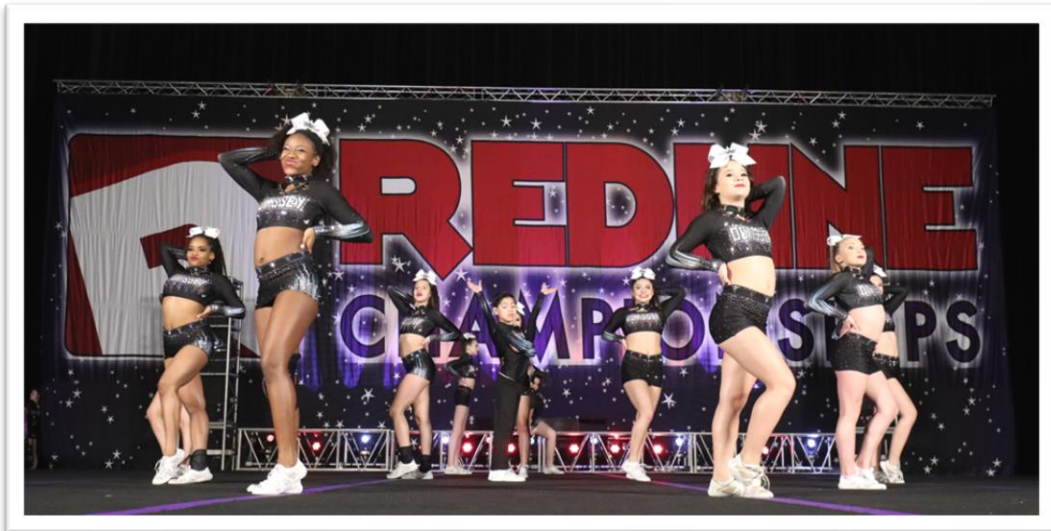




WELCOME TO ODYSSEY CHEER COMPANY



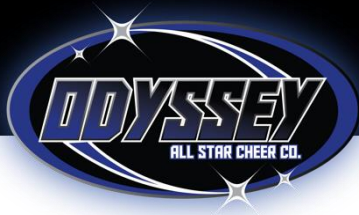
Thank you for your interest in the Odyssey Cheer Company cheer program. The mission of our competitive cheer program is to train with integrity, respect, and build championship squads through team unity and individual commitment. Our goal is to encourage and instill confidence in our athletes, offer leadership opportunities and foster lifelong friendships and memories.

At Odyssey Cheer Company (OCC) we are committed to providing your athletes with the best coaching and skill building available so that they may have a successful future in cheerleading. In our team program, we value all our athletes, consistent progress and achievement.

At Odyssey Cheer Company, we guide and mold our athletes into adults who will make a difference. In addition to top-flight competitive cheerleading opportunities, over the cheer year we participate in several outside activities to help our athletes grow as young people and recognize their achievements:

- **Philanthropy Project:** Each year the Odyssey Family will come together to support one or more local charities as our athletes learn the value of giving back to the community and helping those in need.
- **Annual Retreat:** our annual weekend retreat is an optional event where Odyssey athletes participate in leadership, team building activities, and games with their odyssey Family. This event will take place on a weekend in September at an overnight camp facility.
- **Awards Banquet:** At the end of the cheer season, the Odyssey Family will come together for a banquet dinner that included dancing, awards and a celebration of the past year together.

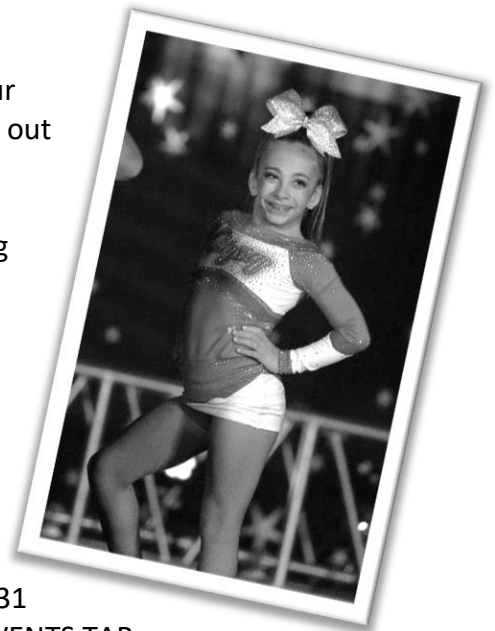
EVALUATION INFORMATION

tumbling, flying ability (if applicable) and a short dance combo. Videos of the dance/cheer combo will be available on our website www.odysseycheer.com beginning June 9, 2020. Athletes trying out are encouraged to attend a team workout session before trying out. Our team evaluations are as relaxed as possible and each evaluation will conclude with a short interview to go over athlete goals for the upcoming season.

