafted by the 3rd day of each month. If you want to use another payment method, payment must be received no later than the 2nd of each month. A \$25 late fee per account will be assessed on the 5th day of each month. This will be strictly enforced this year. It is your responsibility to update lost/stolen CC information as well as billing/address changes. Monthly fees more than 15 days late will result in your athlete sitting out of practice. Odyssey Cheer offers a 10% discount on annual tuition paid in full. Beginning May 11, 2023, athletes who have completed 5 or more seasons with Odyssey will receive a 5% discount on tuition.



## **TEAM EXPENSES CONTINUED**

**Team Fees:** Team fees are due on the 16th of the month, each month from June through January (8 payments). A \$25 late fee per account will be assessed on the 17th day of each month. Team fees include the following items: competition entry fees, coach's event fees & travel, music, choreography, stunt clinic and in-house team camp.




- Competitions: Competitive teams will attend 6-10 events per season. Prep and Show team teams will attend 5-7 local events each season and Novice full year teams will attend 5 local competition per season. All competition and prep teams will attend a MANDATORY end of season event (e.g., The Summit, The One). End of year competition fees & coaches cost to bid events will be paid separately.
- Music, Choreography and Team Camp: Team choreography takes significant planning outside of regular practices. Mandatory team camps will be scheduled in the coming months, dates will be announced as soon as they become available.
- Please make sure to not plan any family vacations, summer camps or other activities on camp days. All athletes are required to attend camp (no exceptions). Note that no refunds are given in the event that an athlete cannot attend camp as they are still being included in the routine choreography. If you are absent for any reason, you must find an athlete to fill in from another team. NO EXCEPTIONS!

**Uniform Bundles:** All athletes are required to purchase new practice wear and competition uniforms for the 2023-2024 season.

- Uniform Bundles: All uniform prices include a competition bow. We are still in the process of finalizing a
  design for the 2023 season so at this time all costs are estimated and subject to change.
- Practice Wear: All athletes will need to purchase practice wear this season. Practice wear will cost \$100 per outfit plus tax, and includes top (sports bra), bottom (skirt or short) and bow. Competitive and prep teams will need to purchase two practice wear sets.
- Baseball Cover-Up: All competitive and prep athletes will need to have a baseball jersey cover-up. If your

athlete purchased one in a previous season, they will not need to purchase one for the 2023-2024 season. Baseball cover-ups cost \$65 plus tax. Names can be added for an additional cost.

- Team T-Shirt: All novice & show athletes will need to purchase a team t-shirt cover-up, including returning athletes. Team t-shirt cover-ups cost \$20 plus tax.
- Competition Shoes: All athletes will need to purchase competition shoes through the pro-shop. Prices vary per team. If shoes are needed prior to the order date, please see the front desk.
- Bling Back Pack: All competitive, prep, show & novice athletes will need to have an officially Odyssey Bling Back Pack. If your athlete was on novice or prep team and purchased one last season or in previous season, they will not need to purchase one for the 2023-2024 season. All competitive athletes <u>must</u> have a Rebel Dream Bag. Cost includes a personalized name tag. Novice and show athletes can upgrade to the competitive back pack by seeing the front desk.





## **TEAM COMMITMENT**



- Competition teams will practice 4 hours a week Two 2-hour session of team practice. Additional practices may be added before an event. Athletes wanting to enroll in tumbling classes will received a 25% monthly discount on tumbling tuition.
- Prep Teams will practice 3 hours a week One 2-hour session of team practice and 1 hour of team tumble/stunt practice. Additional tumbling/stunting classes will receive a 25% discount.
- Novice teams will practice 2 hours a week. Athletes wanting to enroll in tumbling classes will received a 25% monthly discount on tumbling tuition.
- Show team will practice 1.5 hours a week. Athletes wanting to enroll in tumbling classes will received a 25% monthly discount on tumbling tuition.

**ABSENCE POLICY:** Athletes and parents are expected to be able to manage school, family activities, and athletics during cheer season **without missing** practice. Athletes should plan their days and weeks to complete homework outside of cheer practice times. Missed practice sessions impact the entire team's stunts, formations, and tumbling sequences and cannot be fully executed.

Athletes are expected **to attend all** practices. We expect top priority and 100% commitment to attending every practice. Adhering to this policy allows us to keep extra practices to a minimum. We ask that school cheerleaders and parents request a school cheer/sport schedule in advance for the coaches as well as contact information for their school team coach.

