

The Dance Vault Dress Code

Combo Classes (ballet/tap, ballet/tap/jazz): Pink or black leotard, pink footed tights, pink ballet slippers, black tap shoes, tan jazz shoes, hair up & out of face.
**Ballet shoes may be worn for the jazz section of a combo class.*

Ballet: Black leotard, pink footed tights, pink ballet slippers, hair in a neat bun.

Jazz, Contemp., Lyrical, Tap: Tight---fitted top (leotard, tank, crop top), dance shorts or leggings, appropriate style of dance shoes (jazz shoes, pirouettes, tap shoes), hair up & out of face. **Tap shoes can be any black So Danca hard---soled jazz tap shoes. NO patent leather, slip---on or spilt---soled allowed.*

Acro: Any color leotard, tight---fitted dance shorts or leggings, bare feet, hair up & out of face. **If wearing tights, transition tights are necessary for bare feet.*

Aerial Silks: leggings and a shirt with tight fitted sleeves.

Hip Hop: Any style of top, loose shorts (no dance shorts), leggings or sweats, clean sneakers, hair up & out of face. **Hair may be worn down with teacher approval.*

Stretch/Strength: Any style of top and bottoms, clean sneakers, hair up & out of face.

General Dress Code Rules:

- No jewelry should be worn during class with the exception of small earrings.
- Dancers should always wear a cover---up when going to and from the studio.
- Dance sneakers should not be worn to and from the studio. Sneakers should be clean before entering a classroom.
- Bring all dance shoes in a dance bag & label all shoes & attire with dancer's name.