Try-out Attire: T-shirt or sports bra, spandex or shorts and lightweight tennis shoes or cheer shoes with hair pulled into a ponytail. Athletes are assigned tryout numbers during evaluation.

Evaluation Procedures:

- 1) Schedule an evaluation time with the front desk by calling 281-741-0531 OR request an evaluation time in your parent portal under the CAMPS/EVENTS TAB.

- 2) Read through the 2020 Evaluation Packet and program offerings/payment information sheets. All-star cheerleading is a SELECT sport and requires a large time and financial commitment. Please make sure you understand what you are committing to.
- 3) Turn in the 2020-2021 All-Star Registration Form, Parent & Athlete Rules Form & the Credit Card Authorization Form found in this evaluation packet.
- 4) New athletes - turn in a photo and birth certificate. Returning athletes - turn in a current photo.
- 5) If you are not a current member, a \$55 non-refundable registration fee per athlete will apply.
- 6) Submit practice wear & practice bow payment on or before your evaluation time. \$200 for competitive teams & \$100 for prep and showteams. Returning athletes will receive a credit for black practice wear if both the top and/or bottoms still fit (be prepared to bring these items to tryouts).



Odyssey Cheer Company will always do what is best for a team to grow and have success throughout the season. Athletes will be considered for teams based on age, level availability and level requirements. Please note that athlete maturity, dance ability and jumping skills are also taken into consideration during team evaluations. Skills MUST be consistent and demonstrate STRONG technique in order to drive the future success of a team. In the event that an athlete possesses exceptional strength in another area besides tumbling (ex: basing or flying), the athlete may be considered for a higher level team. We are looking for well-rounded athletes with strong work ethic - simply having the necessary tumbling skills does not guarantee that a candidate will automatically make that level team.

Odyssey Cheer Company will always do what is best for a team to grow and have success throughout the season. Due to Covid-19, we fully understand that our season will look quite different. Level workouts will begin on June 17, 2020. Placements are NOT final and athletes may continue to be moved throughout the summer. Please understand that we will be training *individual* skills such as tumbling, jumps, stretching and conditioning for the beginning of the season until restrictions are loosened.

Teams will be finalized by August 2020.

The following skills will be asked to be shown at evaluations:

- Showteam – No required skills
- Prep – Forward, cartwheel, kick to handstand, push up to bridge
- Level 1 Elite – Back walkover, front walkover, valdez
- Level 2 Elite – All Level 1 Skills PLUS standing back handspring, standing back handspring series, back walkover back handspring, round-off back handspring series, front walkover round-off back handspring
- Level 3 Elite – All Level 2 Skills PLUS punch front, standing back handspring series, round-off back handspring tuck, aerial, toe-touch back handspring
- Level 4 Elite – All Level 3 Skills PLUS standing back tuck, back handspring tuck, toe back handspring tuck, round-off back handspring layout, one additional level 4 elite tumble pass

** returning athletes will receive a uniform credit when they bring their 2019-2020 black practice wear to tryouts to show that it still fits for the 2020-2021 season.

Registration Fee: Non-refundable per athlete registration fee. This fee covers annual liability insurance fees.

Practice Wear: Competitive Teams will receive 2 practice wear sets & 2 bows. One set is required to be a full length top. Matching sports bras for this set are available for purchase at uniform sizing and can be worn to practice but not to showcase events.

Prep Teams & Showteam will receive 1 practice wear set & 1 bow. This set is required to be a full length top. Matching sports bras are available for purchase at uniform sizing and can be worn to practice but not to showcase events.

Monthly Tuition: Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of the month. ALL ATHLETES MUST HAVE A CREDIT CARD ON FILE TO RECEIVE AUTOPAY TUITION RATE – NO EXCEPTIONS. Tuition is drafted by the 4th day of each month. If you want to use another payment method, payment must be received no later than the 3rd of each month. A \$25 late fee per account will be assessed on the 5th day of each month. This will be strictly enforced this year. It is your responsibility to update lost/stolen CC information as well as billing/address changes. Monthly fees more than 10 days late will result in your athlete sitting out of practice. Odyssey Cheer offers a 10% discount on annual tuition paid in full.



