



PREMIER PREP TEAM OVERVIEW 2018-2019

*Premier all star prep team is a "stepping stone team" for our beginner cheerleaders to become more involved in a competitive cheerleading squad. Team members will learn the basics of competitive cheerleading while getting to experience the real live competition stage. This team will compete at approximately four local competitions and one out of town competition. Team members will be instructed on tumbling, motions, jumps, stunts, and dance while learning a routine they perform.

*The Premier All Star Prep team(s) will practice twice a week for up to 4 hours total per week. We will release the practice schedule after evaluations.

Evaluation Time: Each athlete will sign up for an evaluation time. Sign-up sheet will be available at the Parent Interest Meeting.

Evaluation Attire: white shirt, black shorts, or any PTC attire and tennis shoes

Evaluation Hair: high ponytail with a bow

Competition Uniforms: Fitting for competition uniform will take place immediately after each athlete is evaluated. All new athletes will need to be fitted for competition uniform. Returning athletes will wear the same uniforms.

Practice Wear: We will be wearing the same practice wear as we wore last year. If you are a returning athlete and you need new practice wear, you will be fitted immediately after your evaluation. If you are a new athlete, your fitting will take place after your evaluation.