During weeks before show-offs and regional competitions, and during the two weeks prior to all national events, there are **NO ALLOWED** absences, these will be BLACK OUT dates on the calendar. Missing a practice during these weeks may result in immediate dismissal from a team. The only excused absences are a mandatory graded school function. Non-related school activities are unexcused.

Odyssey Cheer allows a maximum of 4 absences May - August. ALL ABSENCES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY EMAIL TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE ABSENCE TO: <a href="mailto:INFO@ODYSSEYCHEER.COM">INFO@ODYSSEYCHEER.COM</a> and an approval or denial from Coach Katie will be returned by email.

Cheerleading is a team sport and requires everyone on the team to do their part. We understand that a quest for greatness is achieved with self-discipline and dedication. If you sign up for a school activity or sport, make sure it will not interfere with practices or competitions.

**ILLNESS:** Athletes with fever, vomiting, or diarrhea are asked to not attend practice. If an athlete is "not feeling well", they are still expected to attend practice, but sit out as needed to observe team activities. If your athlete is injured and cannot practice more than one practice session, please make sure you have seen a doctor and have a note stating the injury and the recovery period. We will need a doctor's release for any injured athlete to participate in practice and/or competitions. Even if an athlete is released, the athlete must be able to perform at the appropriate level to be incorporated back into the team practice. The athlete will be able to participate in practice/competition at the discretion of the coach.

During the school year, no more than two unexcused practice sessions will be allowed. Beginning January 2024, only one unexcused practice session will be allowed through the end of the season. In the case of severe illness, the day of an event, parents are expected to stay in contact with OCC staff and work with a doctor in order to make every attempt to help the child get better as soon as possible.

## **POLICIES & PROCEDURES**

I have read and fully understand the entire Odyssey Cheer Company information packet. I understand the guidelines, commitment and financial obligation involved with my athlete being a part of a team at Odyssey Cheer Company.
I understand that I am agreeing to a 10-month contract and that I am responsible for all fees billed. I understand that the team fees (in addition to the monthly tuition and uniform bundle) are divided evenly over an 8-month period.
I understand that Odyssey Cheer Company has a no refund policy for all expenses and items burchased, including, but not limited to, monthly tuition, uniforms purchased, competition fees, summit fees, camp/music/choreography fees, practice wear, shoes, bows, pro-shop orders and team fees.
I understand if my account is not current in terms of tuition and team fees, I will be unable to pick up practice wear, uniforms, bow, shoes, or pro-shop items.
I understand my athlete's team may be chosen to attend the summit or other year end event. If that nappens there will be additional expenses involved.
I understand if I opt-out of the auto pay feature, I'm required to pay \$15 more for team fees and cuition payments and always have a valid credit card on file. If payments are not made on time the credit card on file will be used to charge any over-due balance on my account.
I understand hotels may be required at some events for competitive teams. Most out of town events require teams to book with their travel company ("stay to play" events). I understand athletes will be required to stay at these hotels to participate. I understand all rooms and travel costs are the responsibility of the parent understand all Tiny, Mini and Youth team will compete on Friday in February for NCA, this will require the athlete to be in Dallas Thursday evening and he or she may miss a day of school.
I understand Odyssey has the right to close the parent viewing area at any time to provide our athletes with a more focused atmosphere.
I understand that my athlete is allowed 4 absences during the months of June, July, and August. I also understand that these absences cannot be on mandatory choreography dates.
I understand all the gym team chat rules, and I am aware that Odyssey will use an app such as TeamApp or Group Me as additional means of communication between the coaches and the parents/athletes. These chats allow you to have direct access to the owner, office staff, coaches and parents that are on the same team. To keep a positive atmosphere, we credited the following chat room rules: Only post in your team's chat room, no negativity, arguing, or bashing of any kind. We will have a sero-tolerance policy and will remove the individual from this forum immediately. Chat rooms are for generic question and positive comments: do not use this for athlete specific questions or concerns. Do not use the app for attendance issues. Please be respectful of others and only post between 8AM and 10PM.

I understand the use of the Odyssey Cheer name, all logos, team names and icons are limited to Odyssey Cheer Company, LLC. Any use of Odyssey Cheer, all logos, team names are prohibited. You must have written permission.	
I understand that in the event my athlete is injured at any time during the season, her/his position on the team will have to be filled by another athlete. I understand that athlete injuries, can vary in length and severity: therefore, depending on the severity and length of my athlete's injury, Odyssey coaches will determine when and what position the injured athlete will return to the team. I understand that a doctor note clearing the injured athlete will be required to return to Odyssey. Tuition fees are still due even when athletes are sitting out.	l r's