TEAM EXPENSES CONTINUED

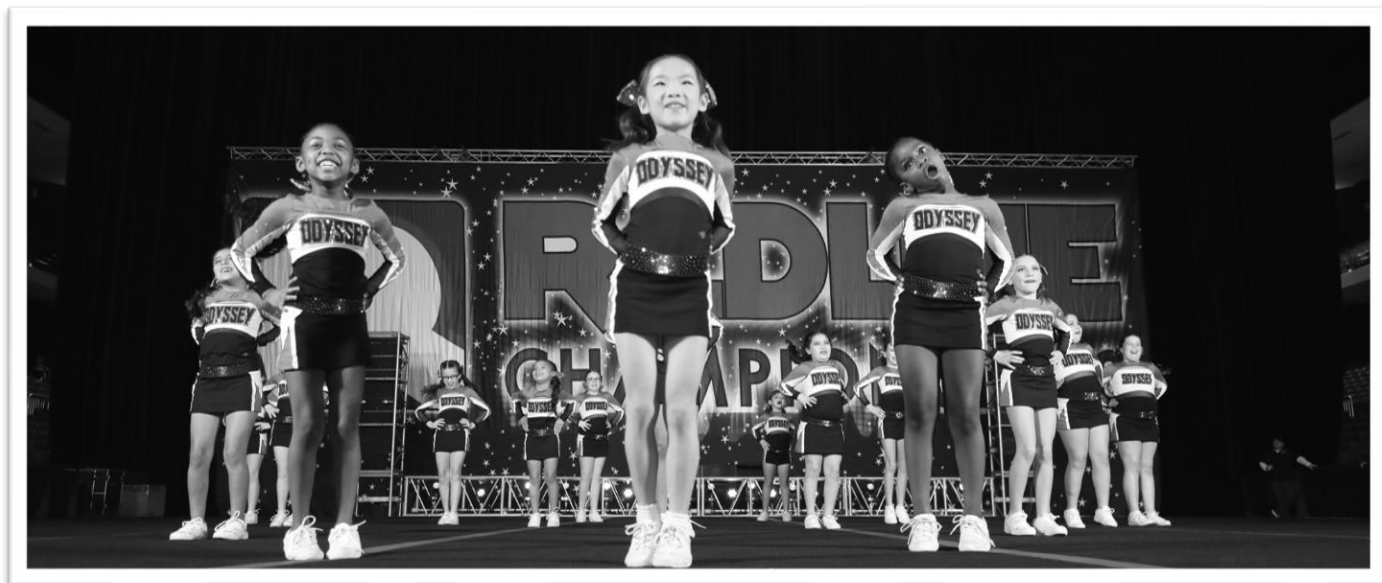
Team Fees: Team fees are due on the 16th of the month, each month from July through February (8 payments). A \$25 late fee per account will be assessed on the 17th day of each month. Team fees include the following items: competition entry fees, coach's event fees & travel, music, choreography and in-house team camp.

- **Competitions:** Competitive teams will attend 5-9 events per year. Prep & showteam teams will attend 4-6 local events each year. Competition fees & coaches cost to bid events (e.g., The Summit, The One) will be paid separately.
- **Music, Choreography and Team Camp:** Team choreography takes significant planning outside of regular practices. Mandatory team camps, individually scheduled for each team, will be held at OCC for three days (competitive) and two days (Prep Teams & Showteam) in August. All athletes are required to attend camp (no exceptions). Note that no refunds are given in the event that an athlete **cannot attend camp as they are still being included in the routine choreography.**

Optional Tumble Classes: ** BEST VALUE - over \$275 in yearly savings!! This option MUST be selected to start July 2020. Once this tuition option is started, this will remain the athlete's tuition rate for the remainder of the season - no exceptions! No sibling discounts on \$40 rate!

Uniform Bundles: We will re-use 2019-2020 uniforms for all teams.

