Once your child has been put on a team that best fits him/her, we will immediately start practices May 24th, 2023. There will be a total of 2-3 practices per week.

In an effort to develop a competitive training program, Venom Allstars has developed this document The Guidelines. These guidelines defines the basic policies and rules of the Venom and informs both the participating members and their parents/guardians of their responsibilities as a member of this program. While Venom will always attempt to communicate changes, these rules and policies are subject to changes without any notification to parents.

By enrolling Venom Allstars you...

- understand that it is your responsibility to remain current with tuition and other Venom charges & financial obligations. If for any reason your account is past due your student will be not be allowed to participate until it is paid. Also any athlete that quits at any point before the very last competition of the season (Summit if applicable) will automatically forfeit any items distributed throughout the season, paid/unpaid.
- agree to give Venom authorization to automatically collect your monthly tuition, charges and late fees more than 30 days past due from your banking account (checking, savings) and/or credit card.
- understand that there are no make-ups for missed practices due to personal issues such as illness or absences; or for practices canceled or shortened by Venom for any reason including, but not limited to, holidays, vacation breaks (such as but not limited to, Christmas, Easter, and a one week break during summer), due to conflict with a competition or clinic attended by the coaches, due to activities hosted at the Venom training facility, or any other reason that Venom determines necessary.



- understand that practice schedules and/or tuition rates and other fees may be changed without notice.
- agree that Venom names, uniforms, and other items bearing its name are the property of Venom and may not be used or reproduced for any purpose other than what Venom Owners have preauthorized.
- understand that the staff of Venom determines a member's level, both for purposes of training and competition. Furthermore, Venom staff may at any time make changes to their levels, squads, and practice schedule at anytime both temporary and permanently. A staff member may also remove a member from a competition or routine for any reason they deem necessary. No partial month tuition will be refunded.
- understand that students/families may be suspended, or removed from the program for any behavioral problems by the student, or another family members, if the Venom staff feels their actions are not in keeping with good sportsmanship or that they displayed behavior that is hostile, disrespectful, acts deemed disruptive to the team, unlawful acts, drunkenness, drug use, fighting, verbal outbursts, or were otherwise generally immoral & or unsupportive behavior in either tone or words. What is unacceptable is the decision of Venom Allstars.
- understand that all communications (website, e-mail, social media, letters, flyers, etc.) are intended solely for the active Venom Allstars competitive families and are not to be shared with others.



- understand that during the course of your association with Venom it may be disclosed to you certain trade secrets of the Venom Allstars; said trade secrets consisting of, but not necessarily limited to, customer information such as names, addresses, passwords, phone numbers, e-mail addresses, and other personal or contact information. You further agree to not create personal private information lists that may be copied, e- mailed, or otherwise transferred to unknown persons, or competitors, without the expressed written permission of Venom Allstars. You agree that you shall not during, or at any time after the termination of your association with the Venom Allstars, use for yourself or others, or disclose or to others, any trade secrets, customer information, confidential information, or any other proprietary data of the Venom Allstar in violation of this agreement.
- that by choosing to enroll in Venom Allstars competitive program, you are thereby agreeing to all of The Guidelines whether this document is read and/or signed or not.