- **Returning Athletes:** Must have uniform approved for fit and cleanliness for the 2020-2021 season. All returning athletes are required to purchase new competition shoes (Rebel) and a baseball cover-up. Bows (subject to assigned team), make-up & back pack may be re-used for the 2020-2021 season.
- **New Athletes:** Prep & competitive athletes are required to purchase a uniform & bow, new competition shoes (Rebel), a baseball cover-up, bling back pack and make-up kit. Showteam athletes are required to purchase a uniform & bow, competition shoes and a baseball cover-up. USED UNIFORM pieces may be available for purchase through the front desk only! Current members that have a used uniform to sell will be contacted during the summer when it is time to consign uniforms. Odyssey does not allow the sale of competition uniforms between athletes. Consignment ensures that the fit & cleanliness of the uniform is approved before sale.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

	<p>ABSENCE POLICY: We understand that a quest for greatness is achieved with self-discipline and dedication. Athletes and parents are expected to be able to manage school, family activities, and athletics during cheer season. Athletes should plan their days and weeks to complete homework outside of cheer practice times. Missed practice sessions impact the entire team’s stunts, formations, and tumbling sequences and cannot be fully executed. Athletes are expected to attend all practices. We ask that school cheerleaders and parents request a school cheer/sport schedule in advance for the coaches as well as contact information for their school team coach. We expect top priority and 100% commitment to attending every practice. Adhering to this policy allows us to keep extra practices to a minimum. During weeks before show-offs and regional competitions, and during the two weeks prior to all national events, there are NO ALLOWED absences. Missing a practice during these weeks may result in immediate dismissal from a team. Odyssey Cheer allows a maximum of 5 absences September – April. ALL ABSENCES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY EMAIL TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE ABSENCE TO: INFO@ODYSSEYCHEER.COM</p>
	<p>ILLNESS: Athletes with fever, vomiting, or diarrhea are asked to not attend practice. If an athlete is “not feeling well”, they are still expected to attend practice, but sit out as needed to observe team activities. During the school year, no more than two unexcused practice sessions will be allowed. Beginning January 2021, only one unexcused practice session will be allowed through the end of the season. In the case of severe illness, the day of an event, parents are expected to stay in contact with OCC staff and work with a doctor in order to make every attempt to make the child better as soon as possible.</p>
	<p>PRACTICE SESSIONS: Competitive teams will practice twice sometimes three times per week, typically for two-hours per session Sunday-Thursday. All-Star Prep & Showteam will practice once a week. Be prepared for practice session lengths or practice days to increase as the national’s season nears. These extra practice sessions are included in your monthly tuition. Extra practices will be scheduled and notified a week in advance. Tuition does not increase for 10-12 practice session months and does not decrease for 4-6 practice session months.</p>
	<p>CLOSED PRACTICE SESSIONS: All extra practice sessions will be closed for viewing. Occasionally practices may be closed throughout the season for viewing allowing for athletes to have 100% focus on the team and coaches at all times.</p>
	<p>INJURY/RETURNING TO PRACTICE: If an athlete is injured in or outside of the gym, the athlete may sit out for one practice without a doctor’s note. Anytime longer, a doctor’s note is required. If a replacement is needed to temporarily fill in for competition, the athlete will be allowed to return when they are medically released and able to fully perform their team duties. This decision will come from coaches and owners. Tuition fees are still due even when athletes are sitting out.</p>
	<p>TUMBLING CLASSES: Practice sessions are not intended for perfecting tumbling. If your athlete is lacking some skills or losing strength tumbling, it is the parent’s responsibility to contact the front desk and arrange for private lessons or to enroll in additional tumbling classes. We have added a 20% discount on tumbling classes, a \$40 10-month commitment rate and a \$20 drop-in fee for team members.</p>
	<p>SUMMER VACATION: We understand that summer vacations are important for our Odyssey Family. However, if you are in town you need to be at practice! We ask that athletes have no more than 3 approved absences during the months of June, July, and August. Vacation absence notifications must be received on the Vacation/Prior Commitment Form before tryouts or two weeks minimum prior to absence.</p>
	<p>PRIVATE LESSONS: Individual or group sessions are perfect for students who are interested in personal advancement over and above what they are doing in their practice or for athletes who may be preparing for cheerleading tryouts. Our experienced staff will make an individual plan and set goals according to each student’s level and ability. Privates can be scheduled through the front desk. Please inquire with the front desk regarding lesson costs and the types of payments accepted.</p>



POLICIES & PROCEDURES CONTINUED

	<p>COMPETITION SCHEDULE: Our competition and event schedule will be released in late August/early September but may be subject to change. All competitions are mandatory, and athletes shall be available the entire weekend to perform. In most cases, event schedules (including arrival and dismissal times) will be available on the Tuesday or Wednesday before the competition or event. Some events may require teams to compete on Friday. While we try to limit Friday performances, please be aware this is a possibility. Please check the competition schedule and gym calendar at www.odysseycheer.com before making travel and vacation plans, especially around major holidays. Mandatory Nationals practices will begin January 2021.</p>
	<p>COMPETITION DAY: Athletes are to arrive on time to designated meeting area in full uniform, no exceptions. This means that make-up and hair need to be performance ready upon arrival. A make-up and hair video will be provided before competition season begins. If you need help getting ready, you will need to arrange to meet with a team mom or another parent BEFORE the team meeting time. No jewelry, gum, or nail polish is allowed. Skin-toned or nude undergarments must be worn at all events. Athletes are to remain in full uniform for the entire event. Staying for award ceremonies is MANDATORY. No backpacks, phones or baseball jerseys may be taken/worn to award ceremonies.</p>
	<p>RESPECT: OCC athletes are to show good sportsmanship at all times. OCC athletes will show respect to teammates, coaches and parents, regardless of team placement - we will always win and lose as a team. OCC athletes and parents will be courteous to other gym or team parents, athletes, and competition officials regardless of how treated. Being discourteous or disruptive can cause our teams to be sanctioned (losing points or disqualified from events). Parents and athletes are to never contact competition officials or judges directly (either in-person, by email, by phone or any other means).</p>
	<p>TRAVEL: Hotels may be required at some events for competitive teams. Most out of town events require teams to book with their travel company (“stay to play” events). Athletes will be required to stay at these hotels in order to participate. All rooms and travel costs are the responsibility of the parent.</p>
	<p>SAY NO TO DRAMA: We are a drama free gym. You start it and you will be put on a drop off status. If your athlete creates it they will be dismissed. We will not participate in negative gossip or communication. Our actions in the parent viewing area and on the cheer floor are a reflection of Odyssey Cheer Company. There are no “secret text groups” allowed between athletes and/or parents. All contact needs to remain on the designated TeamApp. Never post anything negative on social media about teammates, programs or parents. This includes “venting” - negativity will not be tolerated and is immediate ground for dismissal from Odyssey Cheer.</p>
	<p>OCC RIGHTS: OCC owns the rights to all program material including music and logos. Material may not be reproduced in any manner without written permission from OCC. OCC has the right to use any picture or videos of students taken while participating with Odyssey for use on the Odyssey website or marketing material. No posting of team routine videos on social media or YouTube without permission from OCC. Accounts must be current to receive any specialty items such as uniforms, backpacks, and practice wear etc. In the event an athlete is removed from the OCC, there are no refunds of any kind, and any outstanding balances must be paid. I agree to adhere to the rules and guidelines above and have read and understand the 2020-2021 information packet and will display good sportsmanship throughout the cheer season at the OCC facility and at outside events. OCC retains the right to remove any parent from the OCC facility or at outside events/competitions for violation of these rules or at management discretion.</p>

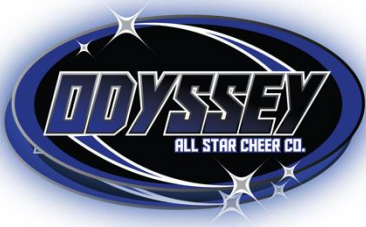

Autopay discounted rate: Requires a valid credit card on file. If you do not have a valid credit card on file tuition and team fees will be incur an \$15 additional monthly charge.

TERMS & CONDITIONS (initial acknowledgment of each)

- 1)_____ All payments are non-refundable. Payments are never pro-rated/ refunded/ transferred, including cases of illness, injury, sitting out for late payments, joining after June 2020 or quitting before last competition.
- 2)_____ Merchandise (uniform, clothing) will not be distributed if ANY payments are past due or if an athlete choses to quit the program.
- 3)_____ Service will be withheld (athlete will be sat out) if payments become 10 days past due.
- 4)_____ Team members are not guaranteed specific positions (i.e. flyer) and can be moved at coach's discretion for the better of the team.
- 5)_____ Missed "Team" practice within 14 days of competition may result in being replaced for that competition. Graded school activity is only exception.
